Govt silent on smuggled money

Dr Kamal tells views exchange meeting at DRU STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Thousands of crores of taka were embezzled from banks and smuggled abroad with the government remaining silent to get the money back, said eminent jurist Dr Kamal Hossain yesterday. "I do not see any visible step..." in this regard, he said. The corrupt involved in looting the country's wealth should be brought to book in a bid to ensure people's rights, he added. Dressed in "black coats", the "perpetrators" committed such illegal activities, said Dr Kamal, also president of Gonoforum. School student found dead in Ctg

STAFF CORRESPONDENT, Ctg A school student was found hanging from the ceiling in his bedroom at his house in Boalkhali upazila of Chittagong yesterday. Ali Hasan, 15, was a class X student of Gomdandi Pilot High School in the upazila. Quoting family members, police said when the boy did not respond till 8:00am, his family members broke open the door and found his body hanging. The boy had spoke to his mother and elder sister the night before, and to his father earlier in the evening, the family said. They cannot think of any reason for which he might want to end his life, they added.

Prof Mizanul Haq passes away

CITY DESK Prof Dr Mizanul Haq, former head of the Department of Forensic Medicine at Dhaka Medical College Hospital, passed away on Friday in a city hospital, aged 64, said a press release. He left behind his wife, a son, a daughter and a host of relatives and friends to mourn his death. The veteran physician had also served at Green Life Hospital and Samorita Hospital in the capital. His namaz-e-janaza was held at Green Life Hospital. He will be buried at the Azimpur graveyard. A qulkwani will be held at his residence after the Asr prayers on Friday.



Road crashes claim 7 lives

STAR REPORT At least seven persons including two college students were killed in separate road accidents across the country yesterday. In Dhaka, college student Mehedi Hasan Rifat, 17, and Jahangir Hossain, 20, died after their bike skidded off a road while getting on Mayor Mohammad Hanif Flyover. Jahangir succumbed to his injuries at a private hospital in the capital while Mehedi died at Dhaka Medical College and Hospital (DMCH), reports our correspondent. Two others were also injured in the accident, said Sub-inspector Mafiz Uddin of Jatrabari Police Station. They were admitted to DMCH, he added. The accident took place while a group of youths were returning from Mawa at 5:30am yesterday, the officer further said. In Barisal, another college student Ashique Hasan 20, and Mim, 22, were killed on the spot in a head-on collision between a bus and a bike in Kashipur area of Sadar upazila, police said. The incident also left Faruk Hossain critically injured, who was admitted to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital, police added. In Narayanganj, schoolteacher Tahmina

Akter Shiuli, 45, was killed after a Dhaka-bound truck ran her over while she was crossing a road in Mograpara Chaurasta area, police quoted her brother as saying. She was assistant teacher of Roypara High School of Gazaria upazila in Munshiganj. The body was sent to Narayanganj General Hospital for an autopsy, police said adding, the truck was seized but the driver fled. In Kurigram, Nurnahar Begum, 45, was killed and six others were injured when a Dhaka-bound bus collided head on with a battery-run auto-rickshaw near Chhinay Bazar under Rajahat upazila, police said quoting locals. The injured were taken to a local hospital. Of them, two were later referred to Rangpur Medical College Hospital, police added. Meanwhile in Jhenidah, an unidentified man was killed and 20 others were injured when a Dhaka-bound bus fell into a ditch beside Kaliganj-Kotchandpur road, police quoted locals as saying. The injured were taken to Kaliganj Upazila Health Complex. The body was sent for autopsy.

FROM PAGE 3 Speaking at a discussion, the BNP leader further said, "He (Quader) disclosed it impulsively what we've long been suspecting. We would like to clearly say that people won't let you (government) implement your blueprint." Nagorik Odhikar Andolon, a pro-BNP platform, organised the programme at Jatiya Press Club, demanding release of party Chairperson Khaleda Zia from jail. On Friday, Quader told reporters that their party's victory is just a matter of formality since the country's people are very happy with their government's massive development work. Moudud, a BNP standing committee member, said their party's popularity is continuously increasing as the government kept Khaleda in jail in a "false" case. He alleged that the government is hatching various plots to prolong her release. The BNP leader, however, hoped that Khaleda would walk out of jail soon and democracy would be restored in the country. Recalling that AL President Sheikh Hasina described caretaker government formula as her brainchild in 1996, Moudud said the ruling party forgot that it imposed hartals for 174 days, set fire to petrol pumps, many vehicles and killed many people to force then BNP government to accept its demand. He said AL is now resorting to lies and unethically opposing the election-time neutral government in fear of losing power. Moudud said the fall of the current "autocratic" government is now a matter of time as no despotic government across the world could stay in power for a long time.

Rahul accuses BJP of spreading hatred

FROM PAGE 3 "The nation is tired and is looking for a way out. The Congress can only show the way ahead," Rahul said in his brief inaugural speech at the first plenary since he took over as party president three months ago from his mother Sonia Gandhi. Rahul's remarks came in the midst of efforts by different regional parties to put together a joint non-Congress and non-BJP opposition in the coming parliamentary elections. Separately, Congress too is trying to cobble together a broader opposition alliance of regional parties to take on BJP in the elections. The plenary is also being attended by a three-member Awami League delegation including AL presidium member Abdur Razzak, former foreign minister Dipu Moni, and the party's Assistant Office Secretary

Biplob Barua. Rahul alleged BJP's "emphasis on divisive politics" has taken its focus away from key issues like unemployment and farmers' distress. He claimed that Congress is the only party that can take the country forward, bringing along with it each and every citizen regardless of caste or creed. He said the difference between BJP and Congress is that BJP spread anger and hatred while Congress spread love and brotherhood. "This country belongs to everyone, every religion, every caste and every person and the Congress party is for everyone and we will not leave anyone behind," Rahul said. The two-day plenary session is being attended by senior Congress leaders including former party president Sonia Gandhi and former prime minister Manmohan Singh.

The university authorities do not take any initiative to highlight them on the website, she said, adding that the initiative could help create a positive image of the university. Jewel Mamun, an economics student, said, "We have many academic buildings and dormitories named after great personalities." "But many of us do not know the history and sacrifices of these great personalities. The authorities can update details about them in 'Academic Building' and 'Residential Hall' sections of the website", he added. A teacher, seeking anonymity, told this correspondent that the university authorities never publish the decisions taken in regular syndicate meetings. But the students have a right to know them. These decisions should be uploaded on the website, he said. Another teacher, Abdullahil Baki of mass communication and journalism department, said, "We have to face problems especially during the admission season when the server remains down." When contacted, Director of RU ICT Centre, Prof Khademul Islam Molla, said they were only assigned to build the website. "There are over 1,200 teachers; so, it is quite impossible for us to gather and update all of their academic information," he said, urging the teachers to update their own profiles as they have been given ID and passwords. While talking to The Daily Star, RU Vice Chancellor Prof M Abdus Sobhan said he had already been informed that the website was not being updated regularly. He will instruct the responsible bodies to update the website soon, added the VC.

Later, the journalists informed the matter to BMP Deputy Commissioner Golam Rauf who regretted the incident and ordered actions against the eight DB men. Sumon alleged that the DB team attacked him when he asked about the drive. "They got furious when I introduce myself as a journalist," he alleged, adding that the law men also threatened to implicate him in a drug case and kill him in crossfire.
