

Press Institute of Bangladesh board formed

The government yesterday formed a new board of directors of the Press Institute of Bangladesh (PIB) with Dainik Samakal Editor Golam Sarwar as its chairman.
This board will act for the next two years with immediate effect, according to a gazette notification issued by the Ministry of Information.

Members of the board include Dr Sakhabat Ali Khan, Md Shab Alamgir, Shyamal Dutta, Alamgir Mahmud, Madhusudan Mondal, Anisul Ghatok Polok, Anisul Islam Khan, Mohammad Latif, Rahman, Md Mizanul Islam, and Swapan Saha. Golam Sarwar was appointed chairman of the board about one and a half years back after the death of the late Dr. Hossain Habibur Rahman Minon.

Rivalry behind

On November 20, 2016, the office of the central assistant secretary of the BCL, which was found hanging from the ceiling of his room near Chittagong University (CU).
The first autopsy report, prepared by Chittagong Medical College Hospital's forensic department, suggested that the death was a suicide. Diaz's family, however, rejected the report.
On November 24, Diaz's mother lodged a murder case with a Chittagong court against around 20 people, including CU assistant professor Anwar Hossain and BCL CU unit president Mohammad Alamgir Tivu.

SCBA asks law minister to say sorry

SC verdict in Masdar Hossain Case, also known as the judiciary separation case.
Barrister AM Mahubul Uddin Khokon, secretary of SCBA, among others, spoke on the occasion.
Reading out a written statement, Advocate Zainul Abedin said the law minister's statements about the chief justice and the conflicting situation between the Appellate Division of the SC and the law ministry over the rules of discipline for lower court judges were not at all conducive to estab-

lishing democracy and the rule of law. The criticism in parliament about the constitutional amendment, judiciary, Appellate Division, and the chief justice was "seriously objectionable and unexpected", the SCBA president said.
He also cited the statement made by Law Minister Anisul Hque, who said on Monday that the SC wanted the power of the president regarding the rules of discipline for lower court judges, provided under Article 116 of the constitution.

"They [SC judges] have revised the rules of [discipline], which show they want the power of the president... How can I give it? You give me a verdict... I cannot give it," he said.
Referring to Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha, the minister said sitting in the courtroom, the chief justice talked about getting rid of the High Court.
"Bangabandhu [Sheikh Mujibur Rahman] established the High Court. How can we get rid of the High Court? Is it not irrelevant?" Anisul said.

Monno to be buried in Manikganj tomorrow

Harunur Rashid Khan Monno, a former minister and adviser to BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia, will be buried in his family graveyard in Manikganj tomorrow afternoon.
He died early yesterday in Manikganj due to old-age complications at the age of 84.
His first namaz-e-janaza will be held on BNP's Nayapalata central office premises around 10:00am today. The body will be kept there for an hour for people to pay their last homage to him.
His second namaz-e-janaza will be held at 11:00am at South Plaza of the Parliament Complex and the third one at 12:30pm on Monno Ceramics Industries Ltd's premises in Dharamai.
Later, his body will be taken to Manikganj where four more zanaza's will be held at different times before his burial tomorrow.

The pioneering industrialist was the chairman of Monno Group of Industries, which included Monno Ceramic, Monno Jute Industries, Monno Fabrics and Monno Atire Ltd.
The Daily Star awarded him lifetime achievement award for the year of 2017 for his contribution to Bangladesh's business sector.
He was elected a member of parliament for three times with BNP nomination. He was made minister most recently after he won two seats in the 2001 election.
He left behind his wife and two daughters.
