

# 13 risky Bailey bridges in Nilphamari

Many important roads accident-prone

Thirteen Bailey bridges over different rivers on important roads in the district have become severely damaged, causing accidents and disrupting road communication.

The bridges are Ananda Babur bridge, Kachukatar bridge, Duhuli bridge, Kurar Par bridge and Hafezia bridge on Nilphamari-Jaldhaka road, Auliakhana bridge on Jaldhaka-Domar road, Modhupur bridge on Saidpur-Taraganj road, Bahagli bridge on Kishoreganj-Taraganj road, Gomnati bridge and Motukpur bridge on Domar-Chilahati road, Thutardanga bridge on Sutibari-Sardarhat road, Ramganj bridge on Ramganj-Mirganj road and Tinbot bridge on Domar-Bhadur Darga road.

Roads and Highways Department (RHD) set up the bridges on temporary basis 20 to 30 years ago as replacement for the old concrete bridges built in the British and Pakistan eras, which were damaged due to natural calamities like flood, and also during political unrest.

District RHD Sub-Assistant Engineer Noor-e-Alam Siddiquee said Bailey bridges are usually set up as interim measures until a permanent concrete bridge is made, and are capable of bearing a load of 10 tonnes at most.

Ignoring the rules, trucks carrying 50 to 60 tonnes of goods cross the bridges, making them risky, he added.

On Tuesday, the front wheel of a 10-wheeler truck loaded with 50 tonnes of rocks got stuck between two displaced steel plates while crossing the Duhuli Bailey bridge, snapping communication for four hours, said Kachukata Union Parishad Chairman Abdur Rouf.

Tenganmari College Principal Mahabubuzzaman Riton said a motorcyclist was severely injured when he fell from the Hafezia bridge 15 days ago as its plates were displaced.

Duhuli bridge, Hafezia bridge and Auliakhana bridge were damaged during the political unrest in 2013 and 2014, said Md Moniruzzaman, sub-divisional engineer of RHD in the district.

District Executive Engineer of RHD Hamidul Islam said the condition of the Bailey bridges was very bad, adding that his department has put up warning signboards on both ends of the bridges, asking heavy vehicle drivers not to carry loads of more than five tonnes.

"We've called a tender to build four new concrete bridges at Hafezia, Duhuli, Kochukata and Ananda Babu areas, and we will do so for other bridges soon," he added.

## Jessore AL leader killed by rivals

Sardar Milon succumbs to his injuries in a Dhaka hospital

An Awami League (AL) leader, who was injured in an attack allegedly by some of his party rivals in Jessore town on November 6, died at a hospital in Dhaka on Wednesday night.

The deceased, Sardar Milon, organising secretary of Basundia union unit of AL, was son of Babu Sardar of Padmabila village in Jessore Sadar upazila.

Habibul Ahsan Bablu, general secretary of Basundia union unit AL, said critically injured Milon was first admitted to Jessore Sadar Hospital and later shifted to National Institute of Traumatology and Orthopaedic Rehabilitation (popularly known as Pangu Hospital) in the capital following deterioration of his condition.

After the namaz-e-janaza, he was laid to eternal rest at his family graveyard at Padmabila village yesterday afternoon, Bablu said.

Inspector Motiur Rahman of Sadar Police Outpost said, after recovering a bit, Milon filed a case against 10 to 15 unnamed people with Kotwali Police Station.

According to the case statement, Milon attended an anti-terrorism rally organised by district unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), protesting the murder of local BCL leader Emon, in Daratana area in the town on November 6.

After the rally, while he was returning home along with some BCL activists, a group of 10 to 15 people chased him in front of Haji Muhammad Mohsin Road around 5:30pm.

At one stage, the gang caught Milon and stabbed him indiscriminately and left the place hurriedly, leaving him critically injured.

Hearing screams, local people rescued Milon and admitted him to Jessore Medical College Hospital, from where he was shifted to Pangu Hospital in the capital.

Inspector Matiu, also investigation officer of the case, said they are yet to arrest anyone in this connection.

## HARTAL ENDS 'Punish killers of Aurobindo'

A daylong Jubo League-enforced hartal in the district passed off peacefully yesterday.

The shutdown was called protesting the killing of Aurobindo Chakma, vice president of Jurachhari upazila unit of Jubo League and demanding exemplary punishment of killers.

The 12-hour hartal started around 6:00am and was observed without any untoward incident.

Roads and waterways communication between Chittagong and 10 upazilas of Rangamati remained suspended during the hartal hours. Shops and other business establishments in Banarupa, College Gate, Bhedvedi, Reserve Bazar and Tabalchhari areas in Rangamati town also remained closed.

Meanwhile, a rally was held in the town around 7:30am. Rangamati municipality Mayor Akbar Hossain Chowdhury led the rally.

Satyajit Barua, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said additional police have been deployed in the area to avert any untoward incident.

Aurobindo was shot dead by miscreants in Debachhari area of Jurachhari upazila on Tuesday night.
