


IN MEMORIAM

The world bid farewell to many iconic artists, celebrities and politicians in 2017. The irreplaceable loss that the void has created can never be filled. This is a small tribute from the Star Showbiz family to chronicle some of the greatest minds who left us for good.

ABDUR RAZZAK JANUARY 23, 1942- AUGUST 21, 2017

"Nayak Raj" Razzak was a legendary actor and Director of Bangladesh. He was one of the most influential actors of this country and was called to be the "Banglar Uttam Kumar" for this charismatic looks and appearance. Films like Jibon Theke Neya, Baba Keno Chakor, Chutir Ghonta and many more made Razzak the Raj of the Film Industry. He won the "Bangladeshi National Film Award for the Best Actor" five times and was awarded the Independence Day Award in 2015.



ABDUL JABBAR NOVEMBER 7, 1938- AUGUST 30, 2017



Eminent Bangladeshi singer and freedom fighter Abdul Jabbar inspired the whole nation during the Liberation War of 1971 with his patriotic songs. He associated his patriotism with creativity and produced songs like *Tumi Ki Dekhechho Kobhu Jiboner Porajoy, Salam Salam Hajar Salam* and many more. Due to kidney failure this veteran breathed his last at BSMMU Hospital.

ANNISUL HUQ

OCTOBER 27, 1952- NOVEMBER 30, 2017

Annisul Huq was more than an entrepreneur for Bangladeshis; he was a man of fascinating personality, the elected Mayor of Dhaka North City Corporation in 2015. He diligently worked for the citizens of the country and inspired the youths to dream and achieve big.



BARI SIDDIQUI NOVEMBER 15, 1954- NOVEMBER 24, 2017

Singer, song-writer and a memorable flutist of Bangladesh, Bari Siddiqui devoted his whole life to folk music. He won the Bachsas Award as a music director for the film Srabon Megher Din for rendering the song Shua Chan Pakhi. Amar Gaye Joto Dukkho Shoy, Oporadhi Hoileo Ami Tor and Matir Deho were some of his best tracks. He left us at the age of 63 due to a heart attack at Square Hospital.




LUCKY AKHAND JUNE 7, 1956- APRIL 21, 2017





CHESTER BENNINGTON MARCH 20, 1976- JULY 20, 2017

Chester Bennington was the front man of *Linkin Park*, who gave voice to the super hit songs like *In the End*, *Breaking the Habit*, *Closer*, *Numb* and many more. His music dominated the music-charts of mid 2000's. Rock music was given a new dimension with his innovative composition.



SHASHI KAPOOR MARCH 18, 1938- DECEMBER 4, 2017



Shashi Kapoor was one of the most attractive and celebrated actors of Indian film industry. His filmy persona and charismatic look attracted fans from all over the world. Deewar, Kabhi Kabhi, Satyam Shivam Sundaram and Suhaag were some of his blockbuster hits.
