# Swiss aid for Rohingya, flood victims

### Uzbekistan to follow suit

Switzerland will contribute 1.2 million Swiss francs, roughly Tk 10.2 crore, as emergency humanitarian assistance for the Rohingya refugees and the flood affected people in Bangladesh.

The contribution will be given through the Swiss Development Cooperation (SDC) Humanitarian Aid, according to a press release of the Swiss embassy in Dhaka yesterday.

Out of this contribution, 1 million francs will be used to provide life-saving support and respond to the

immediate needs of the Rohingyas who have recently arrived in Bangladesh.

The priority support areas are food security, shelter, water and sanitation. Switzerland is closely monitoring this humanitarian crisis and envisions scaling up its humanitarian assistance to meet the emergency needs of the new arrivals.

Switzerland has also decided to provide Swiss francs 200,000 to support the flood affected people in Bangladesh.

Uzbekistan, meanwhile, will provide humanitarian assistance for about 50,000 Rohingyas taking shelter in the makeshift camps of Cox's Bazar.

The assistance includes 14 types of food and other essentials, including puffed rice, sugar, beaten rice, peanut, milk powder, energy biscuit, mosquito net, sari, lungi, blanket, T-shirt, pants, sandals, basic medicines and mineral water.

Representatives of Uzbekistan in Bangladesh will hand over the assistance to the officials of Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BRCS) at its headquarters today for distribution among the Rohingyas, BRCS said in a press release.

# Detectives arrest 'four fraudsters'

The Detective Branch (DB) of Dhaka Metropolitan Police yesterday claimed to have arrested four members of a fraud gang, who were allegedly involved in forging seals of ministries and police clearance documents.

Moslem Mia, 35, was arrested in the capital's Dainik Bangla area, Shah Alam Kabir, 42, and Ashikur Rahman, 23, in Shani Akhra, and Md Abdur Rahim, 28 in Jatiya Press Club area.

The fraudsters mainly targeted people with little education, who look for police clearance certificates to work abroad, said Mir Muddasser Hossain, deputy commissioner of Serious Crime Investigation (SCI) Division of DB.

He said the gang members used to collect Tk 10,000 for providing a fake certificate, while the actual government fee for the certificate was only Tk 500.

The SCI members seized over 800 forms with the Bangladesh government logo, 1,612 fake police clearance documents, 617 seals of ministries and other government, non-government and police officials.

The DB official also claimed the detainees confessed to their crimes.

A case was filed with Jatrabari Police Station.

# 3 murdered in Dhaka

Three people including a businessman were killed in the capital's Badda and Mirpur yesterday.

In Badda, Abdul Awal, 55, owner of Liva Pharmacy on Satarkul road, was attacked with scissors allegedly by his employee, Fakhru, 20. The incident took place around 1:00pm following an altercation between them, as the employee sold a medicine at Tk 110 instead of Tk 120, said Nazrul Islam, inspector (investigation) of Badda Police Station.

Awal was taken to a local hospital where doctors declared him dead. Locals caught and handed him over to police.

In Borobagh area of Mirpur, an elderly woman was stabbed to death with a kitchen knife allegedly by a rickshaw puller early yesterday. Sabiha Begum, 65, was murdered as she prevented the rickshaw puller from having an extramarital affair with one of her daughters, Lokkhi, 33, at her home, said OC Nazrul Islam of Mirpur Police Station.

The elderly woman used to live in the house with her another daughter, Ruma, a garment worker, while Lokkhi lived in another house in Mirpur. "Lokkhi used to often take the rickshaw puller to the house when Ruma was outside, at work," the OC said. Police were looking for the killer.

Meanwhile, Taslima Sultana Eva, 40, was beaten to death allegedly by her husband at her residence in East Manipur area yesterday afternoon. Police arrested the husband, Moniruzzaman Babu. Quoting neighbours, the OC said the husband hit Taslima in the head with an iron rod over a family feud.
