# WEEKLONG PHOTO EXHIBITION showcases colours of Chittagong

**Chittagong Photo Journalist Association and Radisson Blu Chittagong Bay View celebrated the first day of a weeklong photography exhibition titled 'Colour of Chittagong' featuring works of 30 photojournalists in the city on Saturday.**

The exhibition is aimed at portraying the multi-cultural heritage and natural as well as industrial diversity of the region. Through 60 photos, participating photographers are exhibiting the demographic pluralities that enable Chittagong to stand on its own.

Saifuzzaman Chowdhury, State Minister of Land Ministry was the chief guest while Dr. M Ramiz Uddin Chowdhury, Executive Editor of the Daily Purbokone inaugurated the event.

Such exhibitions play a great role in pro-

moting tourism in Chittagong as it showcases the assets we have in this region, the State Minister exclaimed at the programme.

The photographs showcase the beauty from plain land, sea, hills, local markets, festivities, monuments, architecture and various sources to display the cultural harmony and dimly-exposed scenic beauty for what the natives can boast of.

The subject ranged from the picture of a seagull in the air of Saint Martin Island through the fruit market at the hilly area of

Rangamati to Container Ships waiting to come ashore in Chittagong port.

"These photos cannot be taken after 20 years. The ever-changing nature will not bring back the same perspective to capture the scenes by a lens anymore in the future," expressed the minister while valuing the merits of such occasions.

The exhibition will continue till October 13 at the fourth floor of Radisson Blu Chittagong Bay View from 10am to 5pm.

# "Padmavati" pits Deepika-Ranveer in fierce battle

Keeping their promise to fans, stars of Sanjay Leela Bhansali's "Padmavati" -- Deepika Padukone, Shahid Kapoor and Ranveer Singh -- unveiled the first trailer of their period saga on Monday. The trailer launched exactly at 13:03, signifying the year 1303 when the eight-month long siege of Chittor by Sultan Alauddin Khilji took place. Ranveer plays Alauddin Khilji and Shahid essays the role of Maharawal Ratan Singh in the much-awaited film. Deepika plays the titular role of Padmavati. The film also stars Raza Murad and Aditi Rao Hydari.

The three-minute trailer opens on a grand canvas showcasing the vast expanse of Chittor's fort and moves to beautiful, love-filled visuals of Rani Padmavati and Ratan Singh. Ranveer makes a fleeting appearance after a minute into the trailer. He is mostly seen on the battleground, perfect as the obsessive and ambitious invader with his flowing tresses and blood-stained face.

"Padmavati" is based on folklore that 14th century ruler Alauddin Khilji fell in love with Padmini, the queen of Chittor. Choosing honour over a life in Delhi, Padmini and the other women of Chittor killed themselves by leaping into a fire.

This is the third time Ranveer and Deepika have worked with Sanjay Leela Bhansali, after "Goliyon ki Raseela - Ram-Leela" and "Bajirao Mastani". This is the first time that Shahid is working with Bhansali.

The shooting of the film saw several roadblocks with several fringe organisations protesting against Bhansali and the movie, under the assumption that Khilji will be seen romancing Padmavati onscreen. Recently, members of the Rajput community held a protest against the film in Karnal (Haryana) demanding a ban on the film's screening in the state.

# New "Justice League" trailer drops at NYCC

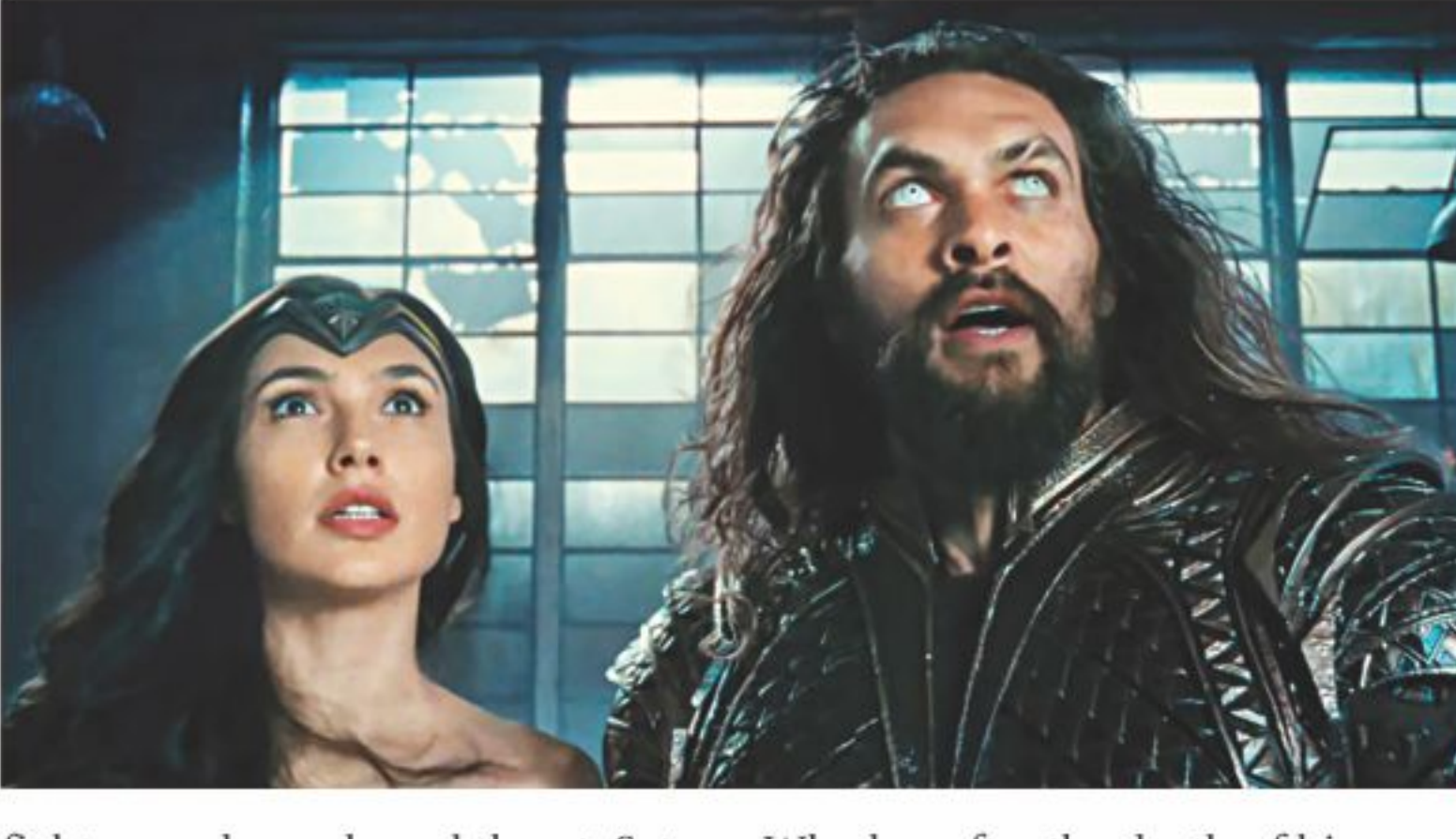
The latest trailer for Warner Bros.'s follow-up to "Batman v Superman: Dawn of Justice" dropped at New York Comic Con Sunday, and showed the world under attack from possibly alien invaders.

Beginning with a Lois Lane (Amy Adams) dream sequence featuring Henry Cavill as Clark Kent in his first appearance in a "Justice League" trailer, the final trailer before the premiere faces his apparent death in the previous film head on. Batman (Ben Affleck) says that the world needs Superman, and that he "made him a promise."

Bruce Wayne also describes a dream he had as "the end of the world."

When Wonder Woman (Gal Gadot) suggests it's an invasion, he replies, "I think it's something more, something darker."

"Justice League" follows Wonder Woman and Batman as they team up to assemble a group of heroes to



fight a newly awakened threat. Set to a cover of David Bowie's "Heroes" and taking a darker tone than the film's three previous trailers, the new one also features Jason Momoa as Aquaman, Ezra Miller as the Flash, and Ray Fisher as Cyborg.

Helmed by Zack Snyder, who handed filmmaking duties to Joss Whedon after the death of his daughter, the latest installment of the DC Universe has enjoyed a long promotional rollout, with its first of four trailers appearing in July 2016 at San Diego Comic-Con. "Justice League" hits theatres November 17.
