

SEXUAL ABUSE, TORTURE 4 children's home staff beaten up

Students of Sathkira Govt Children's Family on Sunday beat up four officials and employees over allegations of sexual abuses, providing inadequate food and physical torture.

The incident occurred at a children's family building at Old Sathkira in the town around 9:00pm.

The students have demanded immediate transfer of all officials and employees including Deputy Superintendent Mizanur Rahman and punishment of the culprits after an investigation.

The employees who were beaten up are office assistant Bidhan Bairagi, Tanvir Hossain, coordinator Abdullah Al Mahmud and cook Koushik Farhan.

Sixteen students raised the allegations in front of this correspondent, Deputy Director of District Social Welfare Directorate Debashish Sarder and Deputy Superintendent Mizanur Rahman.

Debashish Sarder said the district administration has already formed a three-member probe committee headed by Upazila Nirbahi Officer (Sadar) Nur Ahmed Sajal.

He added they have primarily transferred Bidhan to Ashasuni and would take action against others after the investigation.

Little hope

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Dr Lingam Gopal, a senior retina specialist, examined the 23-year-old yesterday.

National Institute of Ophthalmology (NIO) Assistant Professor Zahidul Ahsan Menon, who is also accompanying Siddiqui, declined to comment, saying he had sent a report on the doctor's observations on Siddiqui to the higher authorities.

Contacted, NIO Director Golam Mostafa said, "The doctor will do further assessments at the hospital today."

The victim was primarily examined by Dr Dhanshree Ratra of the same Indian hospital on Friday. She went through the case summary prepared by the NIO in Dhaka and referred him to Dr Lingam Gopal for a second opinion.

Meanwhile, a probe committee, formed to investigate the incident, has not submitted its report yet. Dhaka Metropolitan Police formed the body on July 23 to look into the police action on the students' protest, demanding announcement of their examination schedules.

Siddiqui's eyes were damaged after a policeman, as seen in a video footage, shot a teargas canister directly at the agitating students. Siddiqui collapsed on the street instantly.

Later, doctors at NIO said he could not see with his right eye. The left eye responded to light once or twice when the physicians removed the bandage on July 23.

The government is bearing Siddiqui's medical costs.

POLICE YET TO SUBMIT REPORT

The three-member probe committee, which was given three working days to complete their investigation, has not submitted its report yet. It is now seeking two more days for completing the job.

Mir Rezaul Alam, joint commissioner (operations) of the DMP, told The Daily Star, "We are taking statements from witnesses, on-duty policemen and doctors. We will submit our report based on our findings."

Asked whether they were able to identify the policeman who fired the teargas canister, he said, "We are scrutinising everything. If he has any fault, it will be reflected in our report."

Talking to a TV channel on July 25, DMP Commissioner Asaduzzaman Mia said they had several video clips of the incident and that the probe body was examining them.

Punitive actions would be taken if the probe body found any policeman guilty, he added.

A person could get injured if he or she was caught in the line of a fired teargas canister, he said, adding that canisters were usually fired at 45 degree angle.

"This is unexpected and saddening. Neither we nor the state can evade the responsibility," he added.

Police earlier claimed Siddiqui was wounded when hit by objects thrown by the demonstrators.

Defence

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Alam briefed reporters after the meeting.

He said no law had been enacted for appointment of the chiefs of the three forces in the last 46 years, which was why the draft law was proposed.

According to the proposed law, the chiefs would get salary equivalent to that of cabinet secretary in addition to allowances they now enjoy. After their retirement, they would not be reappointed to any civil or military administration.

However, they would be eligible to work in any constitutional position or at any private organisation on a contractual basis.

Incumbent army chief General Abu Belal Muhammad Shafiqul Huq will retire on June 25, 2018, air force chief Air Marshal Abu Esrar on June 12, 2018, and navy chief Admiral Nizamuddin Ahmed on January 27, 2019.

Padma rail link deal

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Union Information Service Centres (UISC) as IT hubs generating employments, and SPM would help pump imported fuel directly from oil tankers to the depot of Eastern Refineries Limited (ERL).

Currently, large tankers anchor in deep sea and smaller ships unload and bring the oil to storage facilities of the state-run ERL.

The mode of financing for the loans would be different, said the official sources.

The finance ministry tried to have all the projects' financing in soft-loan terms, but Beijing preferred diversified modes such as self-finance, investment, and commercial loan.

A finance ministry official said 15 percent of the cost of the Padma Bridge rail link would be borne by Bangladesh and the remaining 85 percent would be borne under China's preferential buyers' credit in US dollars.

In Info-Sarkar and Single Point Mooring (SPM) projects, China would provide soft loans in Chinese currency.

In both cases (buyers' credit and soft loan), the interest rate would be two percent with repayment period of 20 years including five years' grace period.

Bangladesh would bear 15 percent of costs, while China would provide 70 percent commercial and 15 percent soft loans in financing two power sector projects with a total outlay of \$3 billion.

A finance ministry official indicated that the commercial loan's interest rate would be around 2.5 percent.

The sources added China was willing to start financing three out of 28 mutually agreed development projects from this calendar year. However, Bangladesh pursued for financing more projects, especially the 172-km Padma Bridge Rail Link Project.

A special letter was sent from the Prime Minister's Office to the Chinese government emphasising the political and economical importance of the rail link project for Bangladesh. The letter also noted that the planned rail link is

also a part of the BCIM (Bangladesh-China-India-Myanmar Forum for Regional Cooperation) economic corridor.

The letter further said the prime minister desired for opening of the train services over the Padma the same day the bridge is opened. After the communication China has agreed to sign the deal this year.

The project would be implemented by 2022, but a portion of the rail line would be completed by 2018 so that people can use Padma Bridge by both road and rail. The government plans to open the bridge to public in December 2018.

The project is divided into four segments -- Dhaka-Gendaria, Gendaria-Mawa, Mawa-Bhanga and Bhanga-Jessore rail tracks. The railway tracks would go through seven districts of Dhaka division -- Dhaka, Narayanganj, Munshiganj, Shariatpur, Madaripur, Faridpur and Copalganj -- and two districts of Khulna division -- Narail and Jessore.

Dhaka would probably get \$21.5 billion from Beijing in financial assistance under the MoU signed in last October against a total of 28 projects under China's 'Strengthening Investment and Production Capacity Cooperation' programme, said sources at Economic Relations Division (ERD).

The amount could go up or down when final loan agreements would be signed, they added.

Distinguished Fellow of the Centre for Policy Dialogue (CPD) Mustafizur Rahman said if the projects were implemented in a cost-effective way, the economy would get the benefit.

He, however, insisted on efforts to get the credit from soft loan windows and cautioned against any 'hidden costs'.

He added the first thing is that the negotiations have to be done efficiently and the projects have to be implemented timely and cost-effectively. There will be no problem in debt servicing in that case, he observed.

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functions shall vest in the president and shall be exercised by him in consultation with the Supreme Court."

Anisul said there was a serious apprehension that "it [SC observation on disciplinary rules] might create conflict with the president's power."

"That is why the law ministry is so seriously looking into... There is room for discussion. Had there been no intention to discuss, I would not have submitted the draft to the chief justice."

Referring to Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha, Anisul said sitting in the courtroom, the chief justice talked about getting rid of the High Court.

"Bangabandhu [Sheikh Mujibur Rahman] established the High Court. How can we get rid of the High Court? Is it not irrelevant?" the law minister said.

On Sunday, the SC refused to fully accept the draft rules determining the

discipline of lower court judges, and said the rules were the opposite of the top court's directives.

"And it cannot go on like this," said the chief justice, who was heading a six-member bench of the apex court, during the hearing on the Masdar Hossain case, popularly known as the judiciary separation case.

The law minister met the CJ at his office on Thursday and submitted the draft.

The minister then told reporters that the rules would be sent to the president for approval if the CJ gave consent to those after scrutiny.

Violence mars

Protesters attacked polling stations and barricaded streets around the country on Sunday, drawing a bloody response from security forces, who opened fire with live ammunition in some cases.

Despite the unrest and an opposition boycott, the National Electoral Council said there had been "extraordinary turnout" of more than eight million voters.

Dressed in bright red, his fist clenched and face beaming, Maduro hailed it as a win in a speech to hundreds of cheering supporters in central Caracas early yesterday.

"It is the biggest vote the revolution has ever scored in its 18-year history," he said, referring to the year his late mentor, Hugo Chavez, came to power.

"What the hell do we care what Trump says?"

Members of the new assembly will include his wife Cilia Flores, his pugnacious right-hand man Diosdado Cabello, and other staunch allies.

The socialist president is gambling his four-year rule on the 545-member assembly, which will be empowered to dissolve the opposition-controlled congress and rewrite the constitution.

The European Union voiced concern over the fate of democracy in Venezuela, adding there are "grave doubts" that it can recognise a controversial vote.

Biman cancels

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pilgrims as ferrying those intended hajjis to Saudi Arabia would be difficult for us given the specific number of hajj flights," Mossaddique added.

Of the latest cancelled flights, one was scheduled to fly at 10:25am yesterday and three were scheduled for today, added the Biman boss.

Biman, however, operated three other scheduled hajj flights yesterday carrying more than 1,250 pilgrims, Shakil Meraj, general manager, public relations, Biman, said.

The religious affairs ministry yesterday asked Business Automation Limited, a vendor that provides it with IT services, to give names of the private hajj tour operators who have got visas but failed to send pilgrims on the scheduled dates.

"We will take punitive actions against those hajj agencies who have got visas but yet to take measures to send pilgrims to Saudi Arabia," Abdul Jalil, secretary, religious affairs ministry, told this correspondent over phone.

Hajj officials at Ashkona Hajj Camp said such a situation occurred due to irresponsibility and greediness of the hajj agencies.

Several agencies have yet to strike a deal with the Saudi hajj authorities to rent houses and complete other formalities as they were looking for cheaper options, said a number of Biman and ministry officials.

They alleged that those agencies want to spend less money for house rent, food and other formalities.

"A section of hajj agencies make fortunes from this corrupt process as they want to send hajjis at the eleventh hour to save money from food and accommodation," a former director of Ashkona Hajj Camp and currently involved with Business Automation Limited, told this correspondent.

Another director of the camp said the agencies were waiting to play a dirty game at the end of hajj flights as they would bargain with the government to send pilgrims in replacement quota.

"A section of hajj agencies have registered many fake pilgrims. They will later bargain with the government to send their substitutes mentioning death and serious illness of the fake names," added the director asking not to be identified.

"If they can bring in substitutes, the private tour operators will charge them more money," he added.

The religious affairs ministry said it would take stern action against any hajj agencies if found involved.

Govt to go ahead

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Resources, Power and Ports have demanded the project be scrapped.

They said the government's "propaganda has become clear after the Unesco report came out."

"Earlier, it was said by the government that the Unesco lifted its objection on the construction of the power plant. However, it is clear from the report that no commercial or industrial unit could be set up before the SEA," they said in a statement.

PRESS BRIEFING

Speaking at a press conference at Bidyut Bhaban yesterday, Tawfiq-e-Elahi Chowdhury said the construction of Rampal power plant would go on as "the Unesco has endorsed the government's scientific statement at the 41st session of the World Heritage Committee."

"Necessary infrastructure will also be constructed at the site as per recommendations of the World Heritage Committee of Unesco," he said, reports BSS.

He also said that the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) made it clear that no large-scale infrastructure should be constructed in the plant area before a SEA is conducted in the region.

The government is constructing a 1,320-MW coal-based power plant at Rampal aimed at improving the country's power generation capacity, he said.

"We will carry out the SEA in two years, while a progress report of the SEA would be prepared by 2018. We will also take mitigation measures based on the environmental assessment."

He said the government is also aware of Sundarban's status as a world heritage site, adding, "We will monitor the project as well as the environment closely to take quick mitigation measures."

The government submitted its scientific and logical statement at the 41st session of the World Heritage Committee as an observer of the session, the adviser said.

He also claimed member states of the session supported and raised voice in favour of the scientific statement and then the 21-member committee endorsed it by withdrawing the earlier objection for setting up the plant at its current site.

He added that reports published in many newspapers quoting Unesco and its 41st session's decisions were "confusing" and "misguided".

Power Division Secretary Dr Ahmed Kaikaus, Chairman of Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) Khaled Mahmud and Director General of Power Cell Mohammad Hossain were present during the press conference.

Russia defends

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"But it seems that even if the situation is changing, it's not for any time soon."

Putin's spokesman Dmitry Peskov yesterday insisted that any hopes of mending Russia-US ties rest on "curing the worsening political schizophrenia" in Washington, but admitted the two sides appeared "far away" from any improvement.

He did insist Russia remained keen on "continuing cooperation in the areas that correspond to our interests" suggesting Moscow remains open to working together on Syria after agreeing a ceasefire with the US in the south of the war-torn country.

The US State Department earlier called Moscow's move "regrettable and uncalled for" and said it was "assessing the impact of such a limitation and how to respond."

US Vice President Mike Pence while on a visit to Estonia yesterday said: "We hope for better days, for better relations with Russia."

He stressed that "recent diplomatic action taken by Moscow will not deter the commitment of the United States of America to our security, the security of our allies."

Last Thursday the US Senate overwhelmingly approved a bill to toughen sanctions on Russia for allegedly meddling in the 2016 US presidential election and its intervention in Ukraine. Iran and North Korea are also targeted in the sanctions bill.
