

Why journo Utpal not traced yet

Asks JP MP; demands statement from the home minister

It is unbelievable that the law enforcers cannot trace journalist Utpal Das in this day and age of information and communication technology, said Jatiya Party MP Pir Fazlur Rahman in Parliament yesterday.

He also demanded a statement from the home minister in this regard.

"Young journalist Utpal Das has remained traceless for more than a month. We don't think it is believable that our law enforcement agencies can't trace him," said the opposition MP.

Fazlur said some 10 people went missing in the country in the last two months. Of them, one person was found, he added.

The MP said Utpal's father, a retired primary school teacher, filed a general diary (GD) with the law enforcement agencies and frequently visits them to know about his son's whereabouts.

"It is the age of ICT. The journalist was carrying a mobile phone when he went missing. It is possible to trace him out by tracking his phone. If anyone goes missing, it is the state's duty to find him. If the person acted against the law, a lawsuit can be filed against him accordingly," he said.

Utpal Das, 27, a senior reporter of news portal purboposhchimbd.news, has been missing since October 10 when he was on his way to office in Motijheel.

"He [Bakar] brought a knife two to three weeks ago and used to intimidate others with it," said another student.

"Our Yeasin huzur [teacher] seized the knife from him and took it to his room [a portion of the hall room separated by a curtain]. Bakar might have stolen the knife and killed Zidan as the teacher was on leave," he added.

Mahmudul Haque, officer-in-charge of Paltan Police Station, said Bakar probably killed the boy as a teacher punished Bakar on Thursday following a complaint by Zidan.

"Police are looking for him," he added.

Visiting the madrasa around 1:00pm yesterday, this correspondent saw Zidan's bed and the mosquito net smeared with blood. Panic spread among students and guardians. Many of the parents visited the madrasa yesterday, and a few took their children home.

The madrasa teachers or officials were not available for comments.

Meanwhile, following an autopsy at Dhaka Medical College, the family of Zidan who lives in Thatari Bazar area received his body.

The boy was youngest among five children of Hafizur Rahman, a chicken trader.

different entry points including international airports, seaports and land ports.

"The quarantine stations were established from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2017, under the animal disease prevention and control project," he said in reply to a written query from treasury bench member Nizam Uddin Hazari of Feni-2.

The minister said the quarantine stations were set up at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Hazrat Shah Amanat

International Airport, Osmani International Airport, ICD Kamalapur, Sona Masjid, Akhaura, Belonia, Bangabandha, Burimari, Darshana, Bibir Bazar, Bhomra, Hili, Benapole, Tamabil, Jokiganj, Sutarkandi, Kamalapur, Rohonpur, Birol, Teknaf and Bituly land ports; and Chittagong and Mongla Seaports.

Besides, he said, the government procured necessary equipment, furniture and vehicles including pickup trucks and motor-cycles for the quarantine stations.

petrol or for a CNG-run vehicle, 27 litres of petrol and 270 cubic metres of gas per month from respective ministries, he said.

Besides, privileged full-time officials of various offices, organisations and directorates

would get Tk 25,000 for vehicle repair work.

If an office or organisation cannot provide a vehicle for fulltime use, Tk 50,000 would be allocated upon release order from ministries or department concerned along with recommendation from the office chief, Ashraf said.

have you placed it as an exhibit? On one hand, you are saying the book is not authoritative, but on the other hand you exhibited the book. Why?

"We submitted the book to show the brutality of the atrocities committed there [Sylhet]," Tapas said.

"No, you are trying to confuse us. We will write about the matter separately [in the judgement]," said Justice Shahinur.

The other prosecutor, Sultan Mahmud Simon, then said although they were not relying on the book, they submitted it as it has clues of the crimes committed there. The tribunal then kept the case waiting for delivering judgement.

The HC bench came up with the rule and orders after hearing a writ petition filed by SC lawyer Bashir Ahmed seeking necessary order on this issue.

The lawyer filed the petition after Unesco recognised the March 7 speech of Bangabandhu as a world documentary heritage last month.

Director General of Unesco Irina Bokova announced the decision on October 31 at the Unesco Headquarters in Paris.
