DU expels 15 students over fraudulence DU CORRESPONDENT

The Dhaka University

authorities last night expelled 15 students from the institution over fraudulence in admission tests. Among those expelled

are two leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League, a pro-Awami League student front. The decision was made

at a meeting of the university's syndicate, said Vice-Chancellor Prof Md Akhtaruzzaman.

Twelve of them got admitted to the university last year through fraudulence while the rest were members of a gang that helped admission seekers take the entry test either by providing leaked questions or sending answers to students through electronic devices during the admission tests.

Trade resumes thru' the landport after 5 days

Trade activities through Benapole Land Port resumed Monday night after five days.

The activities had come to a halt on Thursday when the users of India's Petrapole Land Port, which is opposite to the Benapole port, went on an indefinite strike after Petrapole customs officials decided to issue car passes writing the details themselves.

The car pass is the permission for entering the goodsladen trucks on both sides of the land port. In a car pass, details of a vehicle, its driver and helper and the goods the vehicle is carrying are written.

The land port users used to write the information in the form of a car pass seeker.

Deadlock ends | Missing BNP leader arrested by Rab

Confirms Rab official, says he was held for plotting subversive activities; family alleges Rab men take away his passport

Rab yesterday confirmed that it arrested BNP leader Anisur Rahman Talukder Khokon over allegations of plotting subversive activities around 20 hours after he went missing in the capital's Gulistan area.

Khokon "We have arrested him [Khokon] on information that he was involved in plotting subversive activities," Lt Col Emranul Hasan, commanding officer (CO) of Rab-3, told this newspaper yesterday evening.

He, however, didn't say what type of

subversive activities Khokon, mass education affairs assistant secretary of the BNP, was allegedly plotting.

Rab later handed him over to Ramna Police Station. He was shown arrested in a case filed last year over plotting subversive activities, said Sub-inspector Mizanur Rahman of the police station, also

investigation officer of the case. Talking to this correspondent, Khokon's wife Shah Israt Azmery said members of the elite force picked up her husband on a vehicle with a Rab-3 sticker from in front of SEE PAGE 10 COL 2

Banks asked to lower their loandeposit ratio

The central bank yesterday instructed banks to lower their loan-deposit ratio to within 83.5 percent by June 30 in a move to reining in the banks' aggressive lending practices. The Shariah-compliant

banks will have to lower their ratio to 89 percent from 90 percent. The runaway private

sector credit growth has compelled the Bangladesh Bank to take this stand, said a central bank official. Earlier in December last

year, the BB blocked Tk 76 crore of two banks with its account as penalty for breaching the ceiling for loan-deposit ratio set by the central bank.

The private sector credit growth stood at 18.13 percent in December last year, which is way past the target of 16.2 percent set by the BB for the first half of the fiscal year. While unveiling the

monetary policy for the second half of fiscal 2017-18, BB governor Fazle Kabir said that the central bank will slash the loan-deposit ratio with the view to ensuring the quality of credit. "The banks will have to

follow the asset-liabilities and foreign exchange risk management. Strict measure will be taken against SEE PAGE 10 COL 4

Russians named, shamed

US releases list of oligarchs, political figures eligible for sanctions; Putin says it is an unfriendly act

The US has released a sweeping list of prominent Russian business and political figures, in defiance of Moscow and implementing a Congressional law designed to punish Russia for election meddling.

The US Treasury report, published on Monday night, listed every senior member of the political administration at the Kremlin, and every Russian oligarch with a net worth of \$1 billion

Some of those named are already subject to US sanctions. But the administration stopped short of imposing any new punishments, saying the legislation was already doing its job. The report was "not a sanctions list," it said.

Instead, the Treasury report resembled an exercise in naming and shaming -- putting individuals on notice that they may be subject to sanctions in the future.

The list includes 114 senior political figures with close ties to Russian President Vladimir Putin, including his chief spokesman, Dimitry Peskov, Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov and Prime Minister Dimitry Medvedev.

The Treasury said the list was "based on objective criteria drawn from publicly available sources." The oligarchs' names matched exactly a list of 96 Russian billionaires compiled by Forbes magazine last year.
