Green Uni, Horizon Group sign MoU

Green University of Bangladesh and Horizon Group have signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on building and strengthening academic and industrial relationship.

Serajum Munira, director of Green University Centers, and Prof Mubasher Ali, managing director and CEO of Horizon Group, signed the MoU on Friday, said a press release. Prof Golam Samdani Fakir, the vice chancellor, and Prof Muhammad Fayyaz Khan, pro-vice chancellor also attended the event. Research and development (joint product development, problem solving, and testing), and student programmes (job placement, internship) will be organised under the MoU.

BCL faction is after CU teacher!

A day after some unidentified "armed youths humiliated and threatened" a teacher of Chittagong University in his office room, a faction of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) of the university yesterday demanded his removal within 24 hours.

The faction, led by president of the suspended committee of BCL's CU unit Alamgir Tipu, who is known as a loyalist of Chittagong City Corporation Mayor AJM Nasir Uddin, submitted a memorandum on the official letterhead of BCL to the vice chancellor.

The day before, a group of youths identifying themselves as activists of CU BCL "threat-

ened" the teacher for his activism against the holding tax reassessment programme by Chittagong City Corporation.

One of them also brandished a firearm, said the victim, Md Amir Uddin, an associate professor of the university's Institute of Education Research.

Amir is the general secretary of Chattagram Kordata Surokha Parishad, a group created to protect the taxpayers of Chittagong.

He along with a businessman launched the movement after CCC announced a programme in March last year to reassess the holding tax paid by house owners.

The group held different programmes in

the last one year, saying that due to the reassessment, the amount of tax would increase manifold. It calls upon the city corporation to keep the tax rise at a tolerable level.

In the memorandum, the BCL faction alleges that when the tax reassessment programme is being addressed peacefully and fairly through "appeals" and "discussion", the teacher was trying to "mislead" journalists by providing "false" information.

He is "spreading" personal enmity against the elected representatives through social media, it says. They demand the CU authorities remove the teacher within 24 hours.

Contacted, Amir Uddin said all allegations against him were false, baseless and motivated.

"From the incident of submitting a memorandum today, it was proved that those who humiliated and threatened me yesterday have connection with them," he said.

Contacted, general secretary of the suspended committee of CU unit BCL Fazly Rabbi Sujon, said none could use the official letterhead of CU unit BCL as the committee was now suspended, adding, "It's an offence."

General secretary of BCL's Chittagong city unit Nurul Azim Rony said the city dwellers were now getting the result of Amir Uddin's movement as CCC was compelled to go for introducing a provision of appeal for taxpayers following the movement.

"The demand for his removal is nothing but a part of a conspiracy to save the miscreants who humiliated and threatened the teacher," he said.

Talking to The Daily Star, Proctor Ali Asgar Chowdhury said two separate committees would be formed to probe the incidents -- one for humiliating the teacher and the other for the allegation against him.

Meanwhile, some city residents and political leaders expressed their grave concern over the incident of threatening the teacher.

Prof Sekandar Khan, vice chancellor of East Delta University, said anyone could join a

CU BCL leader beaten up by fellow activists

A leader of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) of Chittagong University was beaten up by fellow activists on the campus yesterday.

The injured was Mohsin Bhuiyan, assistant secretary of the suspended committee of BCL's CU unit, also a master's student of international relations.

He was given primary treatment at CU Medical Centre.

Around 10 to 15 men, led by BCL activist Nasir Uddin Mishu, attacked him around 3:00am in front of Shamsunahar Hall tea stall, he said.

They had the intention to "kill me as I was directly involved in the movement for justice for deceased BCL leader Diaz (Irfan Chowdhury)," said Mohsin.

"They called me from the stall and took me to a corner and started beating me with sticks," he added.

Mohsin alleged that he was attacked at the directive of

Students vandalise acting VC's vehicle

Some 10 people, including teachers and police members, were injured when agitating students of Jatiya Kabi Kazi Nazrul Islam University (JKNIU) in Mymensingh's Trishal went on a rampage and vandalised a microbus carrying its acting vice-chancellor yesterday afternoon, said sources.

The students have been demonstrating for last one month demanding resignation of the vice-chancellor (VC), Prof AMM Shamsur Rahman for his alleged corruption in job recruitments in past years when he was serving as the treasurer, a university source said. A faction of teachers joined the movement later.

When the VC reached the campus after some 12-day break, taken for his illness, to join a meeting of the central admission committee around 12:00 noon, the students besieged his microbus before the administrative building for half an hour, said the proctor, Prof Jahidul Kabir.

On information, Jahidul with proctorial body members and policemen rescued the vice-chancellor who later left the campus for his residence in Mymensingh town.

The students threw brickbats and broke window panes of the vehicle, said the proctor, adding that the injured were given first-aid.

Humayun Kabir, registrar of the university, said the University Grants Commission on October 26 served the VC with a show cause notice in connection with his alleged corruption. The VC, who assumed the office in August, has already replied, he added.

The admission test is slated for November 19.
