

YOUTH EXCHANGE PROGRAMME 150 students to visit China this month

A 150-member student delegation from Bangladesh will pay a two-week visit to Yunnan Province under the China-Bangladesh Youth Exchange Programme.

The visit is going to take place following Chinese President Xi Jinping's announcement during his visit to Bangladesh in 2016 that China will invite 600 Bangladeshi students to China during 2016-2020. This is the first visit that will begin from September 11.

The Chinese embassy in Dhaka organised the visit with cooperation from the Yunnan University in Kunming and Confucius Institutes in Dhaka with an objective to strengthen cultural and people-to-people exchanges and carry forward the friendship between the two countries.

Members of the delegation, drawn from various educational institutions will visit prominent cultural and historical sites, top educational institutions across the Yunnan Province and are expected to call on the prominent figures there.

Ahead of their departure, a flagging off ceremony was held at the Chinese embassy in Dhaka yesterday, where Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique attended as the chief guest. Chinese Ambassador Ma Mingqiang also spoke at the event.

BNP extends time to recruit new members

The BNP yesterday extended time for one month to collect new members and renewal of memberships as it failed to recruit one crore new members by September 1, said Ruhul Kabir Rizvi, party's senior joint secretary general at a press conference at the party's Nayapalton headquarters in the capital.

According to BNP central office, the party has so far sold 60.56 lakh party membership forms and earned over Tk 6 crore by selling it at Tk 10 each.

They said they could not carry out the drive due to flood in 27 districts, inclement weather, intra-party conflicts and obstruction by police and ruling party activists.

She also asked each and every BCL member to get educated properly so that they could build the nation and take the future leadership.

"Right education is very much necessary as we've already seen that an uneducated leadership can do much harm to the country -- we saw Bangladesh plunged into terrorism, militancy, looting and money laundering (during the tenure of BNP-Jamaat)."

Referring to the remarks of Bangabandhu on BCL that the history of BCL is the history of the Bengalees, Hasina advised the BCL leaders and workers not to forget these words.

"I'll ask all the BCL leaders and workers to continue to take proper education, and there will be no progress if there is no peace. I want peaceful environment prevails in the country so that we can move towards prosperity..."

Hasina said whenever any natural disaster hit the country she always motivated the

leaders and workers of AL and its other associate organisations to stand beside the affected people for the cause of humanity.

"This is the duty of AL and was also the ideology of the father of the nation. You'll have to remain prepared with this ideology of Bangabandhu."

Recalling the role of Bangamata Sheikh Fazilatunnesa Mujib in the life of Bangabandhu, Hasina, their eldest daughter, said the father of the nation could work for the country without any interference since her mother made huge sacrifices.

Earlier, a minute of silence was observed remembering the martyrs of August 15 and the August 21 grenade attack.

The prime minister also unveiled the cover of a publication of BCL.

Chaired by BCL president Saifur Rahman Sohagh, the meeting was conducted by its general secretary SM Zakir Hossain.

AL general secretary Obaidul Quader was present on the occasion.

Abdul Jabbar inspired people through his songs from Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendra during the 1971 Liberation War. Jabbar received many prestigious awards. He won, among others, Bangabandhu Swarna Padak (1973), Ekushey Padak (1980), Shadhinata Padak (1996), Zahir Raihan Chalachitra Purashkar, BACHSAS Award and Mother Teresa Award.

Born in Kushtia, Jabbar first took music lessons from Ustad Osman Gani and Ustad Lutful Haque. He became an enlisted singer at Bangladesh Betar (radio) in 1958 and Bangladesh Television (BTV) in 1964.

BNP's founding anniversary today

BNP celebrates its 39th founding anniversary today.

To mark the occasion, BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir along with senior leaders would place wreaths and offer prayers at Ziaur Rahman's grave in the capital this morning. A discussion will be held later in the afternoon.

Party Chairperson Khaleda Zia, who is now in London, in a statement issued yesterday on the occasion, alleged that the country's independence and sovereignty are at stake.

"...BNP has been waging movements to remove peoples' sufferings, protect the country's independence and sovereignty and restore multiparty democracy."

"Now our target is to restore people's voting rights and... ensuring freedom of expression."

Late Maj Gen Ziaur Rahman founded the party in 1978 while he was in power, in an apparent move to consolidate his rule.

After Zia's assassination in 1981, Abdus Sattar-led BNP government remained in power for a brief period.

HM Ershad, an army chief-turned-president, seized power in a military coup on March 24, 1982, ousting the elected government of President Abdus Sattar.

After nine years movement against the Ershad's autocratic rule, BNP again came to power under the leadership of Khaleda following resignation of the autocratic government of Ershad in 1990.

The party later also came to power in 2001 for a five-year term.

Country's one of the two major political parties, BNP kept out of parliament for the first time in 2014 since restoration of democracy in 1991 as it boycotted the national election under the Awami League-led government held on January 5, 2014.
