RU dean resigns after being punished over controversial questions

A Rajshahi University dean, who selected controversial questions in the recent admission test, yesterday sent a resignation letter to the vice chancellor. Prof Mustafizur Rahman of the fine arts faculty mentioned in the resignation letter that he resigned from the post of dean on "personal ground", said Registrar Prof MA Bari. The letter reached the VC's office, said Bari, adding that the dean will stay in the post until the VC approves it. Prof Mustafizur, also convener of the question-making committee, sent the resignation letter four days after an RU syndicate meeting had punished him and another teacher. On Wednesday, Prof Mustafizur and Zillur Rahman, an assistant professor of printmaking and oriental art department and a member of the committee, were barred from taking part in any examination process of the university for 10 years. In addition, a five-year delay is to be slapped on M Zillur's next promotion. The meeting also made a primary decision to remove Prof Mustafizur as the dean. In the October 25 admission test, there was a multiple-choice question: "What is the name of the greatest book in the world?" The options were: A) The Holy Quran, B) The Holy Bible, C) The Holy Injil and D) Gita. Another question was: "When did the Myanmar army and the Buddhists launch an armed attack on the Rohingya Muslims?"

ACC arrests three CDA engineers

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday arrested three engineers of the Chittagong Development Authority (CDA) at their offices in the port city over embezzling around Tk 39.29 lakh from construction projects. A Chittagong court sent the three--assistant engineers Sayed Golam Sarwar and Hamidul Haque, and Deputy Assistant Engineer Md Jahangir Alam to jail. Sarwar has been made accused in six cases over embezzling Tk 24,56,160 while Hamidul in one case and Jahangir in two cases over misappropriating Tk 52,541 and Tk 14,19,695 respectively, said Chittagong ACC's Director Aktar Hossain. They allegedly embezzled the money in cooperation with contractors at different times. The ACC filed the cases in 2008.

Trump's decision on Jerusalem to affect peace

BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia yesterday said US President Donald Trump's decision to recognise Jerusalem as Israel's capital would seriously affect peace and stability in the Middle East. Expressing deep concern, the former premier in a statement said this decision would also affect the two-staged solution efforts and urged Trump to review the decision. "I am deeply worried like other peace-loving people of the world over the fresh commotion in the Middle East generated by Trump's recognition..." she said. Khaleda thinks the US president's decision is a slap on the right and desire of Palestinian people to live independently in their own country.

NO END TO BLOODSPILL ON ROADS
Accidents claim 8 lives

Eight people were killed and 12 others injured in road accidents in the country in last two days. Our Dinajpur correspondent reports, two motorcyclists were killed when a shallow engine-run three-wheeler locally known as Nasiman hit their motorcycle on Dinajpur-Thakurgaon road near Pachpir area in Birganj upazila yesterday afternoon. The dead are Abul Kashem, 28, and Rana Islam, 25, of village Chakai in Birganj upazila. In another accident, the manager of Rupali Bank's Ranirbandar Branch, Afsaruzzaman, 33, of Daburi village in Thakurgaon, was killed when a bus hit his motorbike on Dinajpur-Rangpur highway near Tetulia in Chirirbandar upazila on Saturday night. Our Thakurgaon correspondent reports, a woman was killed as a truck hit her on Panchagarh-Debiganj highway at Sardarpara village in Boda upazila yesterday. The victim was Fulera Begum, 58, wife

of Azijul Haque of the same village. Police seized the truck but its driver and helper fled away. A case was filed. Our Tangail correspondent reports, three bus passengers were killed and 12 others injured when the Dhaka-bound bus collided head-on with a truck on Bangabandhu Bridge at Soratoli in Kalihati upazila around 8:00am yesterday. Identities of the dead could not be known immediately. Police with the help of locals rushed them to Tangail General Hospital. Earlier around 7:00am, an unidentified youth died on the spot as a bus ran him over on the same road when he was crossing the road.
