Arrested six students confess to cheating

Six students, three of whom from Dhaka University, arrested on Saturday over cheating in the admission tests of Barisal University, gave confessional statements before a Barisal court yesterday.

Magistrate Amit Kumar Dey recorded their statements, said Mahbubul Alam, a sub-inspector of the Detective Branch of Barisal Metropolitan Police (BMP).

However, Mahbubul, also the investigation officer of the case, said the six told the court that they were involved in leaking questions and supplying answers via electronic devices to five admission seekers in exchange for money.

After recording the statements, they were sent to Barisal Central Jail, he said, adding that they are trying to arrest other members of the gang.

Sub-inspector Ashish Kumar of the DB lodged a case with Kotwali Police Station after the six had been caught red-handed in a rented house on Arshed Ali Contractor Lane in Barisal city while they were involved in such activities.

Of the arrestees, Maruf Hossain Maruf of geology, Alamgir Hossain Sahin of soil, water and environment science, and Mahamudul Hasan Abid of mathematics are from Dhaka University.

The rest are Rakib Akon of Mohammadpur Degree College, Sabbir Ahamed Pritom of

Galachipa Degree College and Muidur Rahman of sociology of Barisal University.

Five electro-magnetic devices (EMD), 11 cellphone sets, 13 SIMs and five electro-magnetic blue tooth inductions were seized from them.

Describing the process of cheating at a press conference on Saturday, BMP Commissioner SM Ruhul Amin said the gangsters install an

EMD, which acts as a mobile phone, with an inserted SIM, in an examinee's body.

They also give the person a blue tooth induction, which is actually an earphone, he said.

"In the exam hall, they connect an examinee to the EMD by calling and get the multiple choice questions from the person. Instantly, they provide the answers to the examinee," he added.

Defamation case filed

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nephew Syed Asaduzzaman Minar filed a complaint with Madaripur Sadar Police Station against Prof Asif Nazrul under section 57 of the information and communication technology (ICT) act for the same post over alleged irregularities in recruitment at Chittagong Port.

The complaint is pending for approval with the Police Headquarters. Police need the approval to register a case under the section, Quamrul Hasan, officer-in-charge of the police station, told The Daily Star.

Asif Nazrul, a teacher of law department, said he was falsely implicated for a post that was uploaded by a fake Facebook page named after him.

"I did not upload any post against or about the minister. There are some fake pages named after me and on a number of occasions, I cautioned all about those fake pages by posting status at my own Facebook account and at the fan page I myself administer," he told The Daily Star yesterday.

"Yet, filing of a defamation case and a complaint under section 57 of the ICT act against me is very unfortunate and it shows how unjustly innocent persons could be harassed through exploitation of the legal system of the country," he added.

The DU teacher urged the authorities concerned to verify the authenticity of the Facebook page from where the post was uploaded before deciding on the question of approval of the case under section 57.

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technology professor at Khulna University. "What Aruni is doing is cross-breeding, and he's on the right track. Aruni likewise thinks farmers are true scientists. "Farmers need to experiment with new ideas in their work lives," he explains. "They need to keenly observe their surroundings and engage in growing their crops with enthusiasm. Farmers are the ones who spend all day with their crops. They should be aware if a new variety is desirable, if cross-breeding is suitable."

"And beyond that," he continues philosophically, "every man has his inclination for creativity. He'd best nurture it, for the benefit of humankind."

In pursuance of the order dated-16.11.2017, passed by hon'ble presiding Judge of the Admiralty Bench Mr. Justice A. F. M. Abdur Rahman, in the Admiralty Suit no. 62 of 2016 regarding the sale in public auction of the Vessel "M.V. CRYSTAL SAPPHIRE", now lying under arrest at the outer anchorage of Chittagong port, Chittagong it is hereby notified that the said Vessel "M.V. CRYSTAL SAPPHIRE" Shall be sold "as it is where it is" basis by public auction in close bid system by the Marshal of the Court or his substitute at his office in the High Court Division of the Bangladesh Supreme Court on 10th day of December, 2017 at 2.30 p.m.

Information regarding the said vessel is available from the office of the Registrar General & Marshal and the same may be inspected, upon prior permission, at the location. Intending local and foreign bidders may participate in the auction by submitting written proposal mentioning the proposed price in closed envelope at the office of the Marshal on the date and time mentioned above. Foreign bidders or their authorized agents may also participate in the auction, subject to fulfillment of the requirements of the foreign Exchange control Regulations of Bangladesh.

The bidder, shall be required to deposit pay Order or Bank Draft of 10% of the bid value from any scheduled bank in the name of the "Registrar General & Marshal of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh" as security money along with the bid in the closed envelop. The successful bidder may request for adjustment of his security money with his bid money, while the unsuccessful bidders will get their pay Order/Bank Draft deposited as security money returned at the convenience of the Marshal.

On acceptance of the highest bid by the Marshal (subject to confirmation by the admiralty Court) the successful bidder shall be informed.
