Two die from electrocution in Dhamrai

Two men died from electrocution in Swarnali village of Dhamrai upazila in Dhaka yesterday.
The deceased are poultry farm owner Tutol Mia, 22, and his worker Monir Hossen, 18.
Police said the duo came in contact with an electrified fence while they were working at the poultry farm around 1:00pm.
Rizaul Haque, officer-in-charge of Dhamrai Police Station, said the metal fences demarcating the entire farm are often electrified to save the poultry birds from wild animals.

Jagannath Hall tragedy day today

Today is the Jagannath Hall tragedy day. Dhaka University will pay tributes to the students and guests who were killed in a tragic incident at Jagannath Hall on the night of October 15 in 1985.
On the day, 39 people, including 26 students and 13 guests, died in a tragic collapse of the roof of a one-storey building at the dormitory.

Mukundal's role recalled

Mukundal Sarker, a valiant freedom fighter and prominent leader of the anti-British movement, struggled his entire life for establishing rights of the distressed people in the society, said speakers.
They made the remarks at a memorial meeting, organised by Mukundal Sarker Memorial Sangsad in the capital on Friday, marking the 38th death anniversary of Mukundal.
Post and Telecommunications Secretary Shyam Sundar Sikder, Additional Secretary of ICT Division Subir Kishore Chowdhury, Additional Secretaries of Finance Ministry Arijit Chowdhury and Manik Chandra Dey, Managing Editor of BSS Shahriar Shaheed and Executive Director of Bangladesh Computer Council Swapan Kumar Sarker were, among others, present at the meeting presided over by freedom fighter Ismat Kadir Gama.
Mukundal was born in 1909 at Dharmarayer Bari village in Muksepur upazila of Gopalganj.

Strong legal actions should be taken against all forms of sexual violence against women, rights activists demanded yesterday.

The National Committee on Observation of the International Rural Women Day organised the human chain before Jatiya Press Club in the capital, said a press release. The day will be observed today in 50 districts across the country.
Representatives of different rights organisations participated at the event, where President of the National Committee Shamima Akhter, its Secretary Ferdous Ara Rumme and Secretariat Coordinator Mustafa Kamal Akand spoke.

that he [chief justice] went abroad on a voluntary leave," he said at a programme at Uttara in the capital.
Nasim, also the health minister, said people are now more conscious and they would not tolerate conspiracies against the constitution.
Urging BNP to join the next polls, he said, "If you have faith in people and the constitution then take preparation for the election."
Besides, Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu yesterday said the chief justice took leave voluntarily and was not forced to do so.
"The government has no jurisdiction to intervene in any verdict of the chief justice in any case and it never did so. All those claims about the government's interference are just

propaganda," he said while talking to reporters at the Kushtia circuit house after a dialogue with his party workers, reports UNB.
Inu, also president of Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal, said the BNP's statement that the government is trying to control the judiciary by sending the chief justice on a "forced leave" is incorrect.
BNP does not believe in independent judiciary, said the minister.
Today, Law Minister Anisul Huq will brief the media about the overall situation.
The press conference is scheduled to be held at the office of the law ministry around 11:30am, Rezaul Karim, public relations officer of the law, justice and parliamentary affairs ministry, told The Daily Star.

Hasina also said in various by-elections and local government elections it was proved that people can franchise their rights properly and the government did not interfere in those.
"In four city corporation elections, for example, all the BNP candidates came out successful. We didn't restrict the voters, we didn't change the results, and we didn't oppress people."
She said people will choose their candidates freely. "We want to ensure that for strengthening the country's democratic system."
INSIDE THE MEETING
At the meeting, Sheikh Hasina asked party colleagues not to talk about the issue of the chief justice publicly.
The meeting did not discuss the issue, although party General Secretary Obaidul Quader, at a programme yesterday, said two letters of the chief justice will be discussed there and Law Minister Anisul Huq has been asked to attend the meeting.
Though Anisul was present, Hasina asked the meeting not to discuss the issue, said party sources.
At the meeting, she discussed the next national elections and gave directives.
She said party leaders and activists will have to go door-to-door and persuade the voters. Hasina also asked the party members to be careful about rebel candidates.
At the meeting, party advisory council member and PM's adviser HT Imam presented the party agenda to be placed at the EC dialogue.

At the press conference, pro-BNP SCBA leaders alleged that CJ's statement has proved that he came under verbal attack by some ministers and the PM because of his verdict in the 16th amendment case.
They sought President Abdul Hamid's intervention to save the judiciary.
"President is the chief of the state. So, we urge the president to take step to save the judiciary," said SCBA President Zainul Abedin.

In his statement, the CJ said some in the government have wrongly interpreted the verdict (in the 16th amendment case).
Referring to the CJ's remarks, Zainul Abedin said the PM should take steps to save the judiciary.
Later, Pro-Awami League faction led by SCBA Vice President Ozi Ullah wanted to hold another press conference but faced obstacles from some pro-BNP lawyers. Later Ozi Ullah held it disagreeing with Zainul's statement.
