



DB again fails to place probe report in Avijit murder case

COURT CORRESPONDENT
A Dhaka court yesterday again ordered the Detective Branch of police to submit on January 16 next year the probe report of the case filed over the killing of writer-blogger Avijit Roy. Metropolitan Magistrate Ahsan Habib passed the order after Fazlur Rahman, an assistant superintendent of DB police and also the investigation officer of the case, failed to submit the report by yesterday.

Apart from that, the court had fixed 29 dates for submission of the probe report but the IO failed to complete the probe. Suspected militants hacked to death Avijit, founder of Mukto-Mona blog, near the Teacher-Student Centre on the Dhaka University campus on February 26, 2015. His wife Rafida Ahmed Bonya was also injured in the attack.

"We did not lose hope, though," Aziz said. He waited for the floodwater to recede. Taking a risk, he removed the damaged plants and sowed again. Now, he reaps fruits of the late planting and expects it will help him cover the losses incurred during the tumultuous period. "Though the yield from the second planting will only help me recoup losses, I am happy," an ecstatic Aziz told The Daily Star. Aziz, from Purbo Notun Gram, north of Gumai Beel, lost 200 decim of paddy land due to flood that occurred thrice with intervals following incessant rains in August. He wasn't the only one though. Many farmers stared heavy losses in the face. That is when the agriculture ministry began a programme to help the most vulnerable farmers and turned a disastrous situation around. Karima Akter, upazila agricultural officer, told The Daily Star that five thousand farmers of four unions in Rangunia upazila depend on Gumai Beel for their livelihood. This August, among 3.5 thousand hectares, at least two thousand hectares got

submerged due to the floods, she added. Gumai Beel, that borders four unions of Rangunia upazila and encompasses an area of 3,500 hectares, produces 16,800 metric tonnes of Aman. Annually, including Boro, the yield stands at 28,000 metric tonnes. "Following the disaster, we took some quick initiatives distributing some BIRI-22, 23 variety which takes less time than other varieties to yield including BIRI-49 and 50. The yield now makes the farmers hope again of recouping their losses," she added. However, out of 2,500 farmers at Gumai Beel, only 200 were recipients of the government programme, said a number of farmers. During a recent visit, farmers on the east of the field were seen harvesting the rain-fed monsoon grain that typically contributes 38 percent to the country's yearly rice output. Though Aziz did not get benefit from the government programme, he did not give up. He worked hard and got rewarded at the end of the day.

But the investigation found evidence of neglectful use of sub-standard parts for operating the aircraft by three of the accused. So, the three accused -- Siddiqur Rahman, Shah Alam and Najmul Haq -- should be brought under trial for their alleged involvement with neglectful operation of the flight carrying Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. The VIP flight carrying Hasina made an emergency landing on November 27 last year at Ashgabat International Airport in Turkmenistan after a loose nut caused engine oil leakage and oil pressure loss in engine 1 of the Boeing 777-300ER aircraft. On December 21, Wing Commander (ret'd) MM Asaduzzaman, director of engineering and material management of Biman, filed the case against nine Biman employees under the Special Powers Act with Airport Police Station. Two more Biman officials were arrested later.

Dhaka south city unit BNP arranged the programme marking the party senior vice chairman Tarique Rahman's 53rd birthday. Meanwhile, BNP yesterday announced a countrywide protest programme for tomorrow (December 13), against the price hike of essential commodities and electricity. He called upon party activists to stage protests in district headquarters across the country, except for Rangpur city where an election is due on December 21. BNP's all thana units in the capital will hold similar programmes tomorrow. Meanwhile, the party has formed a committee to coordinate activities and garner support for their mayoral candidate in the Rangpur City Corporation election. Iqbal Hasan Mahmud Tuku, vice chairman of BNP, is the convener of the committee.

EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS HC questions legality of seeking marital status info

The High Court yesterday questioned the legality of seeking information about marital status of admission seekers at educational institutions. The court issued a rule asking the authorities concerned of the government to explain why such action should not be declared unconstitutional. The HC also asked the authorities to admit a female student, who gave birth to a baby after being raped, to Rajshahi Government Nursing College. A complexity was created over the marital status when she wanted to get admitted to the nursing college, as the college authorities asked her to write in the admission form that she is abandoned by husband. Yesterday, the bench of Justice Quazi Reza-Ul-Hoque and Justice Mohammad Ullah came up with the rule and order after hearing a writ petition filed by two Supreme Court lawyers. They submitted the petition to the HC following a news report published by a Bangla daily on November 14 on the incident.

Ex-envoys want Maroof Zaman's safe return

Maroof has been missing since he left his Dhanmondi residence on December 4.
