Rajshahi International Film Festival ends

A four-day long International Film Festival including Bangladeshi and Indian films ended in Rajshahi last

Rajshahi Film Society and Rajshahi University Film Society jointly organised the 'Second Rajshahi International Film Festival-2018'.

Language movement veteran and Freedom Fighter Abul Hossain inaugurated the festival at Lalon Shah Mukto Moncho as the chief guest.

The festival screened forty Bangladeshi and Indian films at four venues -- Rajshahi University Shaheed Sukhoranjan Samaddar Teacher Student Cultural Centre (TSCC), Talaimari Shaheed Minar Mukto Moncho and Lalon Shah Mukto Moncho (Borokuthi).

Khandaker Suman, a director of film "Ongoj", was awarded Best director in the festival, while the director of "The Rebel of Mind", Shahriar Chayan achieved Best Cinematography award. Meanwhile Tanzina Tasnim, of "The Funeral" was awarded with Special Jury

On the other hand, 21 directors from the festival were honoured with crests. The organisers also honoured Siliguri Cine Society of India and Rainbow Film Society of Bangladesh for their contribution to the film scene.

Prominent litterateur Hasan Azizul Haque was present as the chief guest in the closing ceremony and handed over the awards to the directors at RU TSCC.

Film director Fakhrul Arefeen Khan's "Bhuban Majhi", Morshedul Islam's "Ankhi of Tar Bondhura" and Akram Khan's "Khacha" were screened on the closing day.

The first edition of Rajshahi International Film Festival was held in March last year. More than 73 films from home and abroad were screened in that festival.

"Alta Banu" begins promotional campaign

Poster of Arun Chowdhury-helmed film launched

The first poster of "Alta Banu", the directorial debut of reputed small screen director Arun Chowdhury, was launched in a ceremony at Channel i premises on Thursday.

The film, which has been produced by Impress Telefilm, is based on a story by Faridur Reza Sagar and casts Zakia Bari Mamo, Anisur Rahman Milon and Farzana Rikta in the central roles, along with a formidable support cast of Raisul Islam

Asad, Dilara Zaman, Shamima Naznin, and Mamunur Rashid.

"Alta Banu" (English title "Two Sisters") is set to screen at the International South Asian Film Festival Toronto (Canada) this May, and is expected to land in theatres in Bangladesh on April 20.

The story of the film revolves around "an elder sister going on a search to find her younger sister," Arun Chowdhury said at the event. The social insecurity of women and various social taboo and superstitions are also a big part of the film, he added.

Also present at the poster launch ceremony were Channel i director Shykh Seraj, Film Director's Association president Mushfiqur Rahman Gulzar, Bangladesh Film Journalists Association president Abdur Rahman and actor Farzana Rikta.

"Alta Banu" went on floors in July 2017 in Manikganj's Ghior, where it filmed on the banks of the Kaliganga river, as well as later dates in Comilla on the banks of river Gomati.

will also return for the sequel. "Deadpool" became the highest-grossing Rrated film of all time in 2016, making a sequel all but inevitable. It previously held the record for a February opening before "Black Panther" began its

box office domination. Before seeing Brolin as Cable, comic-book lovers can

see him play the villain Thanos in "Avengers: Infinity War". "Deadpool 2" hits theatres on May 18.


