

MANPOWER FROM BANGLADESH No ban on recruitment in Kuwait

Says state minister; temporary restriction
on Visa20 category remains

UNB, Dhaka

The government has confirmed that there has been no ban on recruitment of Bangladeshi workers in Kuwait in various categories. However, a temporary restriction is imposed on Visa20 category, better known as Khadim (domestic help) visa.

"This is wrong reporting based on partial information published in the foreign media," State Minister for Foreign Affairs M Shahrir Alam, now on a visit to Kuwait, told the news agency over the phone yesterday citing reports run by a section of Bangladesh media.

He said a section of people violated the rules of Visa20 category and brought more than one person for single family.

For this reason, the state minister said, the visa for this particular category will remain restricted until further notice. "But visa for other categories remains open for Bangladeshis," he said.

The government is sincerely working to stop irregular migration. "We will help Kuwait government in this regard," he said.

"We requested the Kuwait government to issue family visa for people who are working there for a long time. They told us they will actively consider that," he said.

He said he spoke to Bangladesh community in Kuwait on Monday and gave necessary directives to work together to stop irregular migration.

The state minister said there is no restriction on Visa18 (company visa and labour) and Visa17 (government offices) categories. He said Visa18 category is the most widely used one.

MONEY LAUNDERING CASE SC verdict on Morshed Khan's appeal today

The Supreme Court (SC) will deliver its order on the appeal filed against a High Court verdict that permitted Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) probe the money laundering case against former foreign minister M Morshed Khan, his wife and their son.

The apex court also directed ACC lawyer Advocate Khurshid Alam Khan to produce the commission's (ACC) case documents before it.

The four-member bench of the Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain yesterday fixed the date after hearing a leave-to-appeal petition filed by the three accused.

Following a revision petition filed by the ACC the HC on November 9, 2016 permitted the ACC to further investigate the money laundering case against them.

The same day, the HC also extended till March 31, 2017 its earlier order of freezing the bank accounts of the trio with Standard Chartered Bank in Hong Kong and ordered them to surrender before a lower court.

After this, a petition was filed by the trio and the Appellate Division of the SC later on stayed the order to freeze the bank account.

Additionally, on January 19 last year, they filed the leave to appeal petition with the SC against the HC verdict to reinvestigate the case.

Advocate Khurshid Alam Khan said that the graft watchdog filed the money laundering case against Morshed, Nasrin and Faisal in 2013 and submitted a final report to the lower court in July, 2015 saying no evidence of money laundering was found against them.

The lower court on April 15, 2016 accepted the final report and exempted the three from the money laundering charge.

The Hong Kong police, who froze their bank accounts in 2008 under an administrative order, have meanwhile sent a

assault one of the girls, but other girls resisted the move. Gulbar then rebuked Sobuj. He again rebuked Sobuj on February 25 when the latter stalked one of the girls. Gulbar then informed the matter to the school's headmaster.

But nothing could stop Sobuj from stalking the girls. On Saturday, some of the students of the school beat up Sobuj while stalking the girls again.

Contacted, Shawkat Islam Mollah, headteacher of the school, said he had heard about the stalking incident, but none of the girls complained to him.

The students who beat up Sobuj, included one of Gulbar's nephews, claimed the headmaster. The attack on Gulbar's house might have been carried out in line with that, he added. However, OC Nasim of Bagmara Police Station said the attack might have taken place following the teacher's protest against the stalking.

Locals said Jubo League leader Sohel is a close associate of Taherpur municipality Mayor Abul Kalam Azad.

Under the shelter of the mayor, Sohel has been involved in different criminal activities in the area for long, they added.

This correspondent could not reach Sohel and Sobuj as they were on the run.

Contacted, Mayor Abul Kalam Azad echoed the headmaster. He said the attack on Gulbar's was a crime, but it happened after Sohel's brother was beaten up. He, however, declined that he was patronising Sohel.
