# Article blocked SQ Chy's election as OIC chief

## Ex-diplomat Momen tells launch of his book, 'Bangladesh Marching Forward'

Former Bangladesh Permanent Representative to the United Nations AK Abdul Momen yesterday said one of his writings had a significant impact on stopping the election of executed war criminal and BNP leader Salauddin Quader Chowdhury as secretary-general of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC).

The then BNP-led government nominated SQ Chowdhury for the position in the 2004 OIC election, he told the launching ceremony of his new book, "Bangladesh Marching Forward", which incorporated the article, at the Bangla Academy.

"I protested the Bangladesh government decision and wrote the article citing the nominee as a controversial person, war criminal and accused in several criminal cases," he said.

Momen, who was living in Saudi Arabia back then, said the article was published in several international newspapers including the Arab News and Saudi Gazette.

He handed over the article to different OIC member state ambassadors after inviting them to his residence and also requested several Muslim nations including Saudi Arabia to oppose the Bangladesh nominee.

"It had a very good impact," he said, adding, "Then I could realise that the pen is mightier than the sword."

Meanwhile, currency screening machines were installed in some of the cattle markets in the city and the district with a view to checking the use of fake notes in the markets.

Chittagong Metropolitan Police officials said all necessary measures were taken to maintain law and order in and around the cattle markets.

CMP has also taken measures so that the cattle markets are not set up on roads and streets disrupting vehicular movement and strengthened the traffic management system in order to ease traffic congestions around cattle markets they added.

"The district police have installed temporary security camps at every cattle market in the city while patrol teams and plainclothes police were deployed in the cattle markets," said Reazul Masud, additional superintendent of police of Chittagong district.

Cyber Tracker will record their activities. During the drive, the team can even take help from different law enforcement agencies, said the sources.

Now, the entire mangrove forest is not under telephone and internet network coverage. If it comes under internet service, it will be possible to monitor the activities of smart patrolling team directly.

Meanwhile, sources at the forest department said the patrolling activities are being hampered due to an insufficient budget.

They cited that Tk 10 lakh has been allocated for this sector in the current fiscal year. On the other hand, it costs about Tk 1.5 lakh for each drive, which means the total budget covers only seven days' costs.

However, the sources expected that additional allocation will be granted for the project.

Earlier in 2016, a smart patrolling project began in four ranges of the Sundarbans with patrolling group formed under the World Bank-funded "Strengthening Regional Cooperation for Wildlife Protection" project.

The project used to check wildlife in more than 140 geographical sites in 31 countries. It is also a familiar system in the forests of neighbouring countries -- India, Nepal and Thailand.

RAIL

Visiting Kamalapur Railway Station yesterday, this correspondent found many people already started leaving the city.

Sitangshu Chakraborty, station manager of Kamalapur Railway Station, said people who bought advance tickets on August 18, will leave Dhaka today (Sunday).

"We've taken all out preparations and till today, the train schedule is almost okay," he said.

Yesterday, the scheduled trip of Khulna-bound Sundarbans Express was cancelled as rail communication between Khulna and the rest of the country remained suspended for around 11 hours since Friday night due to derailment of a train.

The communication, however, was restored from yesterday morning.

Besides, Sylhet-bound Jayantika Express and Joydevpur commuter trains were running behind the schedule yesterday, he said.

ROAD

GM Shaheed, vice-chairman of Bangladesh Bus-Truck Owners' Association, said people already started leaving the capital. However, the main pressure will be on this Thursday and Friday.

Several highways including Dhaka-Chittagong and Dhaka-Tangail are already experiencing heavy traffic; the misery will be boundless if it rains now, he said.

Due to bad road conditions, almost all major bus operators already slashed the number of trips, he added.

Mosharrif Hossain, general manager of Hanif Paribahan, said passengers are suffering immensely as buses need to wait for five to six hours before boarding a ferry at Paturia-Daulatdia ferry docks.

Strong current in the river, inadequate numbers of ferries and a large number of cattle-laden trucks are the reasons behind the delay, he said.

RIVER

Badiuzzaman Badal, senior vice-chairman of Bangladesh Inland Waterways (passenger carriers) Association, said the main pressure of passengers will start from Thursday noon, when garment factories will be closed for the holidays.

"There will be a huge rush of passengers on Thursday and Friday as there's only one day leave before the Eid."
