Winning start for Roxy

BPL Mahbub Hossain Roxy marked his Bangladesh Premier League debut as a coach with a victory as Sheikh Jamal DC eased past Team BJMC 3-0 at the Bangabandhu National Stadium yesterday.

The national under-19 coach was the centre of discussion last week after being appointed coach of the three-time champions following the departure of Joseph Afusi. Roxy picked up right from where Afusi had left, whose last game in charge was 3-0 win over Mohammedan.

The win not only took the Dhanmondi giants just two points behind leaders Chittagong Abahani on 30 points, but also extended their winning streak to three matches. Team BJMC, on the other hand, remained in seventh position with 16 points.

Though the three-time champions looked a bit shaky in the first half, they regrouped after the break and scored two goals in the span of nine minutes to take the game away from Team BJMC.

"I analysed the previous game against Mohammedan in which Sheikh Jamal could have been 3-0 down within the first 30 minutes, which is why I instructed the players to play build up the game from behind and keep the pace a bit slow," Roxy said. "Even though we created two scoring chances [but could not capitalise], we came back strongly in the second half to outclass the opposition."

Right-back Khan Mohammad Tara whipped in a cross from the right for

Raphael Odooin, who chested down the ball to dance past a defender before blasting a powerful angular shot into the net in the 53rd minute. The Nigerian forward doubled the lead eight minutes later after a nice build-up play between Zahed Parvez and Solomon King.

Midfielder Zahed played Solomon on the right flank and the Gambian forward put a lob inside the box for Raphael, who volleyed home to raise his tally to seven goals. Solomon killed off the game on 82 minutes by snatching the ball from BJMC defender Mushfiqur Uddin Shimul and sending it over the head of advancing goalkeeper Arifuzzama Himel. That goal took Solomon to seven goals and placed him on top of the scorers' chart alongside Raphael, Kingsley Chigozie of Mohammedan and Towhidul Alam Sabuj of Chittagong Abahani.

"What I am doing is follow the formation that the players are used to because a sudden change in formation may backfire," Roxy said.

"Our players played matured football and gave a good show. I am happy with their performance and I'm happy to start the journey with a victory," said an ecstatic Roxy.

Meanwhile, Brothers Union broke Sheikh Russel KC's seven-match unbeaten run when they handed a single-goal defeat to the 2012 champions in the day's second match.

Congolese striker Siyo Zunapio separated the sides in the 76th minute nodding in a long-ball from Enamul Haque. The outcome left both teams at their previous positions, with Sheikh Russel in fifth with 19 points from 13 matches and Brothers in 10th.

Barca win Madrid derby 0-0

Barcelona were declared the true winners of the Madrid derby by the Spanish media on Sunday as the thrilling yet low-quality stalemate between Atletico and Real Madrid left the Catalans enjoying a 10-point lead over the two sides in La Liga.

Barca won 3-0 at Leganes on the outskirts of Madrid, before a bruising yet goalless first capital derby at the new Wanda Metropolitano stadium saw tempers flare all over the pitch and left Real captain Sergio Ramos with a broken nose.

"It was a war, and Barca won it," said the front page of sports daily *AS*, while *Marca* declared "Barca won the derby".

The cover of Barcelona-based daily *Sport* also focused on Ernesto Valverde's side and their considerable lead over the two Madrid rivals, headlining their edition "10 points clear - Atletico strike a blow towards the title".

There was little mention of Barca's

nearest challengers Valencia, who can reduce the gap to the Catalans to four points if they beat Espanyol on Sunday, a week before they clash at the Mestalla.

The editorial of *AS* criticised the approach of Atletico and Real in the derby.

"They were obliged to win, espe-

cially Madrid. That sensation could be

felt in the atmosphere before the game but not during it. Neither side truly believed in themselves," it said.

Atletico forward Angel Correa missed a gilt-edged chance three minutes into the game while substitute Kevin Gameiro almost found a winner

but was denied by a goalline clearance from Real's Raphael Varane.

Toni Kroos and Cristiano Ronaldo wasted Real's best efforts as Zinedine Zidane's side finished the game stronger, threatening Jan Oblak's goal in the final few minutes but to no avail.

Newspaper *ABC* was more impressed by the performances of the Madrid sides. "As you would expect, Atletico and Real Madrid engaged in a dog fight. Barcelona raced further ahead, and the only consolation is the teams put in good performances."

Real defender Varane said: "I'm disappointed because we played well, we defended well and created chances but we lacked a bit of luck in front of goal."

"We know we've got no margin for error left now. We're professionals and we're going to give everything to make sure we get as many points as we can."

Atletico midfielder Saul added: "We are hurting ourselves by not scoring as once we go ahead we're very difficult to

beat."

History not on Real's side

A draw in Saturday's Madrid derby left both Real Madrid and Atletico Madrid 10 points adrift of La Liga leaders Barcelona. In other terms that represents a difference that can be overturned in the span of four matches, a gap that has occurred only seven times in the league's history.

Although this difference has been wiped out on five of the seven occasions, it hasn't been done in over 20 years -- and never by Real.

That is not to say Los Blancos do not have memories of such comebacks. However there isn't much to take hope from for Real as they have unfortunately only been on the receiving end, and that too a historic three times.

From 1929 to 1995 a win in Spanish football was only worth two points, so four games represented a difference of eight points. Since the change of rules to award-

ing three points for a win in 1996, such a gap has not been seen.

In the most spectacular comeback, Real lost a 7 point lead to archrivals Barcelona in the National League Championship's 1928-29 season with only 11 games to play.

Real also surrendered a four-game

difference in the 1949-50 season. Atletico had then overturned a seven-point difference. But they were soon on the receiving end, losing a seven point lead over Barcelona in the 1951-52 season with 23 matches to go.

Barcelona repeated their heroics two years later, overturning Espanyol's seven-point advantage to return the title to their stadium at the time, the Estadio Les Corts.

Finally, Real Sociedad were crowned champions in 1981 after clawing back a seven point deficit and pipping Atletico to the title.

Insigne takes Napoli 4 clear

Lorenzo Insigne washed away his World Cup woes by starring in Napoli's 2-1 victory over AC Milan on Saturday that saw the Serie A leaders go four points clear.

Insigne, ignored by former Italy coach Gian Piero Ventura during the disaster against Sweden, scored in the 33rd minute. That helped extend Napoli's lead over Juventus, whose visit to Sampdoria on Sunday ended in a 3-2 loss.

Juve went three down before mounting a comeback in added time, with Gonzalo Higuain scored in the 91st minute and Paulo Dybala getting one back in the 94th.
