Road accidents claim 9 lives

At least 9 people including a minor girl were killed in separate road accidents across the country.

In Dinajpur, HSC candidates Humayun Kabir, 22, Nawshad Islam, 22, were killed in Kaharol upazila yesterday, reports our district correspondent.

The students of Holyland College were on their way to Thakurgaon on a motorcycle when a speeding passenger bus hit the bike killing them on spot.

In another incident in Dinajpur yesterday, BCL leader Rasel Ahmed, 26, was killed when his motorcycle collided head on with another bike on Dinajpur-Gobindaganj road in Palashbari upazila, police quoted locals as saying.

In Chattogram, two cousins Md Rubel, 30, and Md Tarek, 14, were killed after a passenger bus collided head-on with a motorbike on Chattogram-Rangamati Highway at Raozan upazila yesterday, police said quoting locals.

The duo was taken to the Chattogram Medical College Hospital (CMCH) where the doctors declared them dead, police added.

In Mymensingh, Abhijit Singh Roy, 30, his wife Momy Singh Roy, 22, and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activist Hasan, 28, were killed after their car collided with an oil tanker in the city yesterday, police said.

Momy died on spot, while the other four were taken to a local hospital. Abhijit succumbed to his injuries at a Mymensingh hospital, while Hasan died on his way to Dhaka, police added.

Her late husband was founder of Hassan Group of Industries (Chandni Chawk and Balaka cinema hall), said a press release.

Hamidi Begum left behind one daughter, four sons, 11 grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren and a host of relatives to mourn her death.

She was buried at the Azimpur graveyard yesterday and her qulkhwani will be held at the Baitul Atik Jam-e-Masjid (Road 8, Baridhara) on Friday, April 6, after Asr prayers.

Swapan Kumar Adhikari and the five doctors appeared before the HC bench yesterday.

DAG Arobindu said the directorate of health services, director of the hospital and the Gynecologists' Association yesterday submitted three separate probe reports to the HC saying that the doctors have conducted the operation to save the mother's life as her newborn was dead.

The HC was not satisfied with the three probe reports and therefore, it formed the probe committee to conduct a neutral probe, he added.

According to the news reports, expecting mother Julekha Begum, 30, wife of Shafik Kazi from Muradnagar upazila of Cumilla, was admitted to the hospital with labour pain on March 17.

Doctors led by Dr Karuna Rani Karmokar, head of gynaecology, operated on Julekha on March 18, a daily reported.

The doctors cut the uterus of Julekha and thus the baby's head during the operation, it said. The baby's body was dumped near the hospital through its security guard, it added.

Following the reports, the HC bench on March 25 summoned the civil surgeon, director and five doctors before it yesterday and issued a rule asking the authorities concerned of the government and the hospital why actions should not be taken against the doctors involved with the operation.

On behalf of Ain o Salish Kendra, four lawyers -- M Asaduzzaman, Farhana Islam Khan, Anisul Hasan and Shagufta Tabassum Ahmed -- placed the newspaper reports before the court.

Advocate Abdul Matin Khasru appeared for the five doctors, Advocate SM Abdul Mobin and Advocate Kamruzzaman Mamun appeared for the civil surgeon and the director respectively.

The ACC on September 16, 2007 filed the case against Moudud with Gulshan Police Station on charge of amassing wealth beyond his known sources of income and withholding information about his assets.

Moudud recently filed the writ petition with the HC challenging the legality of the ACC's interpretation about his incomes.
