Neymar still has a "small chance" of playing against Real Madrid in the Champions League and there are no plans for an operation on his cracked bone, Paris Saint-Germain coach Unai Emery said on Tuesday.

"For Neymar there has been no decision to have an operation," said Emery, denying an earlier report in the Brazilian press that the world's most expensive player would go under the knife to fix the cracked bone in his foot.

"Neymar is the first to want to play every match, he's very focussed on Real. I think there's a small chance that he'll be ready for the match," added Emery. PSG trail 3-1 from the last 16 first leg in Madrid two weeks ago and the loss of

Neymar would be a huge blow to their chances of overturning that deficit at the Parc des Princes on March 6 and reaching the Champions League quarter-finals. Neymar suffered a cracked metatarsal in his foot and a twisted ankle in an innocuous looking incident against Marseille on Sunday night. And while Emery said there is a possibility he'll recover by next week, he was

more pessimistic than he had been on Sunday. "Today, after analysing Neymar, it looks less likely than it did on Sunday that he'll be ready for this match." However, he was clear in his dismissal of a report published by Brazilian

outlet Globo Esporte on Tuesday that claimed a decision had been reached for Neymar to undergo an operation, and that he would be out until May.

"Last night [Monday] the club issued an official statement: it said how

the player was medically," added Emery. "Things (like operations) aren't decided like that," he added, clicking his fingers.

"You need discussions with the doctor, the player, his entourage. To make such an important decision you need tranquillity and a bit of patience. Right now, I don't think you need anything else. There's a lot of information from

outside, but the truth is what I told you, which is what the doctor told me." While PSG's primary concern is having Neymar for their Champions League match next week, in Brazil it is Neymar's participation at the World Cup that is most important.

### Neymar has 'small Booters leave today for tactical training in Qatar

Having completed a two-week fitness camp, the national football team will fly out

this afternoon to Qatar for a two-week tactical training camp with an eye on finding the right combination for the March 27 FIFA Friendly against Laos.

The charges of Andrew Ord had rigorous fitness sessions at BKSP under the supervision of Portuguese fitness trainer Mario Lemos. Initially 24 footballers participated in the camp on February 13 before the remaining 11 players join for a oneweek training from February 21. Players like Yeasin Khan,

Jewel Rana, Zahid Hossain, Pashban Mollah, Toklish Ahmed, Matin Mia and Hemanta Vincent Biswas withdrew from the camp either due to injury or sickness while Javed Khan, Fazle Rabbi, Mohammad Zahid, Mitul Hasan and Mohammad Arif were dropped for having failed to impress.

Ord designed the ongoing training in three phases -- fitness training in BKSP, tactical training in Qatar and the final preparation in Thailand with the full national team-- before the squad heads to Laos for the FIFA Friendly.

As there are no players from league champions Abahani for the club's AFC Cup campaign next month, Ord's obvious intention is to pick the best from the 24 players, including experienced footballers such as Mamunul Islam, Asharful Islam Rana, Uttam Kumar Banik, Faisal Mahmud, Tapu Barman and Jamal Bhuiyan.

### I couldn't desert my team: Buffon

Italy goalkeeping legend Gianluigi Buffon confirmed on Tuesday he is ready to come out of international retirement if he is called up for friendlies against England and Argentina.

Buffon called time on his international career after Italy failed to qualify for the World Cup in Russia. But Italy interim national coach Luigi Di Biagio said on Monday he was ready to recall Buffon for friendlies against Argentina and England in Manchester and London in late March.

"I had thought about going on holiday for a few days with my family, but when the national team needs you, you must be present and not desert them," Buffon told Italian programme Tiki Taka.

The 40-year-old goalkeeper has represented the Azzurri for 20 years, winning the 2006 World Cup title, and earning a record 175 caps. "There's nothing to add to

Di Biagio's words other than I feel a sense of responsibility and loyalty which I must give to the national team in this transitional moment," he continued. "I repeat, it's a way of showing loyalty and a sense of responsibility towards Italy. A new national team is being born and the first games are not comfortable ones. "I think that any experi-

enced player can be useful at the start, even if it's just to give advice to the young ones." Buffon, who intends to

retire as a player at the end of the season, said he will announce his final decision in due course.

"The only thing I have to do right now is focus on the end of the season," Buffon continued. "The thing I can tell you is that I'm sure and I'm very happy with what will be my choice.




