

WHATS HOT @ MWC 2018

In the world of technology, there are very few days that are as exciting as the time when Mobile World Congress takes place. If you are a tech geek then, without a doubt you were glued to the screen most of the time during the MWC2018. Starting from 5G to all-screen concept phone, this year's Mobile World Congress was sort of a roller coaster ride. We monitored the events closely, noted down all the significant product launches and all the big announcements. From all those stuff, we bring you the hottest smartphones unveiled at this year's MWC.

Samsung Galaxy S9 series

Galaxy S9 series is the iteration of the much successful S8 series by Samsung. This flagship series, at a glance, doesn't look much different than its older brother. Except the back is a bit different and the device weighs a bit more. The newly ergonomically placed fingerprint sensor is below the camera, the powerful Exynos 9810 processor along with 6GB of RAM, the new camera - are some of the improvements in the S9 series. In Bangladesh, Samsung will only be selling S9+ (the bigger version).





Sony Xperia XZ2 series

Sony Xperia XZ2 series is the successor to the Sony Xperia XZ1 series. The design of the Xperia phone hasn't changed much radically in the last couple of years. The XZ2 isn't any bit different: all are chunky, oversized and comes with a stunning display. The fingerprint has moved from power button to the back. Following the footsteps of Apple, XZ2 got rid of the 3.5mm jack.

ASUS Zenfone 5 series

Looking for an iPhone X copycat that won't put a dent in your wallet? Look no further, ASUS Zenfone 5 is here! At the MWC this year, ASUS launched two new phones: Zenfone 5 and Zenfone 5Z. Both have the notch of iPhone and the camera formation is identical to iPhone too. The ASUS is a bit bigger in size though and a bit lighter too compared to iPhone X. The phone is priced around USD 500. Meaning you get a iPhone X look alike for just one third of the price. Although the price in Bangladesh is not set yet, but experts predict it won't be more than BDT 50k. We haven't receive any confirmation yet, but probably this phone may be available somewhere around mid May.






Nokia 8110 4G

Vivo Apex Concept

Vivo is one of the lesser known brands that generally don't get much attention during the Mobile World Congress. Not this year. This year Vivo has shown off a concept phone: Vivo Apex. This phone has a whopping 98 percent body to screen ratio. The phone also has a pop-on front facing camera. Although it's a concept phone, we expect to see it in production by end of May this year. If you are planning to buy this phone then start saving now. It won't be cheap.

Packed with the best possible hardware, Nokia 8 Sirocco is the biggest, baddest phone in Nokia's arsenal right now. Symphony mobile to start manufacturing with Summit Technopolis

Walton releases new 4G handset with face unlock feature

Walton has released its new 4G enabled smartphone Primo S6 infinity which features face unlock technology to provide maximum security of the device along with a back fingerprint scanner.The five-finger multitouch smartphone bears a 5.5-Inch in-cell HD plus18:9 fullview IPS display with 2.5D curved glass. Runs on Android 8.0 Oreo operating system, the device is powered by a 64-bit 1.3 GHz Quad-core processor and comes with 3 GB RAM and Mali-T720 GPU. It sports 32 GB of internal storage, which can



be further expanded upto 256 GB via a microSD card. It also

sports a 13MP rear camera with f/2.0 aperture, PDAF support, LED flash, 5P lens and BSI sensor. Its 8MP front facing camera with f/2.2 aperture, soft LED flash, 4p lens and BSI sensor ensures best selfies. Rear camera can capture full HD (1920X1080 pixel) while the front HD (1280X720 pixel) videos. Powered by a 3000 mAh battery, the 8.1mm slim smartphone weighs only 146
