


Five, including two Rohingyas, held with yaba

STAR REPORT
Officials of the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) and Detective Branch of police arrested five persons, including two Rohingyas refugees, with 43,000 yaba pills in Chittagong and Savar yesterday.
Our Chittagong correspondent reports, the DNC team arrested two Rohingyas with 2,500 yaba pills, worth Tk 8.5 lakh, at Chittagong's Patiya upazila. The arrestees are Anisullah, 20, and Md Rafik, 18, of Kutupalong refugee camp in Ukhiya of Cox's Bazar, said Assistant Director Md Zillur Rahman. The DNC team arrested the duo in Monsha Badamtal area around 8:30am when they were getting off a bus. A case was filed with Patiya Police Station.
Meanwhile, our Savar correspondent reports, Detective Branch (DB) of police in separate drives arrested three people with 40,500 yaba pills in Savar. Tofayel Ahmed, 23, was arrested with 7,500 yaba tablets from a house in Mograkanda village under Bhakurta union, said OC AFM Sayeed of DB (Dhaka north).

an average 12,000 calls daily. A majority of the callers called to check the number. During this period, the call centre provided emergency services to 1,100 people.
Sources in the police headquarters said the ICT adviser first directed the ICT division to create a national emergency number in October, 2015.

The information division established the 999 service at Kaliakoir Hi-Tech Park and ran on a trial basis from October 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. Analysing the calls during this period, they found that 64.8 percent asked for police, 31.1 percent for fire and 4.1 percent for ambulance service.
On the other hand, police in a bid to provide emergency services decided to

establish a call centre with a short code "100" on July 20, 2016.
As the helpdesk received the majority calls seeking police service, the ICT adviser directed the ICT division to hand over the emergency number to the home ministry on October 8, 2017.
The home ministry later held meetings with police, and the existing short code was replaced to "999".

Turn port city into digital hub

Speakers tell panel discussion

Speakers at a panel discussion yesterday stressed the need for digitising Chittagong Port as well as turning the port city into a digital hub for the overall development of the country.
The discussion titled "Digital Development: Road to Empowerment" was organised by Grameenphone Limited at a city hotel in the afternoon.
"As the commercial capital of the country and the economic hub, Chittagong must be developed digitally as the development of the whole country depends on it," said Mahbul Alam, president of Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI), at the discussion.
When Chittagong Port will be digitised, irregularities will be gone, which will eradicate the sufferings of businessmen, added Mahbul.
"If the data entry method was digitised ... traders could be benefited from that," said the CCCI president.

At least 11 workers suffered burns in a gas cylinder explosion at a cosmetics factory in Jamalpur of Kaliakoir upazila in Gazipur yesterday.
A fire broke out in the factory, FS Cosmetics Ltd, after the explosion. Several of the 35 workers, who were working inside, managed to run out.
Firefighters managed to douse the fire around 8:00pm. Six of the injured were taken to Dhaka while the others to different local hospitals, local sources said.

Md Babla and Md Monir Hossain got life imprisonment. Both of them were also fined Tk 20,000 each.
Judge Abdur Rahman Sarder of the Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 of Dhaka handed down the sentence, while Babla and Monir were present at the court.
The judge said that the execution order of the fugitives will be carried out right after their arrest or surrender.
On January 9, 2009, Rana was killed by his co-workers, following a dispute over the distribution of extorted money.
Cops recovered Rana's body the next day, from the spot and filed a case with Demra Police Station accusing some unknown persons.

he said he got Tk 5 lakh during marriage but could not show any documents.
Asir said he got Tk 16 lakh by selling a land and he bought a piece of land in Dakkhinkhan at Tk 70.5 lakh. He failed to produce any documents for both the transactions.
He also said he received Tk 20 lakh from his brother-in-law. But ACC's investigation officer found that his brother-in-law did not file any tax nor he was capable of giving such a large amount.
Asir further said he got Tk 14.86 lakh from selling jewelries to one Prime Jewellers in Mirpur but the investigation officer found the related documents were forged.
The accused also said he sold trees worth Tk 15 lakh to one Khan Saw Mill and Furniture Mart in Mymensingh. However, owner of the mill, Shahin Khan in the interrogation said he bought trees from Asir's brother Sharifuzzaman.
The executive engineer said he received a loan of Tk 20 lakh from one Sirajuddola, managing director of Agragami Engineers Ltd. ACC in the probe found that Sirajuddola is a contractor of CAAB and being a public servant Asir cannot take such a loan.

issued on October 12.
On November 3 last year, AB Siddique, president of Bangladesh Jananetri Parishad, a pro-Awami League organisation, filed the case with the court, accusing Khaleda and her late husband and former president Ziaur Rahman of undermining the country's map and national flag.
According to the case statement, Zia had become the country's president after the killings of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and most of his family members on August 15, 1975. Zia also threatened Bangabandhu's daughter Sheikh Hasina and confined her after she arrived in the country from abroad on May 17, 1981.
Khaleda had formed a coalition government with Jamaat-e-Islami in 2001. She appointed ministers from Jamaat and handed over the map and the national flag of independent Bangladesh despite their role against the country during the Liberation War in 1971, the statement read.
Those activities were tantamount to undermining the country's map and national flag, it added.
