Release of PCJSS men demanded

Leaders of Parbattya Chattagram Jana Samhati Samiti (PCJSS) Bandarban unit yesterday demanded the unconditional release of its arrested leaders and activists.

They brought out a protest procession in the town demanding withdrawal of all false cases filed against them.

The PCJSS leaders also submitted a memorandum to the home minister through the deputy commissioner in Bandarban.

As the historic Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Peace Accord has not been implemented since its signing nearly two decades ago, the overall law and order situation in the hills is getting worse day by day, the PCJSS leaders said.

They also warned of a massive agitation programme in CHT if their leaders and activists are not released immediately.

On November 20, a Bandarban court sent PCJSS's 15 leaders and activists to jail rejecting their bail prayer, in connection with a case filed for collecting illegal toll.

Mohammad Abdul Alim of Rajbilla area in Sadar upazila, who drives a motorcycle on rental basis, filed the case with Sadar Police Station on November 15.

The arrestees include PCJSS central committee Secretary of Cultural Affairs and Education Joli Mong Marma, its Secretary of Land Affairs Ching Hla Mong Chak, Parbattya Chattagram Jubo Samiti Bandarban unit President Mostu Marma, and Pahari Chhatra Parishad President Ajit Tongchangya.

PCJSS Bandarban unit Secretary Kyawba Mong Marma said at least five cases were filed against their leaders and activists between June 2016 and November 2017.

Quality of education questioned

Ruling party men govern most SMC president posts in Pirojpur

The quality of education is hindered as most of the president posts of the managing committees at around 450 high schools and madrasas in seven upazilas of the district is occupied by influential members of the ruling political party.

To select a president, guardians of students first select the school managing committee (SMC) members; later, a president is elected. However, this process is maintained only on pen and paper at the moment, especially at the madrasas.

The main roles of the SMC president include appointing the headmaster, development works, and utilisation of government funds for

the school.

Allegations against these presidents include misbehaving with the teachers. They often fail to properly monitor the school activities as they live in Dhaka or other distant places, and remain busy with their political agenda, say teachers.

Md Kamrul Ahsan, headmaster of Bhabanipur High School inIndurkani upazila, said teachers often complain of failure to take signatures from the managing committee president on important papers, including salary sheets, and a lack of proper etiquette.

An SMC president should hold at least a graduation degree, added Ahsan.

In addition, many exercise the right to become SMC presidents of more

than one institution by giving donations or using political influence, further compromising on the quality of education at the secondary level.

"If a person is the president of more than one institution, he cannot manage the institutions prop-

erly," he said.

Professor Sheikh Sayedur Rahman, a retired principal of a government college, said the system of selecting the SMC president must be changed.

Ramesh Chandra Biswas, district education officer (DEO) at Pirojpur, said they often get complaints from the teachers of improper behaviour by the SMC presidents.

"In many cases, the managing committees appoint weaker teachers and support staff, to pay lower salaries. Our hands are tied as they have the power to do so."

"I have taken up the matter with higher authorities, but the problem persists as the SMC president is selected locally according to the law," added the DEO.

HSTU STUDENTS, TRANSPORT WORKERS CLASH

Indefinite transport strike snaps road link

Road communication between the district and other parts of the country remained cut-off since yesterday morning as transport workers started an indefinite strike protesting an attack on them and burning of two passenger buses over a trivial issue.

Ten transport workers sustained injuries during the attack by students of Hajee Danesh Science and Technology University (HSTU), claimed leaders of the workers' union.

Witnesses said a passenger bus bumped into another bus carrying students of HSTU at Maharaja School intersection in the town around 7:30pm on Wednesday. The students beat up the driver and helper of the passenger bus. They were taken to M Abdur Rahim Medical College Hospital.

On hearing about the clash, the students blocked the Dinajpur-Rangpur Highway around 9 km from Dinajpur Central Bus terminal.

During the blockade, students clashed with the transport workers in Basherhat area. The students torched two buses at around 8:30pm. Two vehicles of Fire Service and Civil Defence went to the spot, but the students did not allow them to douse the fire.

Police also tried to control them, but

could not.

Superintendent of Police (SP) in the district Hamidul Alam went to the spot around 11:30pm and persuaded the students to go back to their campus.

Transport workers and bus operators held an emergency meeting on Wednesday night, protesting the attack and burning of buses, and announced an indefinite strike from 6:00am yesterday.

All the counters selling bus tickets were closed yesterday.

General Secretary of Dinajpur Transport Workers' Union M Rafiq alleged that university authorities provoked the students to be unruly. They demanded removal of the vice-chancellor and proctor of HSTU for their failure to control the students. They also demanded compensation for the burnt buses.

Buses will not ply the roads until their demands are met, Rafiq said.

Students of HSTU blocked the highway in front of the university since yesterday. They are chasing journalists in the university area, alleged several journalists.

The SP said they were trying to settle the issue. Vice Chancellor Prof Dr M Abul Kashem could not be contacted as he did not receive any calls.

One killed as villagers clash

A man, who was injured in a clash between two groups of villagers on Wednesday in Gobindaganj upazila of Gaibandha, died at Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital in Bogra yesterday.

Police said the victim, Azher Bepari, 60, a farmer of Katabari village, put up a fence around his land, which his neighbour Golzar Rahman protested.

Later, Azher's men and Golzar's group clashed, leaving 10 people injured. Locals took Azher to the hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries on Thursday morning.
