President to lead Bangladesh team at first ever OIC tech summit

President Abdul Hamid will lead Bangladesh delegation at "The First Summit of the OIC on Science and Technology" to be held in Astana, Kazakhstan on September 10-11.

The delegation includes the officials from the Office of the President, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Science and Technology. It would be the first ever summit of OIC in the area of science and technology.

The summit is expected to discuss and adopt OIC Ten Year Action Plan on Science and Technology -- "OIC STI Agenda 2026," said a foreign ministry press release yesterday.

First return hajj flight arrives

The first return hajj flight of this year reached Shahjalal International Airport safely last night.

Shakil Meraj, managing director (PR) of Bangladesh Biman Airlines, said that the state-run carrier carried some 420 hajj pilgrims and arrived in the airport safely around 8:30pm.

He also said Biman Bangladesh Airlines would conduct a total of 169 flights till October 5 to carry the pilgrims back home.

Earlier, Biman Bangladesh Airlines carried some 54,873 hajj pilgrims to Saudi Arabia through 187 flights.

Woman fatally run over by train

Foreign minister hopes for Bimstec boost

Foreign Minister AH Mahmood Ali has expressed the hope that the Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (Bimstec) would get a boost as all members are now showing keen interests in its process.

He was meeting with outgoing Bimstec Secretary General Sumith Nakandala who paid a farewell call on him in Dhaka yesterday.

Nakandala highly praised Bangladesh government for all-out support in smooth function and operation of the secretariat established in Bangladesh in 2014.

Ports, border points to get container scanners

For faster inspection, security, cost minimisation

The government has planned to install container scanners at the country's ports and border points to ensure security and proper revenue collection.

Nine container scanning systems will be procured with Chinese grant assistance, official sources said.

Economic Relations Division (ERD) Deputy Secretary AKM Matiuur Rahman has sent a letter to Li Guangjun, economic and commercial counsellor of the Chinese embassy in Dhaka in this regard on August 28, seeking the grant assistance.

The letter says the total estimated cost of the proposed project was \$34.83 million, out of which \$7.83 million would come from the national exchequer and the remaining \$27 million as grant from China.

According to the letter, Bangladesh has to comply with Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC), which was ratified by Bangladesh in 2012. Bangladesh also ratified WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement-2013 in 2016 which requires replacement of physical inspection by non-intrusive ones.

Under the circumstances, Bangladesh Customs is obliged to install scanners at the ports for quick clearance of goods through customs as 100 percent physical inspection is arduous and time-consuming. In view of that, the Bangladesh government is interested to procure nine container scanning systems for installation at its ports and border points," Matiuur mentioned in his letter.

The main objectives of the proposed project are to ensure correct revenue collection, trade facilitation and security and safety of the country at the border points and to comply with the Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC).

The National Board of Revenue (NBR) has already brought four customs stations including a new land port station, a new sea port, and a new inland container depot in the container scanning system to reduce clearing time, enhance trade facilitation, and combat threat against trade and national security.

Talking to the news agency, an NBR official said security was now a great global concern while quick customs clearance was the demand of the time.

The Myanmar government should take back their citizens from Bangladesh and peace should be established in Arakan State of Myanmar, the minister said.

Replying to a query of journalists, Tofail said time has not come yet to cut off trade relations with Myanmar as did the Maldives.

Rather, the minister said the issue of severing trade relations with Myanmar over the Rohingya crisis, is a very big issue. The minister did not elaborate further.

He criticised the role of Nobel Laureate Aung San Suu Kyi in Rohingya crisis. The minister called upon the global leaders to put pressure on Myanmar government to stop the ongoing genocide on Rohingyas.

No civilised nation supports such genocide, said the minister, adding that Indonesia, Malaysia, the Maldives and Turkey had already expressed concern on Rohingya issue.
