

# Road crashes kill six

**CITY DESK**  
Six people were killed and 17 others injured in road accidents in the country yesterday and Saturday.  
Our Pabna correspondent reports, two persons were killed and five others injured when a Pabna-bound bus in an attempt to overtake first hit a three-wheeler and then a motorbike on Pabna-Rajshahi highway at Mozidpur intersection on Sunday afternoon.  
The dead are Rokon Ali, 45, and Samrat Hossain, 30. The injured were admitted to Pabna General Hospital. Of them, motorcyclist Polash Hossain was transferred to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital.  
Our Dinajpur correspondent adds, a bicyclist was killed while 10 bus passengers were injured when the bus overturned after hitting the bicycle near Boiragipara in Mithapukur upazila of Dinajpur on Sunday.  
The deceased was Manik Mia, 35, of village Payraband. The injured were sent to Rangpur Medical College Hospital.

In another accident, a woman was killed and her elder brother injured when a truck hit them on Dinajpur-Thakurgaon road at Basherhat.  
The deceased is Nishi Aktar, 21, of Thakurgaon Sadar upazila. The injured is Arman Hossain.  
Our Chittagong staff correspondent adds, a motorcyclist was killed and his co-rider injured when the former lost his control over the bike while riding through Aktaruzzaman flyover in Chittagong city early yesterday.  
The deceased, Md Ridwan, 20, of Satkania upazila, was a cloth trader of the city's Terry Bazar. His friend Mahfuj was admitted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital.  
Our Faridpur correspondent adds, Robayet Islam, 32, of Miapara area in Gopalganj town, died after he lost control over his motorbike and hit a tree beside Gopalganj-Takerhat road at Konshu in Gopalganj Sadar upazila on Saturday.

# CU teacher 'threatened at gunpoint'

BCL men asked my name. When I gave my identity, they started hurling abuses at me and threatened me for my involvement with the movement against Chittagong City Corporation's tax reassessment," he said.  
"One of them also pulled out a gun and pointed it to my forehead when I tried to pacify them. They asked me to stop my movement and said otherwise I would face dire consequences," said the teacher.  
Amir Uddin is the general secretary of Chattagram Kordata Surokha Parishad, a group created to protect the taxpayers of Chittagong. He along with a businessman launched the movement after CCC announced a programme in March last year to reassess the holding tax paid by house owners.  
The group held different programmes in the last one year, saying that due to the

re-assessment, the amount of tax would increase manifold. It calls upon the city corporation to keep the tax rise at a tolerable level.  
Amir Uddin said he did not know any of the youths who threatened him identifying themselves as BCL men. "I verbally informed the matter to the proctor."  
A general diary was also filed with Hathazari Police Station. Proctor Ali Asgar Chowdhury said they were looking into the incident.  
Meanwhile, when asked, president of CU's suspended BCL committee Alamgir Tipu said he did not know of the youths. "Someone might have done this with an ill-motive to tarnish the image of CCC Mayor AJM Nasir Uddin."  
Tipu is known as a loyalist of the mayor.  
On the other hand, the suspended BCL committee's general secretary Fazly Rabbi Sujan told The Daily Star that he conveyed the issue to central leaders.  
He also denied knowing any of the so-called BCL activists who threatened the teacher.  
Sujan is known to be a supporter of former CCC mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury, who vehemently opposed the holding tax reassessment.

## HC clears way for trial

Justice Sheikh Hasan Arif and Justice Md Badruzzaman passed the order after completing the hearing on the rule.  
The cases were filed mainly by ruling party men following publication of the report in the daily on December 17, 2009.  
The "false and fake" report said Towfiq and Joy took a five-million-dollar bribe from American oil company Chevron promising it to award an oil exploration order, said Rafiqul Islam Faruk, a lawyer for one of the plaintiffs of the cases.  
Following a writ petition of Mahmudur, the High Court in 2010 issued the rule and stayed proceedings of the cases. The court also gave him bail till disposal of the rule.  
In a statement, Rafiqul said as the rule was dismissed, his bail was cancelled, and the proceedings of the cases could be resumed.

After the proceeding, the AG told reporters that Law Minister Anisul Huq may sit with the judges of the Appellate Division on Thursday to resolve the issue.  
The way Chief Justice SK Sinha wanted to see the rules will curb the power of the president, said the AG. For this reason, the government is trying to resolve the issue by holding discussion between the SC and the law ministry, he added.  
Earlier on October 8, the SC adjourned the hearing on the Masdar Hossain case till yesterday.  
On that day, the government for the 25th time in two years sought time from the Supreme Court to issue the gazette notification. The judiciary was officially separated from the executive in November 2007, but the code of conducts for lower court judges have yet to be finalised.
