

Fugitive accused held

Police yesterday arrested an accused who fled from police custody in Kalmakanda upazila of Netrakona on Friday.

Anazul Mia, 35, was held from the town's Satpai area in the morning, said AKM Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Kalmakanda Police Station.

Anazul is an alleged drug peddler and a wanted in two drug peddling cases, said the OC.

On Friday noon, a police team, led by Sub-Inspector Saiful Alam, arrested Anazul from his house at Chatrangpur Purbapara in the upazila.

After his arrest, family members and neighbours allegedly attacked the police team with sticks and during the following mayhem, Anazul bit the hand of a policeman and fled away.

Five policemen, including SI Saiful, were injured in the attack, said the OC.

KILLING OF NASRIN Mother cries for justice

"I want exemplary punishment of those who killed my daughter Nasrin."

A crying Sharifa Begum, mother of slain Nasrin Begum, fainted while saying this at a human chain programme in Thakurgaon town yesterday.

Earlier, villagers and students of different colleges of Charol union in Baliadangi upazila formed a human chain at Thakurgaon intersection, demanding punishment of the culprits, who killed housewife Nasrin in the upazila on September 4.

They also demanded arrest of all the accused in the murder case and proper investigation in this regard so no one should meet such tragic death.

Quoting the victim's family members, police said Nasrin Begum, 17, daughter of Nazim Uddin of Charol village in the upazila, also an HSC first year student, was married to Rezaul Islam, 32, son of Nur Islam about four months ago.

Prior to the marriage, Rezaul claimed his uncle's house (adjacent to their house) as his own property to his be-in-laws' family.

After the marriage, Rezaul's fraudulence came to light which created an unusual atmosphere among the two families and with the passing of time the bitterness increased.

On the night of September 3, Rezaul engaged in an alteration with Nasrin over the issue and later beat her dead and hung the body from a tree.

Following a case filed by the victim's father, police arrested three of the accused, including Rezaul.

Two youths get life for killing man

A court here yesterday sentenced two youths to life imprisonment for killing a man in September 2014.

The convicts are Mizanur Rahman, 25, of Parkartikpasha village, and Kamal Hossain, 20, of Golbunia village in Patuakhali Sadar upazila.

According to the case statement, Mizanur and Kamal took a motorbike from Bimol, 42, on rental basis.

Later, a quarrel ensued between Bimol and the duo as they were not paying the rent regularly.

As a sequel, Mizanur and Kamal took Bimol for a boat journey in Lawkathi river on September 27 in 2014.

When the boat was crossing Patuakhali Bridge area, Mizanur and Kamal swooped on Bimol and hit him with iron rods, leaving him dead on the spot. They later dumped the body in the river.

Following a case filed by Bimol's daughter Priyanka Das Shila with Patuakhali Police Station on September 28, police recovered Bimol's body from the river 36 hours after the incident.

Mentally ill woman strangled Belal, father of two, was forced to marry Sima after allegation of raping her

A mentally challenged woman was strangled to death allegedly by her husband and in-laws at Beelpara village under Doail union in the district's Sarishabari upazila on Monday.

The victim is Sima Begum, 20, daughter of poor Sohrab Ali and Banekha Begum of the village, and second wife of Belal Uddin, 45, of the village.

Belal, husband of another woman and father of two children, was forced to marry neighbour Sima after the allegation against him of raping her was proved in a local arbitration three months ago, said police, referring to the victim's parents.


Soon after the marriage, Belal, his first wife Jelemon Begum, 38, and other in-laws started torturing her mentally and physi-

cally, Aminul Islam, sub-inspector of Sarishabari Police Station, quoted the victim's mother Banekha as saying.

"Around 4:00pm on Monday, Belal and Jelemon strangled Sima to death after their failed attempt to forcibly send her to her parents' house. Keeping the body in the kitchen, they went into hiding.

"The same evening, Banekha came to her son-in-law's house to meet her daughter, but did not see her in the house. After searching, she found Sima's body in the kitchen, said the SI.

On Monday night, Banekha filed a murder case accusing 12 in-laws including Belal and Jelemon with Sarishabari Police Station and police arrested one of the accused -- Nurjahan, 60, paternal aunt of Belal, said SI Aminul, also investigation officer of the case.
