

ATROCITIES ON ROHINGYAS  
Symbolic trial held at CU

There is a credible evidence of genocide and crimes against humanity in Myanmar against the Rohingyas, according to the primary verdict of a symbolic tribunal held at Chittagong University yesterday.

Chairman of the three-member tribunal Barrister M Amirul Islam, a senior advocate of the Supreme Court, gave the verdict. The other members of the tribunal were Dr SM Masum Billah, an assistant professor of the law department at Jagannath University, and Barrister Badrul Hasan Kachi, an advocate of Supreme Court.

All the members of the prosecution, defence, victims and witnesses were students of the university's law faculty. The Society for Critical Legal Studies (SCLS), a study circle of the faculty, arranged the tribunal.

The tribunal in the verdict also said more evaluation and monitoring are needed for a final verdict.

**JU students burn its damaged, date-expired medicines**

A group of students of Jahangirnagar University (JU) burnt a stack of medicines in front of the university medical centre on Friday night.

They alleged that the medical centre had been providing the damaged and date-expired medicines to the students for long. The university high officials brought the situation under control by assuring the students of taking measures in this regard.

Some students of Al-Beruni Hall came to the medical centre around 10:00pm for taking treatment. After receiving prescribed medicines from the centre, they found some of them were either damaged or date-expired, said witnesses, adding that the students had then demonstrated, collected medicines from the storeroom and set those on fire.

Mohit Alam of public administration department said providing date-

expired and damaged medicines to the students had been going on for long, but the authorities turned a blind eye to the practice.

In addition, the medical centre does not have all the medicines; therefore, students have to buy the costly medicines from outside, said Md Didar, a fourth-year student of geography and environment department.

The lone JU medical centre is facing various problems due to negligence of the authorities and inadequate fund, claimed the demonstrators.

Talking to The Daily Star, Sultan Ahmad, a technical officer (medicine) of the JU medical centre, said, "Around 200 people including students, teachers and staff collect medicine from the centre every day. Around 32 types of medicines are available in the centre."

On condition of anonymity, an employee of the centre said the authorities buy poor quality medicines from some enlisted companies.

Asked about the poor quality medicines, Enamur Rashid Litu, a doctor of the medical centre, said, "It is the responsibility of the authorities what type of medicines they would provide to the students. We just prescribe the medicine."

Contacted, Dr Mozeza Zohura, acting chief medical officer, said, "We have no date-expired medicines; as the existing storeroom is old, some medicines might have been damaged due to fluctuating temperature."

Meanwhile, as per the direction of JU Vice-Chancellor Prof Farzana Islam, Pro-VC (administration) Prof Amir Hussain yesterday met the medical centre officials. As per the decision of the meeting, the university authorities would withdraw all the existing medicines of the centre and buy medicines from the reputed pharmaceutical companies soon. A new medicine storeroom will be built also. Prof Amir confirmed it to The Daily Star.

**Jubo League factional clash injures 35**

At least 35 people, including three policemen, were injured as a factional clash between two groups of Jubo League broke out during a rally marking its 45th founding anniversary in Hatia upazila yesterday.

Police said the upazila unit of Jubo League arranged the rally. However, another faction of local Jubo League swooped on them, which triggered the clash.

Police fired around 100 rubber bullets and lobbed 10 tear gas canisters to bring the situation under control, said Hatia police.

**Man arrested for 'killing' daughter in Ctg**

Detectives arrested a man in Sandwip area of Chittagong early yesterday on the charge of killing his 10-year-old daughter in the city two years ago.

The arrestee is Md Ali alias Khorshed, said Md Shahidullah, deputy commissioner (port) of Chittagong Metropolitan Police.

Police recovered the hanging body of the girl, Umme Salma Rima, from her Uttar Kattoli residence on October 10, 2015, said DC Shahidullah.

Her mother, Ruma Aktar, filed an unnatural death (UD) case assuming that it was a suicide.

However, after getting an autopsy report, they confirmed that she was killed, said the DC.

Ali confessed to killing his daughter over family feud, he added.

and communication technology for reformation of case management and efficient service delivery.

The speed of work can be increased several folds by using the information technology, he said, adding that the Judiciary had already made some progress in digitisation of the justice delivery system.

He said the government had already taken a mega project, "e-Judiciary", for ensuring maximum use of information technology in the courts. Coordinated efforts of lawyers and justice-seekers must be continued for implementing the project, said the justice.

Justice Wahhab said the judges and lawyers will have to play a pioneering role in establishing peace in the society by punishing the bad elements and protecting the good persons.

The relation between the lawyers and judges are like two feathers of a bird, two wheels of a vehicle, two arms, two eyes and two legs of a person. For ensuring justice both lawyers and judges would have to work in unison, which will speed up judicial administration and face the challenges in disposal of cases, he added.

Law Minister Anisul Huq said the Bar council certificates should be given on the basis of talent for the greater interest of the lawyers and dignity of the law profession.

Bangladesh Bar Council's Vice Chairman Abdul Baset Majumder presided over the function where Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain of the Appellate Division, SC judges, and Attorney General Mahbub Alam were also present.

The arrestees confessed to sending money through bKash to those directly involved in the attack plan on August 15, said Mohammad Yousuf Ali, an additional deputy commissioner of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, while talking to The Daily Star.

According to Counter Terrorism and Transnational Crime (CTTC) Unit, Torab's son Akram Hossain Khan Niloy, a top leader of the outfit, was the key planner.

ADC Yousuf said Niloy is on the run.

The plot was, however, foiled by CCTC unit in a Panthapath hotel where "Neo JMB" suicide bomber Saiful Islam holed up with huge amount of explosives.

Saiful killed himself during the drive by exploding two "powerful" bombs in the hotel, which is around half a kilometre off Bangabandhu Memorial Museum.
