As far as his acting contribution is concerned, he has been in movies such as *Amélie* by Jean-Pierre Jeunet, *Amen* (2002) and *Wild Life* (2012) for which he was nominated as the best actor in multiple award events. He also had various roles in French TV series and has his own film production company named MNP Enterprise. According to Carlo Chatrian, Artistic Director of the Locarno Festival, "Mathieu Kassovitz is one of the most talented actors of his generation. He is the heir of that great tradition of performers who manages to achieve credibility in the most diverse roles."

Adrien Brody is one of the most brilliant figures in American film, winning an Academy Award at the age of 29.
