Manchester United's Champions League trip to Sevilla on Wednesday night is the type of occasion for which the English giants swallowed their pride to pay £89 million for Paul Pogba, four years after he left Old Trafford for Juventus as a free agent.

Yet, it remains to be seen whether the French midfielder even starts at the Sanchez Pizjuan for the first leg of the last-16 tie as much due to his form as his fitness.

Pogba hasn't completed 90 minutes in a month as he has been hauled off by Jose Mourinho in defeats at Tottenham and Newcastle.

Mourinho described rumours of a breakdown in communication between he and Pogba as "big lies", but has not hid his criticism of the 24-year-old's form.

"In this moment he is not playing well... and the team needs him at a good level."

No more so than in the next few weeks as in between their two legs against Sevilla, United also host Chelsea and Liverpool in the Premier League with all three sides

locked in a battle to finish in the top four. "When he is not playing at a good level the team is

not as good as the team can be," added Mourinho. "I think it happens with every team when the best players, the most crucial

players, for some reason are

not performing."

Pep Guardiola's quest to win an unprecedented quadruple with Manchester City came to a stunning and controversial end when they fell to a 1-0 defeat at third-tier Wigan in the fifth round of the FA Cup on Monday.

Though Frederick signed a five-year deal as the national team's head coach only this Monday, the 50-year-old began working with local archers after his arrival on February 14. And a few have already benefitted from some of Frederick's tips.

Iti Khatun, a recurve bow archer, came into the limelight when she won a bronze medal in the National Archery Championship in January. However, the promising archer faced troubles to improve her scores in training until she recently showed signs of drastic improvement trough Fredrick's aid.

"Iti could not improve her scoring in training but Frederick figured out her problems after seeing her shooting. Her problem was with basics so Fredrick rectified her basic technique. Now Iti has hit a highest of 316 from her average score of 260 to 270," said Zia.

Sanwar Hossain felt discomfort in his left hand and could not shoot properly but after Frederick amended Sanwar's technique, the archer has been able to shoot smoothly.

Praising Frederick, Zia said: "I have worked with a few foreign coaches but Frederick is different as he emphasises on the archers' basic techniques as well as educating local coaches, who will groom budding archers in their native tongue so that the archers don't need basic training after being called for the national team."

However, Bangladesh's top archer Roman Sana made a cautious observation about the German coach.

AFC wants BNS pitch improved

The Bangabandhu National Stadium (BNS), the country's lone FIFA and AFC certified venue, is not up to the standard to host international matches, opined an AFC match commissioner following the AFC Cup play-off qualifier between Saif SC and TC Sports Club last month.

"The AFC recently instructed us to improve the ground's condition and make it playable

before the March 7 AFC Cup match between Abahani and New Radiant Club of Maldives as the AFC match commissioner, after the match between Saif SC and TC Sports Club, reported that the BNS ground is not up to the mark to host international matches," informed Bangladesh Football Federation general secretary Abu Nayeem Shohag yesterday.

During the match on January 23, players from both sides struggled to control the ball on a bouncy BNS pitch, which last season hosted 170 fixtures of the Federation Cup, Bangladesh Premier League and Independence Cup apart from matches of the Bangladesh Championship League, Pioneer Football League and JFA U-14 Women's Football tournament.

Shohag informed that they have taken initiatives to improve the ground's standard since February 17 such as planting grass, watering the pitch and utilising fertilizers.

Groundsman Chand Mia said the pitch turned bouncy due to the use of heavy rollers once a week.


"As we don't have any light roller to level the ground, we

are forced to roll the ground with a 10-ton roller of the City Corporation, so the ground turns bouncy. The problem will not arise if we have a light roller," said Chand, adding that the BNS had light rollers but those were shifted to Mirpur once cricket was shifted to Sher-e-Bangla National Stadium.

However, Chand is optimistic about making it softer and greener by March 5 ahead of the match on March 7.
