FROM PAGE 3 Justice SK Sinha and Justice Wahhab, and the retirement of Justice Nazmun Ara Sultana, the first-ever female judge of the apex court, on July 7 last year.

The High Court Division has also been facing a similar shortage of judges following retirement and death of some judges in the last several months. The number of HC judges now stands at 81, which was 100 in June 2012.

The government appointed 166 judges to the lower courts recently for increasing the disposal of the cases. Their postings are waiting for the Supreme Court's approval, said law

ministry sources. The Appellate Division judges are dealing with more than 16,500 cases. On the other side, 81 HC judges are dealing with more than 4.76 lakh cases. SC sources said around 1,400 judges are dealing with over 28 lakh cases pending with lower courts across the country.

Month-long campaign launched

A month-long campaign, "Nikhoj Shobder Khoje", to encourage the young generation to reconnect with those Bangla words that have been missing from the language for a long time, was launched at Bishwo Shahitto Kendro in the capital yesterday.

Coca-Cola Bangladesh launched the campaign on the occasion of International Mother Language Day.

The main purpose of the campaign is to create awareness on the issue that many Bangla words, which were once used to enrich and beautify the language, are missing, and encourage people to be a part of this campaign to help popularise the idea of utilising the once used Bangla words. Myanmar border police detains five Bangladeshi fishermen

Releases them 6 hours later

Myanmar's Border Guard Police (BGP) released five Bangladeshi fishermen after six hours into their detention from the Naf River in Teknaf upazila yesterday.

During the raid, BGP also shot another fisherman in the leg when he was escaping the detention. Later, he got admitted to Cox's Bazar Sadar Hospital.

After the fishermen were handed over to Bangladesh authorities, a mobile court of the Teknaf upazila administration jailed each of them for three months for trespassing into Myanmar's waters.

The fishermen are Shah Alam, 34, Muhammud Islam, 30, of Kanjarpara village, Year Muhammad, 36, Pethan Ali, 30, Aziz Ullah, 18, and Md Rafiq, 28, of Jaliapara village of the upazila.

According to bullet-injured Muhammad Islam, a group of six fishermen went to fishing in early hours yesterday. Suddenly, they were attacked by BGP men who came on a speed boat and taken to their camp. However, Islam managed to flee and was shot during the escape, he said.

Samsul Alam, brother of fisherman Shah Alam, alleged, "The BGP often attacks and captures Bangladeshi fishermen in the bordering area for ransom, and it has become regular."

Confirming the incident, Captain of BGB battalion-2 Lt Col SM Ariful Islam said that after knowing the incident, they protested the detention and sat for a dialogue with BGP. "The government banned fishing in the river [Naf] so

that Yaba trafficking cannot take place. It is not expected from the fisherman to go fishing in the area," the official said.
