

Cantonment and power bills placed in House

Electricity Bill, 2017, was placed in parliament last night keeping a provision for a maximum of five years' imprisonment along with the highest fine of Tk 5 lakh for using electricity illegally.

State Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Nasrul Hamid placed the bill in the House, with Speaker Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury in the chair.

The Jatiya Sangsad later sent the bill to the parliamentary standing committee concerned for scrutiny and to report within 30 working days.

The proposed law will replace the existing Electricity Act, 1910. The bill is aimed at ensuring power generation and quality service, developing the power transmission and distribution systems, and preventing power pilferage at residential, industrial and commercial establishments.

Meanwhile, the Cantonment Bill, 2017, was also placed in parliament yesterday with provisions for tougher punishments for violating the law, including delaying construction of buildings and breaking traffic rules in cantonment areas.

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Anisul Huq placed the bill in the House.

The Jatiya Sangsad later sent the bill to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Ministry for scrutiny and asked to report within 30 working days.

The new bill has been prepared reorganising and amending the Cantonment Act, 1924, to make it more time-befitting, the minister told the House.

Others were injured after police fired rubber bullets and teargas shells to restore law and order.

Titu's family keeps saying that he is innocent and is being framed. Asaduzzaman was talking to reporters at the capital's Ramna Police Convention Centre after joining a reception accorded to the police members who put up the first resistance against Pakistani occupation forces at Rajarbagh on March 26, 1971.

On October 30, 2016, religious bigots vandalised Hindu houses and temples in five villages of Nasirnagar upazila in Brahmanbaria following a rumour that a Facebook post demeaned the Holy Kaaba.

Asaduzzaman said an investigation was underway to find out the reason behind Friday's mayhem and to identify the attackers.

Replying to a question, he said police could not prevent the incident as the number of attackers was much higher than that of the law enforcers. "Several thousand people launched the attack together."

Earlier in the day, the minister visited Thakurpara village in Rangpur.

Talking to reporters there, he said the law enforcers arrested Titu from Nilphamari.

He said police carried out their duties accordingly and the culprits would be brought to justice. "Bangabandhu's Bangladesh is a non-communal country and no one can carry out conspiracies here."

On Saturday morning, police filed a case against more than 2,000 people over the clash. The previous night, they detained 36 people from Gangachhara and Kotwali area.

TITU'S ARREST
Police arrested Titu from one of his relative's house in Chirviza Golna village in Nilphamari's Jaldhaka upazila around 11:00pm on Monday, reports our correspondent in the district.

Later, he was brought to Rangpur,

said Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Jaldhaka Police Station Mostafizur Rahman

Police did not say what the charges against the arrestee were. Asked, they said they would brief about the arrest today.

Earlier, the law enforcers said their primary investigation had found that the Facebook post "demeaning Islam" was uploaded from somewhere in Rangpur's Gangachhara from the account of one Md Titu on October 28.

They did not give any further details of the matter.

Meanwhile, talking to our Rangpur correspondent,

Ziton Bala, Titu's mother, and locals said Titu could not read and write and that they did not believe that he could create or upload the post.

They also said Titu lived in Narayanganj and he never went to that village in the last four to five years.

Meanwhile, the people of the Hindu community in the Rangpur village were yet to overcome the Friday's shock. They were staying put. This, however, was affecting them hard as most of them are day labourers.

Police were guarding the village around the clock.

People of nearby villages cooked food and fed the affected ones at Brahmanpara Government Primary School premises.

The Bengal Foundation had initially planned to host the event at the Army Stadium on Nov 23, but did not receive permission from the authorities. Later, Bengal Foundation cancelled the festival due to the unavailability of the venue.

Signed by chairman of Abahani Limited, the latest permission letter also set some conditions for use of the venue including getting government permission, controlling sound level and bearing the cost of Abahani's athletes to practice in another ground.

The foundation made the cancellation announcement at a press conference at the Westin Dhaka in the capital on October 22.

They also issued a press release that said the Army Sports Control Board (ASCB) on August 31 had denied allotment of the Army Stadium from November 20-28 (with the event set for November 23-27) to Bengal Foundation, citing the arrival of the Pope to Bangladesh at the same time as the reason.

When it was known that the Pope was arriving on November 30 and his main programme would not be held at the Army Stadium, Bengal Foundation reapplied for the venue on September 9 but no progress was made in this regard.

After getting the venue, Bengal Foundation has applied to the cultural affair ministry for government approval for the festival.

The Abahani grounds can accommodate around 14,000 spectators.

Initiated in 2012, with assistance from Kolkata's ITC Sangeet Research Academy the first year, the Bengal Classical Music Festival became a marquee event of Bangladesh's cultural calendar. The four-nightlong festival featured the world's leading exponents of Hindustani and Carnatic Classical Music in the first two years, with attendance numbers reaching nearly 100,000 in the second year.

Since 2014, the festival was extended to five nights, and audience numbers swelled to 1,50,000. That year the Bengal Parampara Sangeetaly also began its journey with the aim of producing future classical musicians and singers, under the tutelage of noted classical gurus.

In 2016, the attendance rose to nearly 200,000.

After yesterday's GI announcement, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, who is in London, celebrated the news with a tweet saying: "Sweet news for us all. We are very happy and proud that #Bengal has been granted GI (Geographical Indication) status for Rosogolla."

West Bengal's Education Minister Partha Chatterjee said, "Odisha unnecessarily raised a dispute over the issue."

Odisha's Science and Technology minister Pradip Kumar Panigrahi had told media earlier that more than one committee set up to trace the origin of 'rosogolla' pointed to 'conclusive evidence' that the sweet existed in the state for about 600 years.

On the other hand, the West Bengal government used 19-century history to claim rosogolla was invented by Nabin Chandra Das, a famous sweetmeat maker, in 1868.

hurling abusive words during the journey.

The officer said when Farhad was found on a Dhaka bound bus at Noapara in Jessore, more than 18 hours after his wife said that he had gone missing, he was carrying a bag which had in it ashirt, towel, mobile charger, some cash and other things people usually carry during a journey.

However, no bag was seen with Farhad as he left his building in the footage of security cameras.

The writer claimed that before he was released around 7:30pm near Khulna Shibbari area, the abductors gave him a bus ticket and told him to go back to Dhaka.

But the investigation found that Farhad himself bought the ticket from a counter of Hanif Paribahan and said his name was Gafur.

"Farhad called his wife that day and said he was abducted and the abductors demanded Tk 35 lakh for his release, which was a lie," the officer said.

The case statement of Farida, Farhad Mazhar's judicial statement, statements of witnesses including Archana Rani, one of his employees, and other circumstantial evidence prove that the abduction was "false, fabricated and concocted", he added.

9 directors of SIBL resign

Muinul Hasan and AFM Asaduzzaman.

At the same board meeting, seven independent and two shareholder directors were appointed. The names of the newly appointed directors could not be known immediately.

Earlier on October 30, SIBL board chairman Md Rezaul Haque, executive committee chairman Md Anisul Hoque and managing director Shahid Hossain resigned from their posts.

Their replacements were named on the same day, both of whom had ties to the Chittagong-based S Alam Group that recently purchased about 50 per cent stake in SIBL through 19 companies, violating the Banking Company Act, 1991.

As per the act, an individual or a company cannot hold more than five per cent shares of a bank by itself or jointly with the approval of the central bank.

Of the 19 companies, 15 used the same office address: Al-Amin Centre, 12th floor, Dilkusha, Dhaka.

The 15 firms are Global Trading Corporation, Lion Securities & Investment, Portman Cements, Modern Properties, Prasad Paradise Resorts, Unique Investment & Securities, Hasan Abason Ltd, Platinum Endeavours, Dynamic Ventures, Reliable Entrepreneurs, Paradise International, Leader Business Enterprise, Pusti Vegetable Ghee, Unitex Steel Mills, and

Unitex Cement.

The other four companies are Chittagong-based C&A Accessories, C&A Fabrics, Marine Empire Ltd and Shah Amanat Prakritik Gas Co Ltd.

Of the companies, six have direct links with S Alam Group Chairman Mohammed Saiful Alam and his family members, according to the Office of Registrar of Joint Stock Companies and Firms.

Saiful and his family members are directors of Islami Bank Bangladesh, First Security Islami Bank, Al-Arafah Islami Bank, Union Bank, NRB Global Bank and Bangladesh Commerce Bank.

Anwarul Azim Arif, a former vice-chancellor of Chittagong University, was made the new chairman and Belal Ahmed, vice-chairman of NRB Global Bank, the new executive committee chairman of the SIBL.

Belal is the son-in-law of Saiful. He will represent Unitex Steel Mills, also a concern of S Alam Group, in the bank's board.

Quazi Osman Ali, additional managing director of First Security Islami Bank, was appointed the managing director of SIBL. Saiful is the chairman of First Security Islami Bank.

The Daily Star contacted Saiful yesterday, but he refused to comment on the matter.

Out of 20 directors on its board, the SIBL has so far replaced 11 since October 30.

Minister Sheikh Hasina said during the discussion.

She said Bangabandhu has given us freedom. "After getting independence, he had started work for getting economic freedom but couldn't complete it as he was assassinated on August 15, 1975. It is our duty to complete his unfinished dream to build a sonar Bangla, free from hunger, poverty and economic disparity."

In her half-an-hour-long speech, the PM thanked everyone who were involved in getting the recognition.

The PM came down heavily on those who had banned Bangabandhu's March 7 speech following his assassination.

She said Bangabandhu resurrected a sleeping nation and transformed it into a fighting force through his extempore speech. No other speech in the world was heard so many times like the March 7 speech of Bangabandhu.

Taking part in the discussion, the MPs said the Bangalee nation fully cooperated with Bangabandhu. All government offices in the then East Pakistan started to operate under his instructions. He thus became the de-facto ruler, they added.

Speaking on the resolution, ruling Awami League MPs lambasted BNP founder late president Ziaur Rahman, BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and Jatiya Party Chairman HM Ershad for banning the March 7 speech while they were in state power in different times following assassination of Bangabandhu in 1975.

Parliament adopted the resolution following Unesco's inclusion of Bangabandhu's March 7 speech in the Memory of the World International Register, a list of world's important documentary heritage maintained by the UN body.

Unesco Director General Irina Bokova announced the decision on October 30 at its headquarters in Paris.

On March 7, 1971, Bangabandhu in his fiery speech called on the freedom-loving Bangladeshis to wage a decisive struggle against the Pakistani oppressors. The speech set the tone for the Liberation War that would officially begin later that month on March 26.

While placing the resolution under section 147 (1) of the rules of procedure of parliament, Tofail said it is proved now that the March 7 speech of Bangabandhu is the best speech in the world.

"The 18-minute-long extempore

speech of Bangabandhu served as the ultimate source of inspiration for the countless freedom fighters. The speech was a clear indication of the Liberation War. No speech in the world was cited so many times like the March 7 speech of Bangabandhu," reads the resolution.

"Ebarer sangram amader muktir sangram, ebarer sangram amader swadhinatar sangram [The struggle this time is a struggle for emancipation, the struggle this time is a struggle for independence]," Bangabandhu proclaimed in a thunderous voice at a mammoth rally at the Racecourse Maidan (now Suhrawardy Udyan) that day.

"The March 7 speech of Bangabandhu sparked not only the Bangalee people but also the world's conscience. Unesco's recognition of Bangabandhu's March 7 speech has proved this," Tofail said in the resolution.

Participating in the discussion, lawmakers highlighted various aspects and significance of the March 7 speech in creating a new nation -- Bangladesh.

They said the speech would remain as a milestone in the history of independence of Bangladesh.

The MPs also said Bangabandhu's March 7 speech is one of the few speeches that changed the course of history and created a new nation.

In her speech, Opposition Leader Raushan Ershad called upon the Awami League to spread Bangabandhu's spirit among all and not confine it to the limits of the party.

Rosogolla pride West Bengal's

announced that the juicy sweet originated in West Bengal. The announcement ended a two-and-a-half-year-old bitter dispute between Odisha and West Bengal over the origin of the Rosogolla, our Delhi correspondent reported.

"It has been settled under the GI Act that authenticates a product relating to either a geographical location or community or society," said Deputy Controller of Patents and Designs, Sanjay Bhattacharya.

The GI, under the World Trade Organization, is a sign that identifies a product as originating from a particular place.

However, despite the declaration, there is strong disagreement over the issue as many Bangladeshi sweet traders and consumers believe that the sweetmeat was created by Bangladeshi

sweet-makers.

In a report, BBC Bangla Service quoted the late veteran recipe writer and food connoisseur Shawkat Osman who had said that although there is no written proof, but it is believed that the Portuguese used to prepare cheese and sandesh (a particular kind of sweet) from milk in sixth century.

The Bangalee wives would then prepare rosogolla or a form of it with those. He added, "Kolkata's Nabin Chandra, who is presumed to be the maker of rosogolla, is a man from Barisal and lived near Patuakhali."

It is believed that Chandra took his recipe with him to Kolkata, the BBC report said. Adding to Chandra's legitimacy is a host of fabled admirers, including Rabindranath Tagore, who was rumoured to have known whether his rosogolla came from Chandra or elsewhere by taking just one small bite.

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New cantonment

The new cantonment is being built in an area, where the government, of late, has laid out a series of development projects including building a deep-sea port and constructing large power and LNG units.

Replying to a question, the minister said the premier gave the idea of building the cantonment and that is why it is being named after her.

According to a planning ministry proposal, the cantonment will be built on 1,532 acres of land, of which 567 acres has so far been acquired.

The land in the project area has been formed by chars emerged there since 1975 and is devoid of human habitation. As a result, no people need to be rehabilitated or will be affected if the cantonment is built there.

Under the project, eight office buildings each up to four storeys and 12

residential buildings each up to 14 storeys will be built.

The ECNEC also okayed another project for construction of Bheramara (Bangladesh)- Bahrapur (India) Second 400 KV Double Circuit Transmission Line (Bangladesh Part) involving Tk 189 crore.

Currently, a 500 megawatt high voltage direct current back-to-back station has been set up at Bheramara and a 400 KV Transmission Line exists from Bheramara to Bahrapur.

Bangladesh imports 500 MW electricity from India which would increase to 1,000 MW. As part of the plan, a second transmission line is being set up.

The ECNEC also approved another project named Dredging at the Outer Bar of Mongla Port Channel that would take Tk 713 crore. The project is scheduled to be completed by 2019.

The planning ministry proposal says

at the entrance of the Mongla Port Channel there is a shallow river route called Outer Bar.

During high tide the channel has maximum 8.5-metre draught. The proposal says as a possibility of handling and transporting goods from India, Nepal and Bhutan through the Mongla Port has been created, the depth of the Outer Bar should increase.

When the Padma Bridge is open and the Padma rail link from Dhaka to Jessore is set up, the port's importance will increase manifolds.

A 1,320 MW coal-based power plant is also going to be installed there. The navigability of the port will be upgraded so that the channel's draught increases to 10.5 metres.

The ECNEC yesterday approved as many as 10 new and revised projects including these three that would involve Tk 3,334 crore.

Talukdar on Monday told reporters that army would be there, but the method of deployment was not decided yet.

He said this a day after BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia demanded army deployment with magistracy power during polls.

Talukdar, talking to reporters in the capital's Nirbachan Bhaban yesterday, reiterated what he said on Monday.

"I talked to other commissioners and their realisation is that the army should be deployed. I also personally think that there should be army to meet public expectations."

He, however, admitted that the decision over the matter was yet to be taken in an EC meeting.

Time will say how, and in which format, the army will be deployed.

Meanwhile, the acting EC Secretary Helal Uddin Ahmed said the commission would come to a decision after election schedules are announced.
