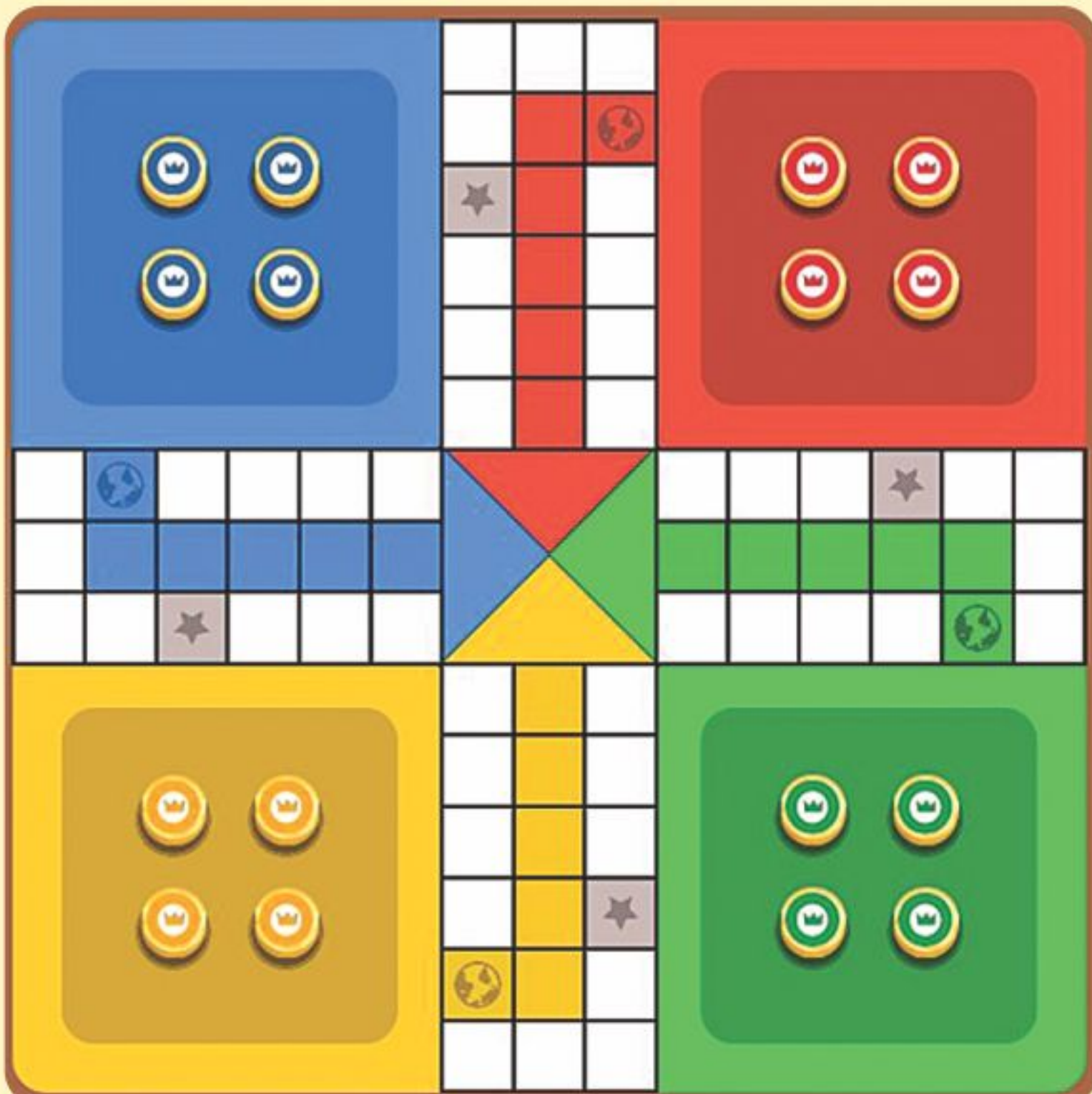

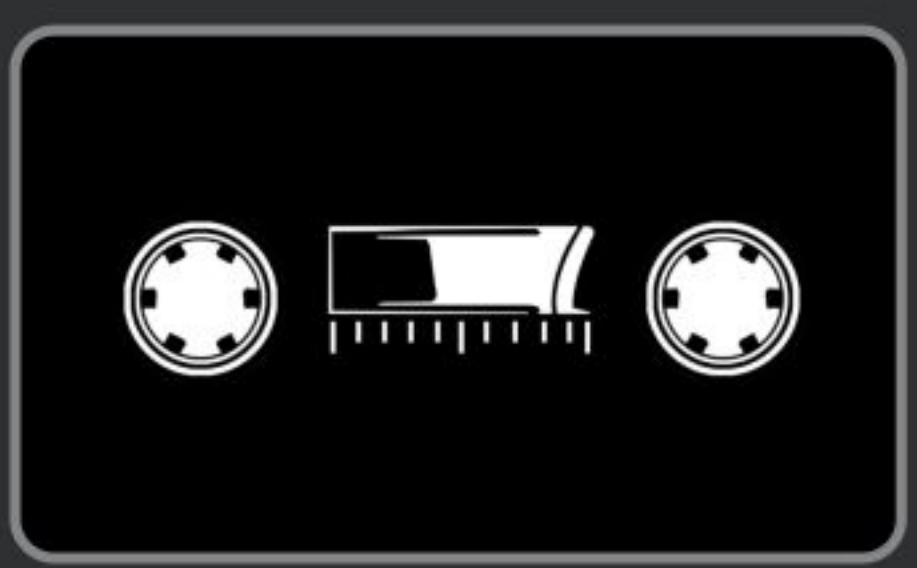


LUDO STAR THE LEGEND RETURNS
