

Jamaat ameer Maqbul on fresh remand

Jamaat-e-Islami Ameer Maqbul Ahmad was shown arrested and remanded again yesterday for three days in an arson case filed with Motijheel Police Station in January 2015. Metropolitan Magistrate Sadjir Yasir Ahsan Chowdhury passed the order after Sub-Inspector Anwar Hossain of Detective Branch of police and also the investigation officer of the case, submitted an application for showing him arrested in the case. According to the case statement, it was alleged that a group of BNP-led-20-party alliance leaders and activists including BNP Secretary General Fakhru Islam Alamgir and Jamaat Ameer Maqbul torched a vehicle by throwing petrol at AGB Colony in Motijheel area on January 4, 2015. Following the incident, the case was filed against 81 including Fakhru and Maqbul with Motijheel Police Station. On October 10, Maqbul was placed on a ten-day remand in two cases. Nine top Jamaat leaders including Maqbul were held in Uttara on October 9 on charge of holding a "secret" meeting.

Chittagong with Rakhine State in Myanmar, the investigators said after primary investigation. A Bangladesh passport with Myanmar visa, some Myanmar currency, a laptop computer, documents and videos containing ALP propaganda, and photos of Ushit and his wife, in arms, with Myanmar army officials were seized by Rab during his arrest, said the case statement. The court placed him on a three-day police remand that ended on October 29. Nure Azam Miah, officer-in-charge of Airport Police Station, said they were scrutinizing the information gleaned from Ushit. "We are also verifying the photos in which his wife is carrying arms."

However, Ushit's sister Aye Thein Rakhine, a former lawmaker of Awami League, rebutted the allegations against her brother, terming the charges false and baseless. Aye Thein said her brother runs an NGO named Rakhine Development Foundation that works for all ethnic and religious communities in the country. Also, he used to work as an advisor for a Myanmar-based NGO named Raingo Foundation. Ushit's wife Sumraraja works for the peace committee formed by the Myanmar government, she also said, claiming that the photos of Sumraraja carrying arms were taken during student demonstrations in Myanmar in the 80s.

Peking University promoting Bangla as means of stronger ties

Asia's first Nobel Prize winner Rabindranath Tagore has been holding a special place in Peking University (Beijing University) for decades showcasing stronger cultural ties between China and Bangla-speaking people in the region. Chinese people still practise works of Rabindranath and do research on his creative works. "We will continue to promote Bangla and creative works of Rabindranath Tagore," said Prof Wei Liming of the Department of Asian and African Languages and Literatures, School of Foreign Language under the University. "Course related to Rabindranath is one of the most popular courses here. Works of Rabindranath have been being practised in China for 100 years," she said. There are three statues of Rabindranath in China and the oldest one is on the Peking University campus, the professor mentioned.
