

Truck, car crashes kill 5

Three riders of a motorbike were killed as a truck hit it from behind near Ispahani rail gate in Chittagong city early yesterday.

The deceased are Kamrul Islam, 27, of Feni, Md Nizam, 32, of the city's Agrabad area, and Md Rezaul, 30, of Bagerhat, said police.


The accident occurred around 3:30am, said Alamgir Mahmud, officer-in-charge of Akbar Shah Police Station. Nizam and Rezaul were killed on the spot while Kamrul, who was driving the motorcycle, succumbed to his injuries in hospital around 5:00am, he said.

Police seized the truck and arrested its driver and helper.

In Comilla city, a woman and her niece were killed after being run over by a private car.

The deceased are Khadiza Begum, 26, and her niece Jannat, 5, of Chandina upazila. They lived in a rented house in the city.

The car driver was arrested after the accident occurred around 11:00am.

Ctg route permit survey

of 145 registered vehicles plying the EPZ route were present.

The survey on human hauliers operating on 16 different routes was scheduled for August 12, but it was postponed for heavy rain and rescheduled for August 13. The checking of human hauliers running on route 7, 8 and 9 was rescheduled to August 28.

On August 17, only 44.24 percent human hauliers with 10 different routes (4, 5, 6 and 10 to 16) were present.

Human hauliers on the remaining six routes (1, 2, 3, 7, 8 and 9) will be surveyed on rescheduled dates.

Debdas Bhattacharya, additional commissioner (AC) of CMP (Traffic), said the committee had extended dates for checking the remainder of the vehicles that failed to turn up on August 26 and 27.

The survey on "auto tempo" will start on

August 19 and end on August 24.

If the turnout of vehicles does not improve, the committee might extend dates after the Eid-ul-Azha, Debdas said.

"Negligence of vehicle owners and the owners' associations" is the cause of such noncompliance, said Belayet Hossain Belal, secretary of Chittagong Metropolitan Paribahan Malik Group.

The drivers and transport crew are avoiding the survey as they have to wait in long queues, sometimes two hours for one vehicle, and fail to pay the daily amount to vehicle owners as per contract, he added.

There is always an artificial crisis of public transport in the city as the drivers and workers often violate authorised routes and make reserved trips to make a quick buck. This survey would help solve the crisis, Belayet observed.

Sahana filed a general diary with Rampura Police Station on January 20 this year and went back to her father's home in Feni. Police later raided Monir's home, but he managed to escape, said Rob.

On June 6, Sahana came back to her Rampura home after getting an assurance from Monir and his mother that she would not be tortured.

But it was a part of their plan to kill Sahana as Monir's family was angered over the GD, alleged Rob.

"On July 30, they beat my daughter keeping her locked inside a room. Monir then strangled her with a scarf and fled the scene," Rob alleged. He said when Sahana was declared dead at Dhaka Medical College Hospital, Monir's mother also fled the hospital.

A murder case was filed the same day accusing Monir and his mother. Police, however, are yet to make any arrest, saying that the accused are on the run.

Youth jailed for attempted rape

A mobile court sentenced a youth to nine months' imprisonment for attempting to rape a nine-year-old girl in Panchagarh Sadar upazila on Thursday night.

The convict is Kajol, 22, son of Akbar Ali, a neighbour of the victim family.

Police said the youth tried to drag her into an isolated place when the class VI student went to visit a nursery around 7:00pm. Hearing her screams, locals rushed in and caught the youth. Upazila Nirbahi Officer Md Abu Wadud delivered the verdict on the same night.

Two RU staff 'beaten by cops'

Two employees of the transport section of Rajshahi University (RU) were allegedly beaten by two police officers of Paba police in the city on Thursday.

The staff are bus driver Saiful Islam and its supervisor Ashikur Rahman Hira.

M Abul Kalam Azad, supervisor of the university transport section, said Saiful stopped the university bus in Nowhata area for the students to get off in the afternoon. Meherul Islam, sub-inspector of Paba Police Station, in civil dress, asked Saiful to move the vehicle. When Saiful said he cannot do so before the students get off, the SI along with another police official beat them.

Contacted, Parimon Chakrabarty, officer-in-charge of Paba Police Station, said Meherul did not beat them. Meherul asked him to move the bus. When he got out of it carrying a stick, locals beat the duo up.

and bricks, attacked Imran and his activists when they were holding a fund-raiser for the flood victims.

Protesting the attack, the mancha organised a rally at Shahbagh at 4:00pm yesterday. As they sought permission from Shahbagh Police Station for the rally, its officer-in-charge, Abul Hasan, asked them to "come through proper channels", said Imran.

The mancha submitted a letter to the office of Dhaka Metropolitan Police commissioner yesterday, and then submitted a "received" copy of the letter to Shahbagh Police Station.

But as they went to Shahbagh to hold the rally around 4:00pm, the OC of Shahbagh police did not allow them, citing security reasons, he added.

Imran then held a press briefing there instantly. When they were returning after the end of the briefing, they came under attack, he said.

Over Thursday's attack, he said they filed a case with the police station on that night and handed over a mobile phone and a print photograph, which the attackers left while fleeing, yet none was arrested, he added.

"...rather police did not allow us to hold the rally. It seems that the government does not want us to work for the flood victims," Imran said.

After yesterday's attack, Imran wrote on his verified Facebook wall: "Was attacked again before PG hospital while returning from Shahbagh. They won't stop until gagging our voice. The message is clear: You can't speak up if you want to live in this country."

Jafar Ali Biswas, officer in charge (investigation) of Shahbagh Police Station, said Gonojagorom Mancha men including Imran held a "programme" at Shahbagh, and when returning to Paribagh, "some people" threw "guava" at them. "But none was injured...we could not identify the people who threw guava. We are looking into the matter."

The Daily Star could not get a comment from the Shahbagh OC despite repeated attempts.
