Greece seeing 'light at end of austerity': EU commissioner

Greece is seeing "the light at the end of austerity", the EU's economy commissioner Pierre Moscovici said Monday, calling the reforms imposed on Athens by its creditors perhaps "too tough" but "necessary".

"Greece was caught up in an incredible economic and financial storm," Moscovici told France Inter radio ahead of a visit to Athens for talks with Prime Minister Alexis Tsipras on debt relief.

"Today, things are much, much better," he said, noting that the economy was starting to grow again, unemployment had dipped and the country's credit rating had improved.

"We had to create the conditions for (investor) confidence, which was done. Was it too tough? Probably. Was it also necessary? Likewise," Moscovici said.

Greece is on the rebound from a severe crisis that took the debt-ridden country to the brink of collapse in 2010.

It had to be repeatedly bailed out by its eurozone partners to prevent it bringing down the single currency bloc.

In a sign that the country is turning a corner the economy is projected to grow by 2.1 percent this year -- after no growth at all in 2016.

Unemployment has fallen 1.9 points in a year but was still stuck at a towering 21.7 percent in April.

The International Monetary Fund last week approved a one-year, \$1.8 billion loan programme for the country, which is reportedly planning a test re-entry to the bond market.

The fund said however it would not release any funds until the eurozone agreed on a deal to cut Greece's colossal 314-billion-euro debt burden.

Moscovici said the "140 extremely courageous reforms" undertaken by Athens meant there was now hope of "finally finding a solution to the debt problem."

Mideast growth to dive as Saudi economy stagnates: IMF

Economic growth in the Middle East and North Africa is forecast to slow considerably over oil prices as the Saudi economy slides, the International Monetary Fund said on Monday.

After a better than expected performance with five percent growth in 2016, the economies of countries in the Middle East and North Africa as well as Pakistan and Afghanistan will subside to just 2.6 percent growth this year, it said.

Last year's healthy regional economic performance was mainly attributed to Iran's strong growth estimated at above 6.5 percent because of higher crude production, the IMF said.

In its World Economic Outlook update, the IMF lowered economic growth of Saudi Arabia, the world's top oil exporter, to just 0.1 percent in 2017, down 0.3 percent on its April projections.

This will be Saudi Arabia's worst growth since 2009 when its economy contracted by 2.0 percent on the slump of oil revenues following the global financial crisis.

"The recent decline in oil prices, if sustained, could weigh further on the outlook for the region's oil exporters," the IMF said.

After recovering to over \$55 a barrel following a production reduction agreement by producers, oil prices receded on strong inventory levels and a pickup in supply.

The IMF projected that regional growth will rebound to 3.3 percent in 2018, however.

Saudi economic growth is also forecast to rebound to 1.1 percent next year, down 0.2 percentage points on April projections, it said.

Saudi Arabia's economy, the largest in the region, grew by 4.1 percent and 1.7 percent in 2015 and last year respectively.

MENA oil exporters have lost hundreds of billions of dollars since the mid-2014 crash in crude prices, transforming huge surpluses into shortfalls.

They have since implemented some economic reforms that have included raising fuel and power prices.

Gulf states, which earn more than 70 percent of their revenue from energy, have been posting budget deficits since oil prices fell.

Samsung takes aim at TSMC with plans to triple chip foundry market share

Samsung needs to strengthen the rest of its chip portfolio to secure future growth.

Jung declined to comment on revenue or investment targets, but said foundry and memory businesses will share the 6 trillion won next-generation chip production line that will be built in Hwaseong, South Korea.

Samsung doesn't reveal its chip contract manufacturing revenue, but analysts estimated it at 5.3 trillion won last year, with Daishin Securities forecasting it will see an increase of 10 percent or more this year.

While TSMC splurges around \$10 billion of capital expenditure annually, Jung said Samsung will be able to keep production capacity flexible depending on market demand by relying on memory chip lines.

Though Samsung already counts major firms such as Qualcomm Inc, Nvidia Corp and NXP Semiconductors as clients, it has a long way to go to catch up to TSMC.

Analysts estimate Samsung lost Apple to TSMC in 2015 and the Taiwan firm has had 100 percent of Apple's mobile processor business in 2016 and 2017.

"You need a technology that can wow your clients. Without such advanced technology, it'll be difficult to win back customers from your rivals," Jung said, without specifying any clients' names.

He said Samsung was confident of producing chips using the latest manufacturing technology called EUV (extreme ultraviolet) lithography ahead of rivals.

EUV is a next-generation technology that potentially lowers the cost and complexity of chip manufacturing. Samsung and TSMC are neck-and-neck in introducing EUV.
