ACC commissioner warns corrupt govt officials at public hearing

ACC Commissioner AFM Aminul Islam said people are being deprived of getting public services due to corruption and negligence of some dishonest and unscrupulous government officials, which is ultimately hampering the country's development.

He was speaking at a public hearing of the Anti-Corruption Commission on public services on the premises of Independent Square in Gaibandha on Wednesday, aiming to raise awareness against corruption.

Aminul warned that the national anti-graft body will not hesitate to take harsher actions against corrupt government officials if they do not change their mindset.

"Due to the active participation of people alongside the officials concerned, the public hearings have become an effective tool in checking graft in the public sector," he said.

17 women raped in public transport

Reveals Bangladesh Jatri Kalyan Samity report on last 13 months

Nine women were gang-raped while eight others raped inside public transports, mostly buses, across the country in last 13 months, said a passengers welfare platform yesterday.

Besides, four women were sexually harassed inside public transports, according to a report revealed by the platform, Bangladesh Jatri Kalyan Samity, yesterday.

Cases were filed in connection with all the incidents except for a gang rape. Police and the media took prompt actions after the incidents and a total of 55 people were arrested in all the cases, it added.
