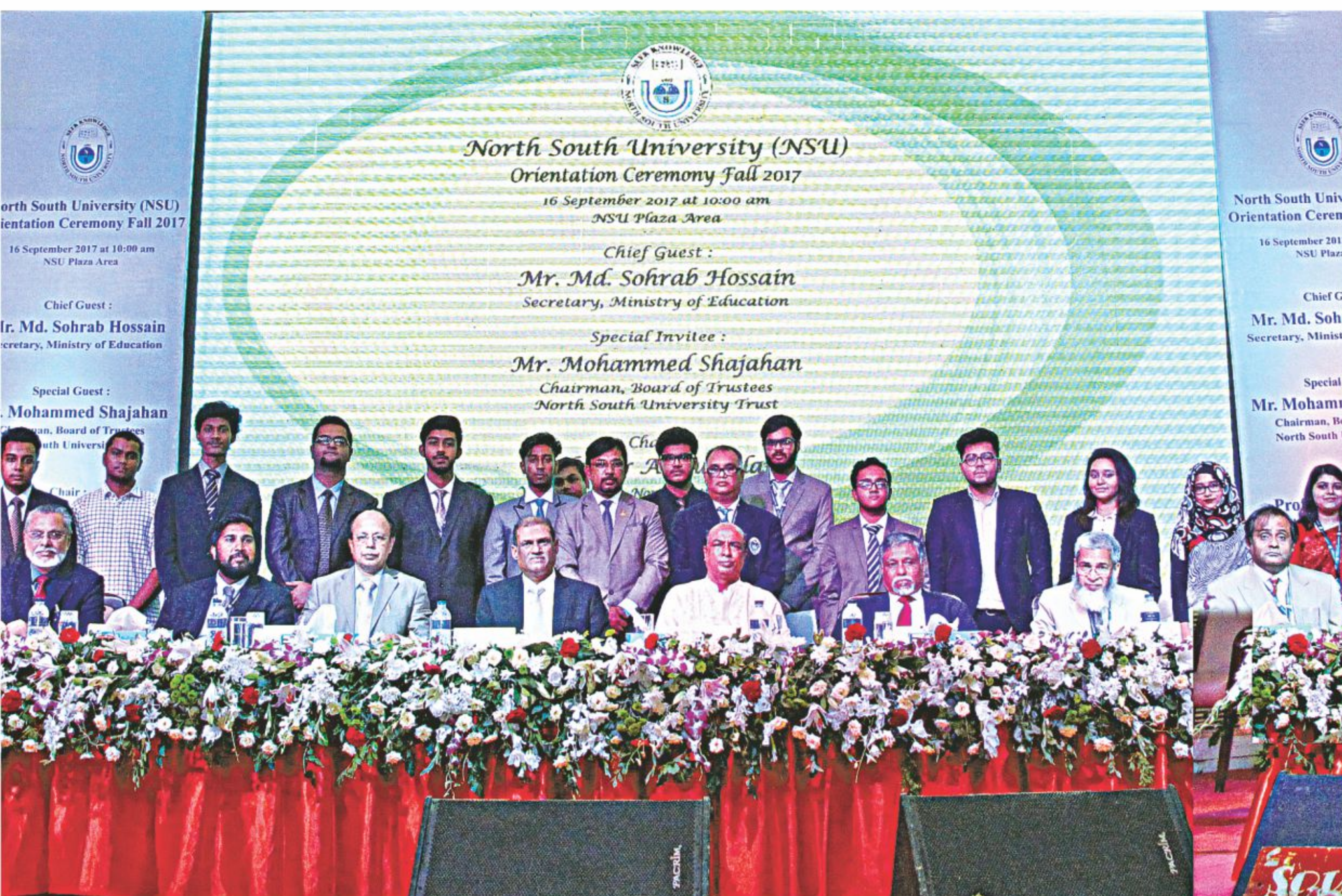


BUBT distributes relief among flood victims
