"Why the cigarette companies would get advantage?" he asked.

Lawmaker Nazmul Haque Prodhan said, "I'm very much surprised that the finance minister recently declared that it would abolish only the bidi industry within three years, but not the entire tobacco sector."

Bangladesh Bidi Workers Federation Joint Secretary Abdur Rahman said the bidi industry would close automatically in near future as cigarettes are becoming cheaper.

Besides, the government imposed excessive tax on it, and the workers in the sector are living a miserable life, he added.

Lawmaker Kazi Rozi and RDC General Secretary Zannat-E-Ferdousi also spoke.

Big day for the differently-abled

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were looking for candidates with disabilities.

Talking to The Daily Star, Shamsur Nahar, production manager of Dutch Bangla Pack Ltd, a producer of flexible intermediate bulk containers (FIBCs), said they needed a female candidate for monitoring CCTV videos on the TV screen.

Addressing the opening session of the fair, speakers said persons with disabilities could make contributions to every workplace. There is a huge pool of potential employees from this section of the population, from whom companies and businesses can benefit, they said.

Siddiqur Rahman, president of BGMEA (Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association), said these specially-abled people should be motivated in the workplace. Companies should train them and put them in positions where their passion lies, he said.

Afroza Khan, secretary-in-charge at the labour and employment ministry, said this sort of job fair should also be held in remote areas in the country where there were little employment opportunities for disabled people.

Kishore Kumar Singh, chief technical advisor, International Labour Organization (ILO), also spoke on the occasion.

Bir Shreshtho Ruhul Amin's

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got the highest gallantry award.

Ruhul joined the then Pakistan Navy as a sailor in 1953. In 1968, he was posted to BNS Baktiar in Chittagong and had been serving there till the 1971 Liberation War.

On December 10, 1971, when a convoy of three ships, including The Palash of

which Ruhul Amin was a sailor, reached near Khulna, four enemy aircraft bombed the convoy that caught fire. Ruhul did not leave the ship, tried to extinguish the fire and continued attacking the enemy. Meantime, he became injured and fell into the river.

He reached the shore but unfortunately got caught by Razakars who killed him later.

Strike called off

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Both current and former students, former Ducsu leaders joined the rally and demanded Ducsu polls. They said the students are being deprived of their democratic rights due to the dysfunctional Ducsu.

"The authorities had assured us several times of holding Ducsu polls but did not take any visible steps," said Masud Mahdi, coordinator of the movement that has been demanding the polls for long.

Speakers at the rally threatened to wage a tougher movement if the authorities fail to announce the Ducsu election manifesto by January 10.

On December 6, Walid, a student of Social Welfare and Research Institute of DU, was admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) as his health condition had deteriorated. He was injected with saline at the DMCH; but he returned to Memory Eternal premises immediately afterwards and declared to continue his strike despite falling ill. He did not take any food except for water since November 25.

Since the first day, different student organisations and DU teachers expressed solidarity with Walid's movement, but no fruitful initiative was taken by the authorities until yesterday.

So far, all the student organisations had expressed support for Walid except for Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

The last election to Ducsu, representative body of the students, was held on June 6, 1990.

As per the purchase agreement with Boeing, pre-delivery payment (PDP) of approximately US\$ 136.28 million has already been paid to Boeing for two 787-8 aircraft supported by Sovereign Guarantee.

Biman Bangladesh Airlines signed an agreement with Boeing on April 22, 2008 for purchase of new generation four 777-300ER and four 787-8 aircraft. Another agreement was also signed with Boeing on May 30, 2008 for purchase of two 737-800 aircraft.

Biman already took deliveries of four 777-300ER in 2011 and 2014 and two 737-800 in November and December 2015.

The Boeing 787 Dreamliner is a long-range, mid-size, wide-body, twin-engine jet airliner developed by Boeing Commercial Airplanes. Its variants seat 242 to 335 passengers in typical 3-class seating configurations.

It is Boeing's most fuel-efficient airliner pressed into commercial flight service in late 2011 and the world's first major airliner to

use composite materials as the primary material in the construction of its airframe.

The 787 has been designed to be 20 percent fuel efficient than the 767.

The 787 Dreamliner's distinguishing features include mostly electrical flight systems, a four-panel windshield, noise-reducing chevrons on its engine nacelles, and a smoother nose contour.

It shares a common type rating with the larger Boeing 777, allowing qualified pilots to operate both models, due to related design features. Established in February 1972, Biman is currently operating flights to seven domestic and 15 international destinations. Out of the international destinations, Biman operates to two destinations in the Saarc region, four destinations in the South East Asia, eight destinations in the Gulf and Middle-East and one destination in Europe.

Its 13-craft fleet includes four 777-300ER, two 777-200ER, one A330-200, four 737-800 and two Dash-8-Q400 aircraft.

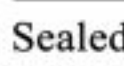
