Local and expat patrons had gathered to chat away a pleasant time inside the posh Spanish restaurant, Holey Artisan, right at the heart of Dhaka's diplomatic zone when five young men, all in their teens and 20s, entered with backpacks. The pleasant conversations over dinner were violently disrupted as the youths brought out automatic weapons from their backpacks and sprayed the helpless diners with small caliber bullets. They then finished the mayhem by butchering the survivors with machetes. Their target was the foreigners.

Mother, son found dead at home

A mother and her son were found dead at a house in Kharpara residential area of Mirabazar in Sylhet city yesterday morning.

Her five-year-old daughter was rescued alive from the house. The deceased were identified as Rokeya Begum, 40 and her son Rabiul Islam Rupon, 16.

Police suspect that they were murdered on Friday afternoon or night. Several knife wounds were found in the woman's throat, hands and thigh; the boy appeared to have died from suffocation by a pillow.
