


DIU Chairman presents paper on entrepreneurship at AUAP

Khan presented in the plenary session of the conference on November 8 in front of 300 participants from 64 universities; his paper titled "Incorporating Entrepreneurship in Education" on the theme "New Initiatives to Promote Entrepreneurship and Innovative Thinking in Higher Education Institutions" drew the attention of the dignitaries. UIU organises 1st Inter-University Undergraduate Research Symposium

School of Business and Economics at United International University organised the first ever nationwide Inter-University Undergraduate Research Symposium. The award giving ceremony was held in the main campus of UIU.

Dr. Debapriya Bhattacharya, Distinguished Fellow, Center for Policy Dialogue (CPD) was present as the chief guest. A.S.M.
