Hunger strike rolls on amid cold

108 madrasa teachers fall ill; 9 hospitalised

With a thin blanket tucked in, Mohammad Ismail was lying on the road in front of Jatiya Press Club yesterday afternoon amid icy wind.

It was the fourth day the teacher of an ebtedai madrasa in Bogra stayed there to press for one demand -- nationalisation of the registered madrasas. "Four days have passed by, no one from the government

came to us... But we will not return home without realising our demand. We'll die on the road if needed," he said.

The indefinite hunger strike of the madrasa teachers rolled onto the fourth day yesterday. A few hundred teachers under the banner of "Bangla-

desh Swatantra Ebtedai Madrasa Shikkhak Samity" started the strike on Tuesday, demanding that the government nationalise the ebtedai madrasas that teach students from class I to V. Earlier, they staged a sit-in for eight consecutive days at

the same place. At least 108 teachers fell ill yesterday and nine are now

receiving treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital, Qazi Ruhul Amin Chowdhury, president of the organisation leading the demonstration, told The Daily Star last night.

"It seems that the government does not treat us as teachers. We have been remaining on the street for the last 12 days, but no one from the government could spare time to meet

PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

Foreign student flow on the wane

The country's public universities are lagging far behind private universities in terms of attracting foreign students for a lack of promotional activities and various facilities.

The overseas students are now choosing private universities over the public ones as those offer many opportunities, including scholarships.

There are 37 public and 95 private universities in the country.

A few years ago, a large number of foreign students used to get admitted to public universities to pursue higher education, but the situation is quite different now.

According to the last annual report of the University Grants Commission (UGC), only 355 foreign students enrolled in 19 public universities in 2016 while the number of overseas students getting admitted to private universities was 1,927.

The report also said 359 foreign students got admitted to public universities in 2010 while 210 in 2011, 525 in 2012, 326 in 2013, 432 in 2014, 593 in 2015.

On the other hand, 1,548 foreign students enrolled in private universities in 2015 while

the number increased to 1,927 in 2016. UGC Chairman Prof Abdul Mannan

attributed the decline in the number of foreign students in public universities to the lack of publicity and promotion. "Most public universities don't update their websites. They don't provide any information

about foreign student admissions on their websites and don't take any step to promote their university internationally," he said. On the other hand, private universities con-

duct strong campaigns, and offer scholarships and facilities to attract foreign students, he said.

Mentioning that many countries are now focusing more on vocational and job-oriented education, the UGC chairman said that also discourages students of those countries to pursue higher education elsewhere.


In 2017-18 session, only two foreign students got admitted to Dhaka University, while a few years ago, a significant number used to enroll in the country's leading university.

According to sources at the university, 16 foreign students enrolled in DU in 2016-17 academic session while four in 2015-16, eight in 2014-15 and 11 in 2013-14 academic calendar for higher study.

Govt can't destroy BNP Says Noman

"There's no democracy in the country now," he said. Noman made the comments at a human chain organised near the capital's Jatiya Press Club by Jatiya Ganotantrik Mancha demanding the withdrawal of all "false cases" filed against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and the party's Senior

Vice Chairman Tarique Rahman. The BNP vice chairman also said, "We are ready to engage in talks for the restoration of democracy. We'll also wage a movement, if necessary, as we won't make any compromise on the issue..." More than 650,000 Rohingya have fled to neighbouring Bangladesh to escape a brutal crackdown in which security forces have been accused of systematic abuses tantamount to ethnic cleansing.

During a meeting yesterday, Kono asked Suu Kyi's government to allow humanitarian and media access to the affected area, the resettlement of returned refugees, and the implementation of recommendations made by former UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan.

Kono also said Japan plans to give further aid of \$20 million to improve humanitarian conditions and development in Rakhine state.

"We are thankful to Japan for its willingness to support the needs both for short term and long term," Suu Kyi said at the joint news conference.

Yamaguchi stressed that Japan will monitor how the repatriation will be carried out. "The money will be paid in a timely manner based on the progress of repatriation," Yamaguchi added.


Freedom fighter Nasir Uddin alias Nannu Miah died of a stroke at Combined Military Hospital in Dhaka on Thursday morning. He was 84.
