# Punish killers of 3 Santals, return ancestral lands

### Ethnic people demand at Gaibandha rally, submit memo to DC

Ethnic Santals yesterday brought out a procession in the town demanding return of their forefathers' lands in Shahebganj sugarcane farm area under Rangpur Sugar Mills and punishment of the people involved in killing three Santals and torching homes of a large number of people of the indigenous community in November last year.

The procession joined by hundreds of males and females paraded different roads of the town and they later handed over a memorandum to Gaibandha deputy commissioner (DC) with their seven-point demand.

Lajava Adivasi Parishad, Bagda Farm Bhumi Uddhar Sangram Committee, Advahani Sanghati Parishad, Bangladeshi Adivasi Union

and Jano Udyog jointly organised the programme.

The demonstration faced police barricade at the entrance of the deputy commissioner's office. Later they held a protest meeting there demanding immediate implementation of their demand.

Santal leaders alleged that police detained many of their people and seized their spears, bows and arrows at different points, when they were coming from Gobindganj for handing over memorandum to the DC as part of their agitation.

The speakers at the programme demanded exemplary punishment of police personnel involved in killing three Santal men and setting fire to their sheds during the eviction drive in Shahebganj sugarcane farm area on November 6 last year.

On that day, police joined by locals attacked Santal dwellings in Shahebganj sugarcane farm area.

Three Santal men were killed, over 1500 makeshift houses of the community were torched and household articles looted during the incident, the speakers said.

They also demanded trial of Gaibandha-4 lawmaker Abul Kalam Azad and Shakil Ahmed Bulbul, chairman of Sapmara union parishad in Gobindganj for their alleged involvement in the incident.

Rahindranath Soren, president of Jatya Adivasi Parishad, Philimon Baske, vice-president of Bhumi Uddhar Committee, and Shajahan Ali, its secretary, handed over memorandum to Gaibandha DC Gautom Chandra Pal and the latter assured sending it to the higher authorities.

# BNP to take

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The CEC was addressing a views exchange meeting with the district administration at the deputy commissioner's office.

He said, "We held talks with different political parties and they have suggested deployment of army during the polls. We will decide about it once we conclude the talks."

In reply to a query, Huda said the Rohingyas will be on a high alert so that no Rohingyas could be enlisted as voters.

"Besides, discussion was going on about involving the commission in the registration of the Rohingyas refugees in biometric method," he said.

The CEC told these to journalists after holding the views exchange meeting chaired by Helaluddin Ahmed, acting secretary of the Election Commission Secretariat.

The meeting was attended by election officials from 16 districts.

Seeking permission for carrying out DNA tests. The court granted the permission to law enforcers.

The charge sheet in the Rupa murder case would be submitted to the court after receiving the DNA test report, added Kaiyum, also the investigating officer of the case.

Sauful Islam Khan, resident medical officer at Kganj General Hospital, submitted the autopsy report to the Tangal civil surgeon on Tuesday.

Police on August 25 recovered the body of an unidentified woman from near Tangail-Mymensingh road in Tangail's Madhupur upazila. The following day, the body was buried at the Tangail central graveyard after carrying out an autopsy.

Seeing news in different media, Rupa's family members went to Madhupur Police Station on August 28. They saw clothes and photographs of the victim and identified her.

The next day, law enforcers picked up five staff of a bus from Madhupur. The arrestees during interrogation admitted their involvement in the crime.

The Senior Judicial Magistrate's Court in Tangal on August 29 and 30 recorded their confessional statements under section 164 of the CrPc and sent them to jail.

Following a court order, police on August 31 exhumed Rupa's body from the grave and handed it over to her family. The victim was later buried at her village in Srirangpur's Tarash upazila.

# BCG vaccine, antibiotic can cause impotence

### Netherlands professor tells Nilphamari seminar on leprosy

Researchers at a seminar here yesterday said immunological complications and side effects of some particular drugs taken by the patients suffering from leprosy can cause impotence.

Leprosy is a chronic infection disease caused by bacteria. The leprosy patients usually take BCG vaccine and Rifampicin antibiotic.

They said this at a seminar on leprosy at the Training Centre of The Leprosy Mission International, Bangladesh

(TLM) in Nilphamari town.

Prof Dr Annemieke Geluk of Immune Diagnostics and Tuberculosis Department at Leiden University, Netherlands, said consuming BCG vaccine and Rifampicine antibiotic can cause impotence in leprosy patients.

During the programme, researchers from home and abroad shared their experiences regarding their findings on different branches of their research work on leprosy patients.

They also focused on the safety of

the affected people (relatives and using a variety of modern footwear to prevent spreading of leprosy ulcers.

Presided by TLMIB Country Director Solomon Sun Haldar, Rangpur Divisional Director (health) Dr Mohammad Mozammel attended the seminar as the chief guest.

International researchers Prof Dr Annemieke Geluk and Prof Dr H Richardus of Public Health and Infectious Diseases at Leiden University were present as key speakers.
