

# First aid for road victims

Traumalink launches emergency support on Dhaka-Aricha road

Traumalink, a voluntary organisation providing emergency primary treatment to road accident victims, has now launched its service on the Dhaka-Aricha highway in Manikganj.

During an inauguration ceremony in Manikganj Zila Parishad's auditorium yesterday, Director (operation) of the organisation Esha Chowdhury said they selected 90 trained volunteers who would be deployed on different spots within 20-kilometre between Golora of Saturaia and Mohadevpur of Shivalaya upazila.

The volunteers in uniform will be carrying first-aid kit, she added.

Noted writer and researcher Syed Abul Moksud attended the event through video conference. Even though road accidents decreased in Manikganj after 19 spots were

widened on Dhaka-Aricha highway, many accidents are still occurring there, he added.

Deputy Director of Manikganj Local Government Md Abdul Motin, Medical Officer of Manikganj Government Hospital Dr Uttam Kumer Sarker, Officer-in-Charge of Golora Highway Police Station Mohammad Habibur Rahman and Traumalink's Medical Advisor Abdul Baki, and its Programme Manager Arup Saha also spoke.

The service launched on Dhaka-Aricha highway named "death trap" deserves appreciation, the participants said.

The organisation launched its first service on 19-kilometre highway in Daudkandi of Comilla on November 23, 2014. At least 484 victims have been given first-aid till now.

They will also launch a team on 15-kilometre highway in Chandia of Comilla on August 27, Esha said.

# CMP seeks 2,500 new members, 7 police stations

Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) sent a proposal to the police headquarters asking for 2,488 new police members and establishing seven new police stations in the port city in a bid to provide better service to people.

The additional force was sought mainly for the proposed seven police stations and a full-fledged counter terrorism unit, said CMP sources.

In the proposal sent in late July, the CMP sought for an additional commissioner for the detective branch, two deputy commissioners -- one for counter terrorism unit and another for public order management, said a high official of CMP.

Besides, four additional deputy commissioners, eight assistant commissioners, 56 inspectors, 17 traffic and patrol inspectors, 500 sub-inspectors and assistant sub-inspectors and 1,900 constables were sought, said CMP sources.

A similar proposal was sent in March last year asking for 17,154 new members but it is yet to get a positive nod from the headquarters. So, this time CMP sent a new proposal, downsizing the requirement.

In February 2013, the CMP sent a proposal to police headquarters asking for 5,155 forces and the government made 1,269 appointments in June 2015. It was the last massive recruitment in CMP, said sources.

Contacted, Masood-ul-Hasan, additional commissioner (admin and finance) of CMP, said the previous proposal of recruiting over 17,000 new members was "under process".

At present, CMP has 16 police stations and over 7,000 police members, he said.

Masood said seven new police stations -- Fatehabad, Shikabaha, Bhatiyar, Kattali, Parki, Bara Uthan and Ananya -- had been proposed.

"We need more police stations, particularly some for remote areas", he added.

Contacted, Saleh Mohammad Tanvir, additional commissioner (crime and operation) of CMP, said the ratio between the numbers of police members and the city dwellers is too high.

# Justice Mamtaz Press Council chairman again

and order situation during the election as law enforcement agencies in the country are very much politically biased.

Shujan President M Hafiz Uddin Khan said Bangladesh has already turned into a country like North Korea as the people do not have freedom of speech at present. "We don't have any voice at present."

Imran [Gonojagoron Mancha spokesperson Imran H Sarker] recently mentioned rightfully that we don't have any freedom of speech if we want to live in the country... We can rid ourselves of the situation if we can establish democracy in the country."

"We need a serious movement to regain democratic atmosphere in the country," he also said.

Justice Kazi Ebadul Hoque said the Election Commission should make rules to ban some outdoor campaign methods including setting up of archways on roads, putting up of posters and banners and using loudspeakers in the election.

Former election commissioner Brig Gen (ret'd) Sakhawat Hussain said theoretically Bangladesh Election Commission is more powerful than any other election commission in South Asian countries including India. In spite of this, holding a free and fair election is not being possible due to the present political culture in the country.

Sakhawat said in many cases, members of law enforcement agencies, especially the police and the Rapid Action Battalion, stand in the way of holding a free and fair election as they are highly biased and partisan.

If there is a political will, holding of an acceptable election with a few minor hitches is possible under any political government, he observed.

Dhaka University professor Asif Nazrul and columnist Syed Abul Maksud, among others, criticised the government for its misuse and curtailing democratic space in the country.
