Ivy Rahman's 13th death anniversary today

The 13th death anniversary of Ivy Rahman, former president of Bangladesh Mahila Awami League and wife of late President Zillur Rahman, will be observed today in a befitting manner. To mark the day, different political and socio-cultural organisations, including Bangladesh Awami League (AL), its associate bodies and other like-minded organisations have chalked out elaborate programmes. The programmes included placing wreaths and offering fatiha at her (Ivy) grave at Banani graveyard in the capital, arranging mauli mahfil and special prayers, and holding discussions in Dhaka and elsewhere. Central leaders of Awami League and its associate bodies will pay tributes to Ivy Rahman by placing wreaths at the Banani graveyard at 8:00am. AL General Secretary Obaidul Qader urged all members of AL central executive committee, advisory council and associate bodies to attend the programmes. Ivy Rahman received grievous injuries during a grisly grenade attack on an AL rally at Babubhata Avenue in the capital on August 21 in 2004 and succumbed to her injuries on August 24.

Nayakrazz laid to rest

 On a rainy August morning, a small motorcade left the Gulshan's Lokhikunjo residence and pushed past the weekday traffic to head towards Banani, taking the undisputed emperor of Bangladeshi cinema for one last ride, to lay him to final rest. Razzak was buried yesterday at around 10:15am at the Banani graveyard, drenched in people's love. The burial had been postponed earlier in wait for his second son Bappy, who flew in from Canada. An army of fans and well-wishers braved the gloomy weather, as family members and Razzak's colleagues from the film fraternity reached the graveyard. His three sons carried the body, along with film actor Shakib Khan and others. After the burial and a brief prayer, Razzak's youngest son Samrat thanked the film fraternity, media, and law enforcement agencies for their love and support. He also informed that his father's khalihani would be held on Friday at Gulshan's Azad Mosque after the Asr prayers. Fondly known to millions of fans across generations as Nayakrazz, Razzak passed away on Monday evening at the capital's United Hospital following a heart attack. He was 75 years old.



16TH AMENDMENT VERDICT National discussion not taking place

 Noted rights activist Barrister Sara Hossain yesterday said there is hardly any rational discussion on the verdict of 16th constitutional amendment. Instead of having any logical discussion, people are expressing their emotions, she said at a dialogue organized by Bangladesh Debate Federation (DBF) at Bishwo Shahitto Kendro in the capital. Sara Hossain's comment came at a time when Awami League leaders severely criticised the verdict and many of them sought resignation of Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha while BNP leaders welcomed the verdict. The Supreme Court on August 1 released the full text of its verdict, scrapping the 16th amendment to the constitution on August 24.

'Neo JMB' killed Noakhali shrine caretaker

 A counterterrorism investigator has claimed that the recent killing of a caretaker (khadem) of a shrine in Noakhali was an act of "Neo JMB", the offshoot of the two youths, caught by local forces with two militancy recently killed "Neo JMB" militants. Locals captured suspected killers Elias, 22, and Sujon, 24, soon after the caretaker of Azal Patwari's Mazar in Sonaimuri was hacked to death on August 16. Other than local police, DMP's Counter Terrorism and Transnational Crime (CTTC) unit is also running a shadow investigation. The CTTC official said Elias used to be a friend of "Neo JMB" militants lobbyist Hossain and Ashraful Alam Nazim. Hossain was killed in the Kalyanpur raid on July 26 last year and Nazim in the Moulavibazar raid on March 31 this year. The official said the "Neo JMB" ordered Elias to kill the caretaker. Superintendent of Noakhali Police Elias Sharif yesterday said it was an act of JMB. One of the arrestees, Sujon, already confessed to the killing. Four hours after the murder, a Facebook account under the name of "Sumon Kibria" claimed the killing. Police are interrogating one Golam Rasul alias Sumon as the account was created under his name.

DEFAMATION CASE HC stays trial of Fakhru

 The High Court yesterday stayed the trial proceedings of a defamation case filed against BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir in 2014. After hearing a petition filed by Fakhru, the HC also issued a rule asking the government to explain why the proceedings of the case against him should not be scrapped. On September 1 of 2014, Nur-e-Alam Siddique, vice-president of Awami Matsyaji League, filed the case. In the case, the AL leader alleged that Fakhru on August 24, 2014 at a press conference termed the ruling AL a "killer party" and its chief a "killer". Fakhru's lawyer Sagor Hossain Leon told The Daily Star.

BOAT HIT BY LIGHTNING IN SAVAR RIVER 4 more bodies recovered

 Four more bodies were recovered from the Bongsi river in Savar, outside the capital, yesterday, a day after a thunderbolt struck an engine-run boat in the river. With those, the death toll now stands at six. The dead are Shenoti Rani, 25, wife of Madhub Chandro, Mahela Begum, 36, wife of Raju Mia, Hosne Ara, 30, wife of Jhaledul Islam, and Depu Lal Debnath, 32, son of Mohonal Debnath. All the four worked at Akhtar Furnishers Ltd. Senior Station Officer of Savar Fire Service, Ligon Ahmed, said informed by locals they recovered the bodies. A passenger named Rebeka Begum is still missing. Ligon said, quoting locals. On Tuesday around 7:30am, the thunderbolt struck the vessel carrying around 150 passengers in Katapur Gudara Ghat area. Two persons died on the spot, 25 others were injured and five went missing. Sheikh Rasel Hasan, upazila nirbahi officer of Savar, said families of the dead already got Tk 20, 000 each from the Dhaka district administration. The search operation continued till last evening.

REPATRIATION OF ILLEGAL BANGLADESHIS EU team arrives Aug 29 to finalise decisions

 A high-level European Union delegation will arrive in the capital on August 29 to conclude negotiations on repatriation of thousands of undocumented Bangladeshi immigrants living in 28 EU member countries. Bangladesh is one of the top 30 countries which has over one lakh citizens apprehended and found to be illegally living in the EU countries. Expressing regrets at "lack of progress" in return of the illegal Bangladeshis at the eighth joint commission meeting on July 12 in Brussels, it issued an ultimatum to the Bangladesh government to end the negotiations on the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) by end of July. Following the warning, Dhaka on July 26 finalised the terms and conditions for the return of irregular migrants from the EU and agreed to bring back all its irregular nationals through a nationality verification process within a "logical time."

The EU delegation, comprising high officials of EU Foreign Service and the Directorate General for Migration and Home Affairs (DG HOME), will go for extensive negotiation on the draft SOPs submitted to the Bangladesh government in June 2016, and the amended drafts finalised by Bangladesh on July 26, 2017. Foreign Secretary Md Shahidul Haque will lead Bangladesh's delegation, including senior officials of foreign and home ministries. The two-day meeting will finalise the terms and conditions in detail. The two sides may sign a deal on SOPs. Even though the EU has not yet given any specific number of the irregular migrants, an Eurostat claimed that the number of Bangladeshi citizens apprehended and found to be illegally present in the EU from 2008 to 2016 is 104,575. While, another EU data claimed that the first 100 days of 2017 saw 4,645 Bangladeshis illegally arrived in Italy.
