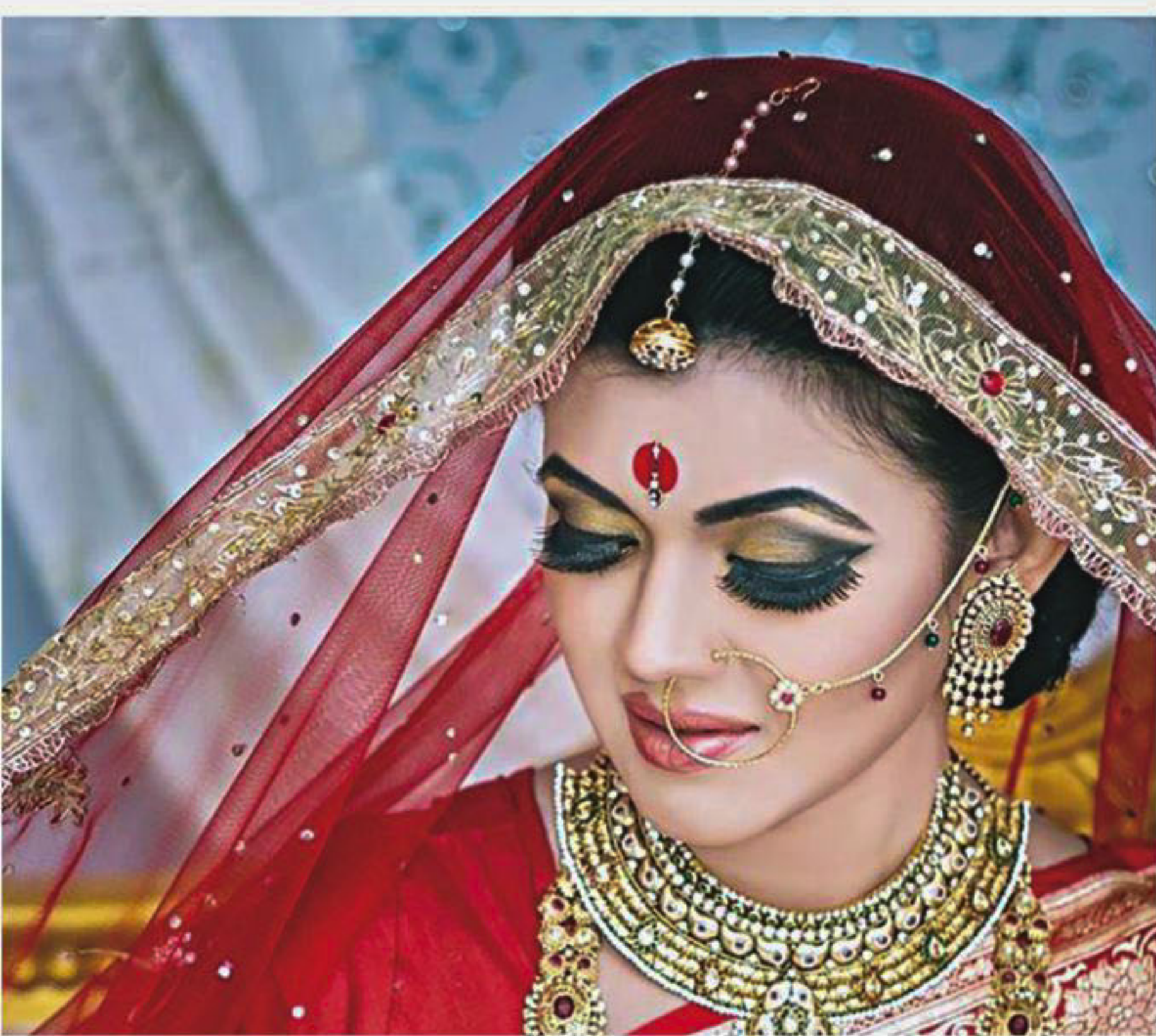




## ELITA AND BIBEK'S 'TUMI NEI TO AMI NEI' RESONATES!
