These will cause moral degradation of the future generation," he said. Dhaka University Prof Mesbah Kamal and Oikya Nap president Pankaj Bhattacharya also spoke.

Six get life term for murder

A Chittagong court yesterday sentenced six persons to life in jail for killing a student after abduction in Patiya upazila of Chittagong in 1991. The convicts are Mahbul Alam, Habibur Rahman, Aminul Haque, Milon Barua, Abul Kashem and Nurul Alam. Chittagong Public Safety (Jononirapotta) Tribunal Judge also Special District and Session Judge Sayeda Hosne Ara delivered the verdict, said Public Prosecutor Jahangir Alam. The court also sentenced the four and one Sirajul Islam to three years in jail under section 201 of Penal Code. Meanwhile, the court also acquitted four persons -- Yunus, Sayed, Selim and Monir. Samir Das, another accused in the case was awarded five years jail term. According to the case, the convicts abducted SSC examinee Suvash Barua on June 21, 1991 from Patiya upazila. Later, they sought ransom from his parents but went on to hack the victim to death and dumped his body on a hill. Suvash's father filed a case with Patiya Police Station in this regard.

Three held with 19kg of cannabis in Ctg

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab)-7 detained three "drug peddlers" with 19 kilogrammes of cannabis, worth Tk 1.52 lakh, in Chittagong city early yesterday. On a tip-off, a Rab-7 team searched a Dhaka-bound bus in the city gate area under Akbar Shah police station and detained its passengers Md Anwar Hossain, 42, of Patuakhali; Md Hasan, 42, and Md Shamsu Miah, 27, both of Comilla, after recovering the cannabis in a packet from the luggage compartment, said Assistant Superintendent of Police Mimitanur Rahman. The detainees were handed over to Akbar Shah police.

34th death anniversary of Selim, Delwar today

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the implementation stage, he said, adding, "This practice contributes to the delay in project implementation." Abul Kashem Bhuiyan, additional chief engineer of the Roads and Highways Department, said even after introducing electronic government procurement (e-GP) system, anomalies in tender process could not be stopped due to some loopholes in tender submission procedure. Dipak Kanti Paul, managing director of BD Climate Change Trust, opined that experts should be included in the relevant projects. Engr Mohammad Hossain, director general of Power Cell of Power Division, said they have made their service online which helps reduce corruption. He, however, admitted that there are practices of corruption in power sector at the field levels. ACC Chairman Iqbal Mahmood asked the engineers not to be afraid of influential quarters. "Don't be afraid of them [influential people]. Do your jobs according to the system," he said. "If any influential person makes any illegal demand, inform us," he asked the engineers. The ACC chairman pointed that importing cars for every project is a waste of public money. Therefore, he suggested buying cars locally manufactured by Progoti. ACC Commissioner AFM Aminul Islam suggested that the top officials should visit project sites to inspect whether any corruption is taking place.
