In HSC/ equivalent examination, applicants must have obtained minimum 'A' grade in any two subjects from Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, English and Biology with minimum 'B' grade in rest of the subjects. c. Applicants with GCE must have passed minimum five subjects in O-Level including Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry and minimum two subjects in A-Level including Mathematics and Physics. Applicants of Oceanography must also have Biology in A-Level. However, an applicant having more than two 'C' grades in O-Level and/or more than one 'C' grade in A-Level shall be ineligible for admission.	a. Field Epidemiology Training Program- Frontline, Bangladesh

The Institute of Epidemiology, Disease Control and Research (IEDCR), and US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) jointly invite application for the next batch(es) of the **Field Epidemiology Training Program- Frontline Bangladesh**. Which is going to be started in the 3rd week of October 2017.

To expand public health workforce capabilities at the local level US CDC launched FETP- Frontline in 2015. In Bangladesh, FETP- Frontline course started in March 2016 and **82 candidates have graduated in 4 batches**. The **two months** hands on intensive training program including classroom sessions and field exercise. The field exercises are designed in between the classroom session where the trainees will perform this activity in their own posting place (along with their regular responsibilities). Government doctors and veterinarians working at upazila level are encouraged to apply to increase the capacity and knowledge regarding surveillance and responding to disease outbreaks and other public health threats.

1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) towards the cost of "Cross Border Road Network Improvement Project". It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for: **Construction of 4-Lane Kalna Bridge (Nielsen Lohse Arch type) on AH1 along with construction of long access road and installation of toll collection system with toll booths-Package No. A1.**

2. The Roads and Highways Department (RHD), Road Transport and Highways Division, Ministry of Road Transport and Bridges (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Employer") now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion of Contract Package No: A1 (referred to as "Works"). The scope of works comprising of components for bridge and access roads connecting corridor includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Construction of 4-lane Kalna Bridge (Nielsen Lohse Arch type) and PC-I girder with 690m in length on AH1,
- Construction of 4-lane 4.3km in length access roads on AH1,
- Construction of computerized tollgate and Toll Collection System (TCS) installation with toll plaza & administration building,
- Procurement of operation & maintenance vehicles and device i.e. 1-heavy vehicle, 2-utility vehicles and maintenance device.

Bidding will be conducted through procedures in accordance with the applicable Guidelines for Procurement under Japanese ODA Loans, and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries, as defined in the Loan Agreement. The bidders must have experience in constructing Bridges of Nielsen Lohse and PC-Girder and Road works in fulfillment of the qualification criteria.

1. The economy of Bangladesh has achieved significant economic progress since independence. In recent years the country has been able to maintain impressive track record on economic growth and overall development. Bangladesh has the potential to grow at an even faster rate.

2. "Digital Bangladesh" is a part of the government's Vision 2021 which promises a prosperous and equitable middle-income Bangladesh. Digital Bangladesh proposes empowerment of the people, transparency and accountability, human resource development, poverty alleviation and economic growth which will ensure better, faster public services.

3. Power sector will play a significant role in developing the overall economy of Bangladesh. However sectorial efficiencies, price levels and service standards will remain a challenge for the sector going forward.

4. The main aim of ICT development in the Bangladesh power sector is to bring the government services to the 'citizen's doorsteps' and enable centralized monitoring of Key Performance Indicators (KPI) of utilities for faster decision making. 7. ERP Vendor must have been in the field of ERP software business for a minimum of ten (10) years (Documentary proof required).

8. ERP Vendor shall demonstrate average annual business turnover of at least USD 10 billion from software business in each of the last ten (10) years. (Documentary proof required).

9. ERP Vendor shall demonstrate availability of liquid assets of at least USD 1 billion. (Documentary proof required).

10. ERP Vendor and Implementation Partner must have legal presence in Bangladesh for post-Implementation support. (Documentary proof required).
