Manikganj district election office formally began their programme yesterday.

'Save Karatoa, bring back navigability'

Speakers at a human chain in Bogra town said people of Bogra will be saved if the Karatoa river is saved and urged people from all walks of life to work together to save the river. About three hundred people under the banner of "Bhenge Felo Dokholer Sima, Ferao Karatoa Nodir Mohima" formed the human chain at Satmatha Intersection in the town demanding immediate steps to keep the flow of the river by bringing back its navigability. Organised by Sushashoner Jonno Procharovijan and Sacheton Nagorik Committee, two non governmental organisations, teachers, lawyers, leaders of different political parties, students and cultural activists participated in the programme which was presided by freedom fighter Masudur Rahman Helal, also district unit president of Sectors Commanders' Forum. They also submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner's office in the afternoon. Among others, Prodip Bhattacharya Shankar, KG Mostafa, Sheikh Abu Hasnath Shaheed, Bobita Rani Barman, Swapan Kumar Mistry, Kaniz Reza, Fazlul Haque and Babul Robi Das, also spoke.

Physical challenge no bar to his success

Masum Parvez, 38, from BDR Hat Road area of Lalmonirhat town is a successful businessman. In his diversified fertiliser, pesticide, cement and transport businesses he employs 32 people. He supports his wife and three children. He regularly contributes to the welfare of orphans and children with disabilities in the area. That's quite a resume for someone who only studied up to class two. It's an achievement of note for somebody who is physically challenged. "I didn't continue in school because the other students used to call me names due to my impairment," Masum recalls, whose disability stems from faulty treatment of typhoid when he was just seven-months-old. "Instead, I started spending more time with my father in our small fertiliser shop. Gradually I learned how to run a business properly." In 1996 he started his own fertiliser business in a tin shed shop, with around Tk 38,000 in pesticide and fertiliser stock. His father Moktar Ali, who was once a municipality councillor, helped him secure a dealership license. "My father's reputation was

beneficial," says Masum. "Many businessmen in the local markets and some pesticide companies were sympathetic and cooperative because of him." He also worked in partnership with his younger brother Masud Rana until a few years ago, when Masud died from cancer. Yet support from family and others, along with solid business management practices, did not by themselves, make Masum's business grow. It also took hard work. "We never see Masum idle," says Krishna Chandra Roy, 52, who has been employed in Masum's shop for the last twenty years. "He is always smiling, always busy. And he is popular with other businessmen for his honesty." By 2002, Masum had added cement and transport interests to his portfolio. Nowadays he owns assets worth around Tk 5 crores. "Masum Parvez has proven the proverb: where there's a will there's a way," says local businessman Rohidul Islam, 40. "Despite his physical challenges he has built a business that's in a much better position than many others." Yet Masum believes that without his disability he could have done

more. "Collecting dues from the market is difficult," he says, "because I can't move about freely." Moreover, Masum regularly helps others in the community. "I know the pain that people with disabilities experience," he says. "So I do my level best to help them. I also try to do something for orphans." Masum donates around Tk 60,000 per month to this end. "We pray for our donor Masum Parvez," says 12-year-old orphan Mehedi Islam from Taluk Khutamara area of Lalmonirhat town. Along with 25 other orphan children in a local madrasa, Mehedi receives food, clothing and healthcare free of cost due to Masum. "Poor people never return from Masum Parvez without getting assistance," says another local, Abdul Quader, 45. Naturally Masum's efforts are appreciated by his parents. "Masum manages our whole family," says his mother Bilkis Begum. "He has grown a small business into a large one," notes his father Moktar Ali, "and besides that he is working for the welfare of others. I am so proud of him."

Include Mital's heroic role of '71 in textbook

Kamal Lohani tells Pabna memorial meet

Veteran journalist Kamal Lohani urged the government to include Shirin Banu Mital's heroic role during the 1971 Liberation War in textbooks. Mital in her 20s disguised herself as a man to fight against the Pakistan army. The demand was made at the commemorative meeting held on her first death anniversary at Pabna Press Club on Monday. A non-government organisation 'Assistance for Rehabilitation and Knack (ARK)' organised the programme. If Mital's heroic role in 1971 is included in the textbook, the next generation will be able to know about her sacrifice, and it is possible if the government takes initiative in this regard, said Kamal Lohani. Shirin Banu Mital, daughter of Selina Banu, MP of Jukta Front in 1954, was a second-year student at Pabna Edward College, and a leader of Chhatra Union in Pabna when the Liberation War began. As local people were preparing for the war following Bangabandhu's historic speech on

March 7, she was figuring out how she could participate in the fight against the occupation forces. She wore a shirt and pant like Pritilata Waddadar, an anti-colonial revolutionary woman during the British period, and participated in the nine-month war along with the male fighters although most of the freedom fighters during that time could not come to know her identity. Her heroic role was published in international media with her fighting dress during the Liberation War. Born on September 2 in 1950 in Pabna town, Mital died of cardiac arrest on July 21 last year.

Law ministry

FROM PAGE 16 been suggested for the post of chief metropolitan magistrate of Barisal, the source added. Requesting anonymity, a law ministry high official told The Daily Star that the ministry sent the proposal to protect the image of the judiciary. The official said it was reported in the media that there was a hue and cry in his courtroom over his activities, and that he had not paid for his stay at a circuit house and had not paid a bus fare as well. The official said those might raise questions about his acceptability and neutrality as a judge. The proposal called for a probe into the allegations. Sabbir Faiz, additional registrar of the SC's High Court Division, said the proposal would be placed before the SC's general administration committee led by Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha for a decision. But Sabbir could not say when the general administration committee would make a decision. Barisal CMM Ali informed the SC administration on Sunday that he did not refuse Tariq bail and that he was not sent to jail, Sabbir told this correspondent on that day. Despite the claim, Tariq's name was seen on the top of a list of accused in the court's custody register on July 19. This paper obtained a copy of the list titled "Hajatkhanar Asami Grohon Register". Sabbir declined to comment on the list, saying that they did not get any such lists from the Barisal CMM.
