Eleven more Sitakunda children hospitalised

Eleven more children in Sitakunda's Tripura Para were admitted to a hospital yesterday.

The children showed symptoms including fever, rash, breathing problem and coughing, said Azizur Rahman Siddique, Chittagong civil surgeon. "These children too are likely suffering from measles."

A medical team of Sitakunda Upazila Health Complex sent them to Bangladesh Institute of Tropical and Infectious Diseases (BITID) in Fouzdarhat, he said.

"We will also start a vaccination programme in Tripura Para for children aged 0-15 today," he added.

A total of 107 children in Tripura Para, who were suffering from measles, were released from BITID and Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) after they got well, he said. With the 11, 24 children are now being treated at the two hospitals.

Ten children died after being sick, showing similar symptoms, he said. Of them, nine died at their houses as they did not get treatment, and one child died at CMCH on July 24.

Conspiracy claim against Khaleda ill-motivated

Says BNP

BNP yesterday criticised the ruling party leaders for repeatedly accusing BNP chief Khaleda Zia of hatching anti-state conspiracies in London.

"We sense a conspiracy in such allegation. It is motivated and an outcome of a deep-rooted plot against Khaleda Zia," Rizvi said at a press conference at the party's Nayapaltan office in the capital.

Several Awami League leaders including its General Secretary Obaidul Quader are creating a smokescreen by claiming that Khaleda Zia is engaged in hatching a conspiracy in London against Bangladesh, Rizvi said.

"It is a blatant lie..." the Awami League wants to cling on to power by force and such allegations might be a part of the plan, he also said.

The government is now fabricating stories over the BNP chairperson's UK tour since it has failed in every step of the way.

Time running out to reap benefit of young population

International conference in Dhaka told

The advantage of having a large young population would go to waste if the country fails to engage the youth in the workforce immediately, an international conference was told yesterday.

"We're shrinking the window of opportunities in terms of labour advantage," said Dr Mashiur Rahman, economic affairs adviser to the prime minister. "We should move quickly, and maybe we should undertake projects without having adequate information."

There is no need to wait for adequate information and analysis in this regard, he said.

Now, more than 65 percent of the

population are of working age, between 15 and 64.

Bangladesh since 2007 has had more people of working age than non-working, known as demographic dividend, and by 2040 this window of opportunity to accelerate economic growth would start to close.

Dr Moshiur said the opportunity would be available for the next 20-25 years.

"Suppose we'll take about six years to implement a programme to train these people. Of these 20 years, we lose six years. Because there is a short supply of trained workforce, industrial investment also perhaps would be a little

slow, so a few more years will be wasted," he told a session of the conference's second day.

The Institution of Diploma Engineers, Bangladesh (IDEB) and Colombo Plan Staff College (CPSC), Manila jointly organised the three-day conference themed "Skills for the Future World of Work and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET)" at IDEB in the capital.

Suggesting bringing changes in the technical education curriculum since the world is changing very fast, Moshiur said, "I always feel that our vocational and technical training curriculum is
